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THE US-ISRAELI AIR CAMPAIGN AGAINST IRAN ENTERS ITS SECOND WEEK AMIDST GLOBAL ECONOMIC PARALYSIS, CONFLICTING IRANIAN LEADERSHIP SIGNALS, AND A BURGEONING SECONDARY FRONT IN LEBANON.

## DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

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March 7, 2026, marks the one-week milestone of "Operation Epic Fury," the joint US-Israeli military offensive against the Islamic Republic of Iran. While US President Donald Trump has declared the operation an unprecedented success, claiming the total destruction of the [Iranian navy](#) and air force, the humanitarian and economic fallout is reaching critical levels. More than [1,300 Iranians](#) have been killed, including at least 181 children, and over 100,000 people have been displaced internally. Despite claims of military degradation, Iran has maintained its capacity for asymmetric retaliation, launching its [24th wave](#) of missile strikes against Israel and continuing to target US assets and critical infrastructure across the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) states.

A significant strategic ambiguity emerged today as Iranian President Masud Pezeshkian issued a [televised apology](#) to neighboring countries, pledging a halt to attacks on any nation not serving as a launchpad for US strikes. This diplomatic overture was almost immediately contradicted by continued missile interceptions over [Doha and Dubai](#), suggesting a severe breakdown in command and control or a deliberate rift between the political establishment and the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC). This "trust gorge" is complicating regional diplomacy as GCC states like Qatar and Saudi Arabia attempt to maintain a neutral posture while their civilian [airports and refineries](#) remain under fire.

The conflict is now a global economic crisis. The closure of the Strait of Hormuz has stalled [20% of global energy](#) shipments, driving Brent Crude prices to over [\\$92 a barrel](#). The aviation sector is experiencing its worst disruption since the COVID-19 pandemic, with over [25,000 flights cancelled](#). Domestically, President Trump faces mounting political risk as the bodies of the first [six US service members](#) killed in the conflict returned to Dover Air Force Base, fueling a partisan and generational divide over his "America First" campaign promises versus the reality of a new Middle Eastern war.

## MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

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### Iranian Leadership and Command Fragmenting

- President Pezeshkian claimed Iranian forces were "free to fire at will" after the [killing of top commanders](#), implying a loss of centralized control.

- The interim leadership council, comprised of the President, the Head of Judiciary, and a member of the [Guardian Council](#), is struggling to project a unified voice.
- The IRGC issued statements clarifying that while they respect neighbors, any [US military bases](#) in the region remain primary targets, effectively negating Pezeshkian's diplomatic olive branch.

### **Regional Escalation and the Lebanon Front**

- Israel expanded its ground and air operations in Lebanon, conducting a deep commando raid in the [Beqaa Valley](#) (70km from the border) in an unsuccessful search for the remains of missing airman Ron Arad.
- Israeli air strikes in Lebanon have displaced over [300,000 people](#), with Israeli officials threatening the Lebanese government with a "heavy price" if it fails to disarm Hezbollah.
- Hezbollah has retaliated with drones and rockets targeting [Haifa](#) and northern Israeli communities, further straining Israeli air defense systems.

### **Global Economic and Infrastructure Contagion**

- Energy markets are reeling as Iran targets "precious resources," including a [desalination plant](#) on Qeshm Island, threatening water security for 30 villages.
- Crude oil prices have surged nearly [30% in one week](#), with analysts predicting prices could exceed \$100/barrel if shipping through the Strait of Hormuz remains blocked.

- Major aviation hubs in Dubai and Qatar remain partially closed, though Qatar Airways has begun [limited repatriation flights](#) through alternative safe corridors.

### **The Information War and AI-Generated Disinformation**

- Social media is being flooded with AI-generated [fake videos](#) of missile strikes and the destruction of Ayatollah Khamenei's bunker.
- Analysts describe a "war of narratives" where supporters on both sides use sensationalized, cinematic [disinformation](#) to claim strategic advantage.

## **KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS**

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### **Energy Security and Critical Infrastructure**

- The targeted destruction of [infrastructure](#) like desalination plants and oil depots (such as the Rey refinery near Tehran) indicates a transition toward total economic warfare.
- Kuwait and Iraq have announced [reductions in oil production](#) due to the inability to export through blocked sea lanes.

### **Elite Politics and Succession**

- The [Assembly of Experts](#) in Iran is reportedly meeting to choose a new Supreme Leader, with Mojtaba Khamenei appearing as a front-runner despite the US desiring an "acceptable" leader.
- Power brokers like [Ali Larijani](#) and Mohammad Bagher Ghalibaf are asserting control as the political establishment tries to mitigate the IRGC's hardline retaliatory stance.

## Coalition Cohesion and International Relations

- European unity is fractured; Spain remains a vocal [opponent of the war](#), leading President Trump to threaten a cut-off of all trade with Madrid.
- The UK has granted [limited use of British bases](#) for defensive operations, despite local sovereignty protests in Cyprus after a drone hit a British hangar.
- Trump used the "Shield of the Americas" summit to consolidate a new [anti-cartel military coalition](#) among Latin American allies, further projecting US military might.

