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VENEZUELA NAVIGATES
NORMALIZATION WITH THE TRUMP
ADMINISTRATION AMID DOMESTIC
HEALTH CRISIS AND GLOBAL
ENERGY TURMOIL

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

March 7, 2026, marks a pivotal moment in Venezuelan statecraft as the administration of Interim President Delcy Rodríguez aggressively pursues diplomatic normalization with the United States under President Donald Trump. This rapprochement is characterized by significant economic concessions, including the issuance of [OFAC License 51 for gold transactions](#) and new energy partnerships with Shell. Simultaneously, Venezuela is attempting to stabilize its domestic social order through a massive "Amnesty Law" that has already granted [liberty to over 7,600 individuals](#), while preparing for a "National Popular Consultation" on March 8 to delegate resource management to over 5,000 communal circuits.

However, this narrative of "re-institutionalization" and peace is threatened by two converging crises. Domestically, a

lethal Yellow Fever outbreak has prompted [mandatory vaccination checkpoints](#) and travel restrictions across several states, highlighting vulnerabilities in public health infrastructure. Globally, the outbreak of "Operation Furia Épica"—a massive military offensive against Iran—has triggered a global energy crisis and a power vacuum in the Middle East, forcing Venezuela to position itself as a [stable energy alternative](#) while managing internal inflation that remains stubbornly high, surpassing 50% in the first two months of 2026 alone.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

US-Venezuela Diplomatic and Economic Rapprochement

- The Venezuelan government is inspecting its embassy and consulates in Washington and other US cities to [repair structures damaged](#) during previous years of diplomatic rupture.
- Interim President Delcy Rodríguez has publicly welcomed [recognition from President Donald Trump](#), expressing a desire for long-term relations based on mutual respect and "good intelligence."
- The US Department of the Treasury issued License 51, allowing [transactions with Minerben](#) for the sale of Venezuelan gold to the United States, provided payments are directed to a specialized US Treasury account.
- Energy analysts highlight a new agreement between Shell and the Venezuelan state to exploit gas and oil in Monagas, though success depends on [addressing chronic electricity shortages](#) in the region.

Domestic Governance and Judicial Shifts

- The "Amnesty Law" has resulted in [7,654 individuals receiving full liberty](#), including those previously under cautelar measures; the commission continues to process over 12,000 applications.
- National Assembly President Jorge Rodríguez is pushing for a total [reform of the justice system](#) to ensure that lack of resources does not impede access to legal representation or fair trials.
- A national vote scheduled for March 8 will see citizens in [5,336 communal circuits](#) choose local development projects, which the government claims is 40% more efficient than traditional bureaucratic spending.

Public Health Emergency: Yellow Fever Outbreak

- Health authorities confirmed at least [two deaths from Yellow Fever](#) in Lara state, with 36 cases identified nationally across four primary states: Aragua, Lara, Portuguesa, and Barinas.
- A "sanitary alert" has been issued, and vaccination will be [mandatory for travel](#) to certain regions, including Táchira, starting in the Holy Week period.
- The vaccination campaign targets individuals between 1 and 59 years old, as the vaccine uses [live attenuated viruses](#) that are risky for infants and seniors.

Global Geopolitical Conflict: Operation Furia Épica

- Military analysts report that US-led "Operation Furia Épica" has [decapitated the Iranian regime](#), leading to a systemic power vacuum and a global energy crisis.

- Conflict has spread to the Persian Gulf, with reports of [missile attacks on Bahrain and Qatar](#) and Iranian retaliation against the USS Abraham Lincoln.

AI and Information Sovereignty

- The "Grock" AI system has been deployed to [debunk viral deepfakes](#), including fabricated footage of missile attacks in Bahrain and distorted "Epstein file" leaks used to disinform the public.
- Authorities warn that even real document releases are being [polluted with fake digital material](#) submitted by the public to generate mystery and viral engagement.

Economic Security and Statecraft

- The Central Bank of Venezuela (BCV) reported that [inflation in 2025 closed at 475.28%](#), with the first two months of 2026 showing an alarming 51.94% cumulative increase.
- State mining policy is shifting toward a model of [mixed-capital enterprises](#) similar to the Hydrocarbons Law, focusing on strategic minerals and rare earth elements.
- The Bolsa de Valores de Caracas is launching a [Sustainability Finance Diploma](#) to align Venezuelan capital markets with international ESG (Environmental, Social, and Governance) standards to attract foreign investment funds.

International Relations and Regional Influence

- Venezuela is seeking to [revitalize relations with Europe](#), hosting high-level meetings with Polish diplomats to boost tourism and direct flights to Margarita Island.

