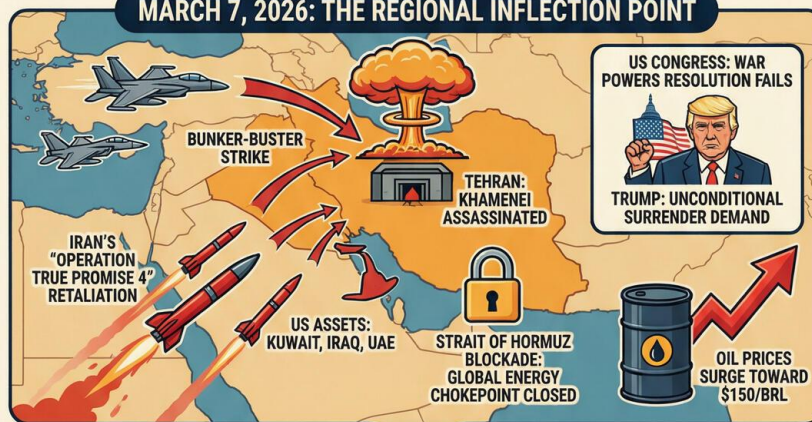

THE ASSASSINATION OF IRAN'S SUPREME LEADER HAS TRIGGERED A REGIONAL CONFLAGRATION, THREATENING GLOBAL ENERGY SECURITY AND FORCING INDONESIA INTO A DUAL-FRONT CRISIS OF EMERGENCY DIPLOMACY AND DOMESTIC CORRUPTION.

## DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

---

March 7, 2026, marks a catastrophic inflection point in global geopolitics as the Middle East enters a state of total war following the assassination of Iranian Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei. US and Israeli forces conducted a massive bunker-buster strike on Tehran, leading to the collapse of the Iranian leadership hierarchy and prompting the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) to launch "Operation True Promise 4." This retaliation involves waves of [missile and drone strikes](#) targeting US assets in Kuwait, Iraq, and the UAE, alongside a total blockade of the Strait of Hormuz. The US Congress failed to pass resolutions to halt President Donald Trump's military aggression, effectively granting a "green light" for continued operations, while

Trump has demanded Iran's [unconditional surrender](#) and claimed the right to hand-pick a successor regime.

For Indonesia, the crisis is immediate and multi-dimensional. Domestically, the government is grappling with a high-profile corruption scandal as the KPK named Pekalongan Regent Fadia Arafik a [suspect in an outsourcing kickback](#) case involving billions of rupiah. Simultaneously, the Ministry of Communication and Digital has issued a landmark "Digital Sovereignty" decree, banning children under 16 from [accessing major social media](#) platforms starting March 28. Economically, the blockade of the Strait of Hormuz threatens 40% of global oil supplies, forcing the Finance Ministry to prepare for a "worst-case" scenario of [oil hitting \\$150 per barrel](#), which would necessitate drastic budget realignments and potential fuel price hikes during the holy month of Ramadan.

## MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

---

- **Assassination of Khamenei and Global Retaliation**
  - US-Israeli forces utilized 50 jet fighters to destroy a **strategic bunker** in Tehran, killing Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei and over 1,000 civilians [in the opening waves](#).
  - Iran has retaliated with its **26th wave** of missile strikes, targeting the Al-Udeid, Al-Dafra, and Camp Udairi bases [across the Persian Gulf](#).
  - Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian issued a **diplomatic apology** to Arab neighbors for "accidental" missile overflights while maintaining that Iran will not yield to US dictates [regarding its sovereignty](#).

- **Total Blockade of the Strait of Hormuz**

- The IRGC has closed the world's most critical energy chokepoint, stopping **commercial shipping** and threatening global energy stability [and supply chains](#).
- Global oil prices are surging toward \$92/barrel with projections of **\$150/barrel** if the conflict persists [into the next quarter](#).

- **Indonesian Digital Sovereignty Decree**

- The government issued **Permenkomdigi No. 9 of 2026**, ordering the gradual deactivation of social media accounts for all citizens [under age 16](#).
- The ban covers platforms including YouTube, TikTok, Instagram, and X, citing a **digital emergency** regarding child protection [and mental health](#).

- **KPK Crackdown on Pekalongan Regency**

- Pekalongan Regent Fadia Arafik was arrested in a **KPK sting operation** related to a 19-billion-rupiah corruption scheme [involving local services](#).
- Kickbacks were allegedly channeled through the Regent's **husband and children**, highlighting deep-seated dynastic corruption [in regional governance](#).

- **Emergency Evacuation and Umrah Disruptions**

- The Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Kemenlu) is executing a **multi-stage evacuation** of 329 Indonesian citizens (WNI) in Iran via Azerbaijan [due to worsening security](#).
- Approximately 58,000 Indonesian Umrah pilgrims remain **stranded in Saudi Arabia** as regional airspace closures prevent [return flights to Jakarta](#).

## **KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS**

---

### **Elite Politics & Leadership Dynamics**

Following the death of Khamenei, Iran has established an **Interim Leadership Council** including Ali Reza Araf and the head of the judiciary [to maintain order](#). US President Trump's attempt to **intervene in the succession** by claiming a "right" to pick a new leader has been condemned by Tehran as an [illegal domestic interference](#). In Indonesia, the arrest of Fadia Arafik represents a major blow to regional political dynasties [during an election cycle](#).