## Economic Security and Trade

- Bangladesh and Pakistan are facing [fuel shortages](#) and economic instability as fuel import bills surge and remittance flows from the Gulf are threatened.
- The US has reached a "historic [gold deal](#)" with the newly recognized government in Venezuela to facilitate the sale of minerals and oil.

## LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

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Legislative and policy activity today focused on emergency military assistance and regional security alliances. The Trump administration has aggressively utilized executive authority to bypass traditional diplomatic norms, particularly concerning arms sales and international trade sanctions.

- **Emergency Arms Sale to Israel:** The US administration approved a [\\$151 million](#) emergency arms sale to Israel, including 1,200 one-thousand-pound bombs.

- **Shield of the Americas Doctrine:** President Trump announced a new doctrine and military partnership with [17 nations](#) to use lethal force against criminal cartels.
- **Indonesian Youth Social Media Ban:** Indonesia joined Australia in banning social media for [under-16s](#) to protect against "online harm" during the heightened period of information warfare.

## HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS

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- **Shield of the Americas Summit (Florida):** Trump heralded the destruction of the Iranian navy and threatened [certain death](#) for Iranian leadership if they do not surrender unconditionally.
- **Dover Air Force Base Repatriation:** Trump attended the "dignified transfer" of six service members, framing their deaths as a [unavoidable price](#) of war.
- **Pezeshkian Television Address:** The Iranian President offered a [conditional apology](#) to the GCC, signaling a desire for de-escalation that was later undermined by his own military.

## DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

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### The Failure of Decapitation as a Revolutionary Catalyst

A week after the killing of Ayatollah Khamenei, the US-Israeli strategy of "decapitation" has failed to spark the predicted [internal uprising](#) in Iran. Instead, the political and military establishment appears to be coalescing around survival. Analysts note that the Iranian regime is "deep and entrenched," and the assassination of top leaders may be [accelerating nuclear ambitions](#) as the only perceived guarantee of

survival. The emergence of even more hardline figures, such as Ahmed Vahidi taking a larger role in the IRGC, suggests that the "Epic Fury" campaign is inducing [radicalization](#) rather than moderation within the Iranian state apparatus.

### **The Weaponization of Regional Stability**

Iran is successfully utilizing its "Balance of Threat" strategy to coerce the international community. By striking [GCC energy infrastructure](#) and threatening the global economy through the closure of the Strait of Hormuz, Tehran is attempting to force Gulf neighbors to pressure Washington into a ceasefire. The disparity between Pezeshkian's apology and the IRGC's [missile launches](#) can be interpreted as a "good cop, bad cop" tactic designed to keep the region off-balance while emphasizing that "any instability in Iran means regional instability."

### **The Erosion of the Multilateral Order**

The conflict highlights a significant shift toward "naked colonialism" and unilateralism. The UN is being sidelined by constructs like the "Board of Peace," and US officials are [shredding international law](#) by openly calling for regime change—a crime of aggression under global norms. The US demand that Sri Lanka [not repatriate](#) Iranian sailors rescued from a torpedoed warship further exemplifies the breakdown of humanitarian and maritime treaties in favor of raw power projection.

## **STRATEGIC FORESIGHT**

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### **Short Term (1-4 Weeks)**

- Continued [volatility in oil markets](#), with prices likely testing \$100/barrel if the Strait of Hormuz remains inactive.

- Intensified Israeli strikes on [Lebanese infrastructure](#) as the IDF attempts to force a buffer zone south of the Litani River.
- A likely announcement of a [new Supreme Leader](#) in Tehran, which will provide a focal point for either a consolidated war effort or a formal negotiation window.

### **Medium Term (1-6 Months)**

- The US mid-term elections in November will become a referendum on the war, with [Democrats likely to gain ground](#) if inflation and gas prices do not subside.
- A possible "Venezuelan model" [regime change attempt](#) in Cuba, as Trump pivots military attention toward the Caribbean to secure his "Shield of the Americas."
- Potential for "ground incursions" by [Kurdish separatist groups](#) in western Iran, backed by US/Israeli intelligence, leading to a multi-ethnic civil conflict.

### **Long Term (1-5 Years)**

- The collapse of global arms control, with Iran and potentially [Saudi Arabia and the UAE](#) pursuing independent nuclear deterrents due to a lack of trust in US security guarantees.
- Structural shifts in global shipping as the Middle East's status as a "safe haven" for [aviation and freight](#) is permanently diminished.

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### For International Policy

- **Security Interdependence:** Allied nations must prepare for [asymmetric attacks](#) on domestic targets as Iran's conventional forces are depleted.

- **Supply Chain Diversification:** Companies reliant on [Gulf petrochemicals](#) or nitrogen fertilizers must immediately seek alternative sourcing to avoid catastrophic production halts.
- **Insurance and Risk:** Maritime and aviation operators should expect [skyrocketing premiums](#) and total withdrawal of coverage for "high-risk" regional corridors.
- **Asset Reallocation:** Capital flight from the Gulf is likely; investors should look toward [re-emerging markets](#) like Venezuela, currently receiving aggressive US political and economic backing.