- The Esequibo territorial dispute remains a cornerstone of foreign policy; legal experts argue Venezuela's case is [stronger than Argentina's claim](#) to the Malvinas because of the specific framework of the 1966 Geneva Agreement.

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

The National Assembly is currently focused on an aggressive legislative agenda aimed at "legal security" to facilitate foreign investment and internal reconciliation. This includes major revisions to the foundational laws governing the nation's primary resources and the judiciary.

BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **Amnesty Law:** Legislation providing full pardons or alternative measures for thousands of citizens. It is being used as a primary tool for [national reconciliation](#) and to encourage the return of political exiles.
- **Reform of the Hydrocarbons Law:** Passed unanimously to allow more flexible partnerships with [companies like Shell and Chevron](#).
- **Mining Law Reform:** A proposed overhaul to adopt the "mixed enterprise" model in the mining sector, specifically for [strategic minerals and gold](#).
- **Judicial System Reform:** A legislative effort to decentralize the judiciary and prevent the [penalization of poverty](#).

- **Amnesty Progress Report:** Jorge Arriaza detailed the [12,233 applications for amnesty](#) received, clarifying that even those in self-imposed exile for "usurpation of functions" are being considered.
- **Communal Consultation Launch:** Delcy Rodríguez and communal leaders held a press event to [promote the March 8 vote](#), emphasizing "direct government" by the people.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The "Normalization" Narrative as Economic Survival

The Venezuelan state is undergoing a massive rebranding. By embracing the Trump administration and facilitating the entry of major Western energy and mining firms, the Rodríguez interim presidency is attempting to [de-risk the investment climate](#). This is not merely a diplomatic shift but a structural necessity; with 2025 inflation at 475%, the state can no longer sustain itself without re-entering the US dollar-denominated financial system. The use of "Amnesty" serves as the domestic counterpart to this rebranding, designed to [neutralize opposition](#) and present a facade of stability to international observers.

Epidemiological Fragility in a Mobile Society

The Yellow Fever outbreak exposes the limits of the government's "normalization" efforts. While the state discusses "rare earth minerals" and "high-level tourism," it is simultaneously forced to [threaten travel bans](#) at state borders for those without 20-year-old vaccination cards. This indicates a "dual-state" reality where advanced capital markets

in Caracas coexist with a [collapsing sanitary barrier](#) in the interior. The outbreak also appears to be a regional trend, with Brazil and Colombia reporting similar virus circulation, suggesting that regional migration remains a vector for disease.

AI as the New Censor

A recurring theme is the reliance on the "Grock" system to arbitrate truth. The transcripts show a government and media apparatus that is increasingly [outsourcing fact-checking to AI](#). STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks): Expect a surge in reported communal project successes following the March 8 vote, used to [legitimize the interim presidency](#). Epidemiologically, the Yellow Fever "sanitary fence" will likely cause significant transport delays during Holy Week as [military checkpoints demand vaccine cards](#) at state lines.

Medium Term (1-6 Months): The energy crisis triggered by the collapse of Iran will likely lead to an [acceleration of US licenses](#) for Venezuelan oil. If inflation continues at the current 25% monthly rate (Jan-Feb average), another [monetary reconversion](#) or extreme austerity measures may be required by mid-year.

Long Term (1-5 Years): If the US-Venezuela rapprochement holds, the "communal government" model may solidify into a permanent parallel state, where [traditional municipal bureaucracies are replaced](#) by

direct-funding circuits. Structurally, the re-entry of Western "supermajors" (Shell, Chevron) will lock Venezuela back into a [Western-aligned energy bloc](#), potentially cooling relations with China and Russia as US Treasury oversight of gold and oil becomes the norm.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- The US-Venezuela gold license sets a precedent for "escrow-style" sanctions relief; other nations may [seek similar carve-outs](#) for debt repayment through resource extraction.
- The power vacuum in Iran significantly elevates the [geopolitical value of the Esequibo gas fields](#), making a resolution of the ICJ case a global energy security priority.
- Regional health cooperation must be prioritized; the [Yellow Fever outbreak](#) is cross-border and could threaten regional aviation hubs if not contained.

For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Risk:** Operational continuity for new energy projects is threatened by the [electricity grid collapse](#); investors must factor in self-generation costs (microgrids) as a baseline requirement.
- **Opportunity:** The move toward [ESG-compliant finance](#) in the Caracas Stock Exchange suggests an opening for green-bonds and sustainable agriculture (e.g., organic coffee/cacao) directed at European markets.

- **Compliance:** Strict adherence to the US Treasury [reporting requirements for gold and oil](#) is mandatory; "triangulation" with China or sanctioned entities (Russia/Iran) remains a "hard-stop" for OFAC licenses.