### **Economic Security & Statecraft Finance**

Minister Purbaya Yudi Sadewa warned that if oil prices remain above \$92/barrel, the Indonesian **fiscal deficit** could widen to 3.6% [of the GDP](#). The government is considering **budget reallocations** from non-productive sectors and the Free Nutritious Meal program to maintain [fuel price stability](#).

### **Technology Policy & Digital Sovereignty**

The new **social media ban** for minors marks Indonesia as a "non-Western pioneer" in radical digital regulation [to protect the youth](#). Minister Mutia emphasized that this "uncomfortable" step is necessary to **reclaim digital sovereignty** from global tech giants [and platform risks](#).

## Energy Security & Critical Infrastructure

Indonesia's national oil reserves currently stand at **23 days**, slightly above the 20-day regional [energy security standard](#). Minister Bahlil Lahadalia urged the public to **avoid panic buying** despite the ongoing blockade of the [Strait of Hormuz](#).

**Diplomatic Engagement** Indonesia is facing pressure to withdraw from the **Board of Peace (BoP)**, though the administration maintains that staying is the best [diplomatic avenue for peace](#). President Prabowo reportedly **cried during a meeting** with Islamic leaders while discussing aid [for Palestinian civilians](#).

## LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

---

The day was characterized by emergency executive decrees in Indonesia and the failure of legislative oversight in the United States regarding war powers. Efforts to curb executive military authority were soundly defeated in the US Congress.

- **US War Powers Resolution (SJ Res 104):** A resolution aimed at stopping President Trump's war with Iran; it failed in the House (212-219) [on Thursday evening](#).

- **Indonesian PP on Digital Protection:** Implementation rules related to the safety of **minors in cyberspace** [under the new law](#).

- **KPK Press Briefing:** Formal announcement of the corruption charges against the **Pekalongan Regent** and five relatives [and associates](#).
- **Finance Ministry Fiscal Outlook:** Minister Purbaya detailed the impact of war-driven **oil price volatility** on the 2026 [national budget](#).
- **Religious Leader Summit at State Palace:** President Prabowo met with MUI, NU, and Muhammadiyah to discuss **Middle East peace** [and national unity](#).

## DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

---

### The Doctrine of Unconditional Surrender

The conflict has transitioned from a localized exchange to an ideological war for regional hegemony. US President Trump's refusal to **negotiate with Tehran** and his demand for "unconditional surrender" suggests a goal of total regime change [rather than de-escalation](#). Iran's strategy has shifted to **asymmetric endurance**, leveraging its geography—specifically the Zagros Mountains—to deter a [potential US ground invasion](#), which analysts characterize as "suicide" for Western forces [in the long term](#).

### Digital Protectionism as National Security

Indonesia's aggressive move against social media platforms (Permenkomdigi 9/2026) signals a shift toward **authoritarian digital protectionism**. By framing children's social media access as a "digital emergency," the state is exerting **unprecedented control**

over international tech platforms [within its borders](#). This move is likely to strain relations with US-based tech firms [in the coming weeks](#).

## Dynastic Corruption and State Resilience

The Pekalongan scandal highlights that while Indonesia pursues global peace, its **regional governance** remains riddled with nepotistic corruption. The involvement of the **Regent's entire family** in a service-contract kickback scheme suggests that decentralized authority continues to be a [primary vulnerability](#) for the Indonesian state's **integrity and public trust during crises**.

## STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

---

**Short Term (1-4 Weeks):** Expect a significant increase in civilian casualties as US-Israeli forces target Iranian **urban command centers**. Global oil prices will likely breach \$100/barrel, triggering **emergency fuel subsidies** or price hikes in Indonesia during Idul Fitri. Domestic social media platforms in Indonesia will face **mass account deletions** as the March 28 deadline [for the ban approaches](#).

**Medium Term (1-6 Months):** The Iranian "Interim Council" will likely struggle with **internal power plays** between conservative ulama and the IRGC. Indonesia may see **logistics disruptions** for the Mudik season if aviation fuel costs soar or regional stability [deteriorates further](#). The Pekalongan corruption case will likely broaden to include more regional leaders as the KPK [traces the financial network](#).

**Long Term (1-5 Years):** A permanent restructuring of the **Middle East security architecture** is likely, with a weakened Iran

potentially leading to a decade of insurgency. Indonesia's digital ban could create a **generation gap** in tech literacy or foster a robust "underground" internet culture to [bypass state controls](#).

## RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

---

### For International Policy:

- Indonesia must leverage its membership in the **Board of Peace** to secure energy corridors for non-combatant nations [to prevent economic collapse](#).
- Immediate coordination with **OPEC+** is required to offset the loss of Iranian and Hormuz-routed oil [to stabilize global prices](#).
- The Kemenlu must prepare for **secondary evacuations** in neighboring Gulf states as Iranian missiles [target US bases in Kuwait and the UAE](#).

### For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Supply Chain Risk:** Manufacturers must find alternatives for components or goods passing through the **Strait of Hormuz** [due to the blockade](#).
- **Regulatory Compliance:** Tech companies operating in Indonesia must immediately implement **age-verification systems** to comply with Permenkomdigi 9/2026 [or face deactivation](#).
- **Investment Opportunity:** Significant capital should shift toward **domestic renewable energy** and food self-sufficiency projects as fossil fuel costs [become unsustainable](#).
