THE US-ISRAEL OFFENSIVE AGAINST IRAN ENTERS ITS SECOND WEEK AMID SOARING GLOBAL ENERGY COSTS, A FAILING GROUND INCURSION IN LEBANON, AND A STRATEGIC PIVOT TOWARD UTILIZING ETHNIC PROXIES FOR REGIME CHANGE.

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

As of March 7, 2026, the conflict between the US-Israeli coalition and the Islamic Republic of Iran has entered its eighth day of high-intensity kinetic operations. The Trump administration has escalated its rhetoric, threatening the [complete destruction](#) of Iran while bypassing congressional oversight to expedite the delivery of heavy munitions to Israel. Despite sustained aerial bombardments targeting Iranian oil depots and infrastructure, the Iranian state displays significant resilience; domestic reports indicate that supermarkets and essential services in Tehran remain functional, and the government is leveraging the [persistence and resistance](#) of the population to project stability. Meanwhile, Iran's President Masud Pezeshkian has signaled a strategic restraint

toward neighboring Gulf states, offering a [diplomatic resolution](#) provided that these countries do not facilitate strikes against Iranian territory.

The regional theater has expanded significantly into Lebanon, where the Israeli Defense Forces (IDF) have launched a ground incursion that is meeting unexpectedly [fierce resistance](#) from Hezbollah units. Efforts by the IDF to conduct airborne operations deep into the Bekaa Valley have reportedly resulted in tactical failures, including the repulsion of elite forces near Nabi Sheit. The humanitarian situation in Lebanon is deteriorating rapidly, with over 300,000 civilians [displaced from the Dahia district](#) alone. Globally, the conflict has triggered an energy crisis of historic proportions; the effective closure of the Strait of Hormuz has forced major producers like Iraq and Kuwait to slash production, leading to a [spike in energy prices](#) that is beginning to cause civil unrest and "panic buying" in Western nations.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

The Proxy War Strategy and the "Kurdish Gamble"

- Internal US intelligence assessments suggest that a large-scale war is [unlikely to oust](#) the Iranian regime, leading the Trump administration to explore arming ethnic minorities.
- The CIA is reportedly coordinating with [Kurdish militant groups](#) in Iraq to trigger an internal uprising within Iran's western provinces.

- Kurdish leaders and local citizens in Iraq have expressed deep skepticism, viewing US support as a [dangerous gamble](#) that historically leads to the abandonment of Kurdish interests.
- Concerns are rising regarding the "Balkanization" of Iran, with potential mobilization of [Azeri and Balochi](#) separatist factions.

Expansion of the Lebanese Front

- The IDF has intensified its "decapitation campaign" against Hezbollah, while simultaneously ordering an [unprecedented evacuation](#) of the entire Dahia district in Beirut.
- Reports from the ground indicate that Hezbollah's Radwan units, previously claimed to be eliminated, successfully [ambushed an Israeli airborne landing](#) attempt intended to recover a legacy POW body.
- The Lebanese government has attempted to ban Hezbollah's military wing to avoid state-level destruction, but the [Lebanese army has withdrawn](#) from the south, leaving the resistance as the sole force engaging the IDF.

Global Energy Market Destabilization

- Iraq has slashed oil production by [1.5 million barrels](#) per day, and the Strait of Hormuz is now under effective Iranian control.
- US gas prices have spiked [11% in a single week](#), undermining the Trump administration's domestic "peace through strength" narrative.

- Analysts warn that the derivatives market is at risk of a [catastrophe of historic proportions](#) due to the sudden removal of 20% of the world's oil supply.

Information and Propaganda Warfare

- The US State Department has accused CNN of [aiding Iranian propaganda](#) for reporting that life in Tehran appears normal and shops are well-stocked.
- Contrastingly, Israel continues to [restrict international journalists](#) from entering Gaza or reporting freely on the impact of Iranian missile strikes within Israeli territory.
- The White House has released high-tech "recruitment videos" using [Hollywood movie clips](#) and AI-generated content to bolster support for the war effort among young Americans.

Internal Intelligence Dissent

- Former CIA analysts report that Trump has [fired senior intelligence officials](#) who provided objective assessments that contradicted the administration's optimistic war timelines.
- DNI Tulsi Gabbard is reportedly overseeing a National Intelligence Council that remains [objective regarding the difficulty](#) of regime change, leading to friction with the White House.

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Energy Security

- The closure of the Strait of Hormuz has rendered the previous [security paradigm upside down](#), as Gulf monarchies find themselves unable to export critical resources.
- Iran has targeted [oil depots in Tehran](#) themselves to prevent them from falling into enemy hands or as a scorched-earth tactical measure.

National Security & Security Architecture

- The US is shifting advanced missile defense systems, such as THAAD and Patriot batteries, between [global combat theaters](#) to cover shortages in the Middle East.
- There are emerging reports of [US naval movements](#) involving multiple carrier strike groups, signaling a transition from "standoff" to "stand-in" precision-guided warfare.
- Rumors of a [possible military draft](#) in the US are circulating as experts argue that airpower alone cannot achieve the stated objective of regime change in Iran.

Diplomatic Engagement & Bloc Politics

- Iran is actively pursuing [regional unity](#) with Muslim countries, positioning the conflict as a defense against "Zionist-American" imperialism.
- Russia and China are reportedly providing [telemetry and targeting data](#) to Iran, specifically identifying the locations of CIA and Mossad stations in the region.

- The GCC states (Qatar, UAE, Saudi Arabia) are [recalculating their alliances](#) after failing to receive the promised protection from US missile defenses.

Critical Infrastructure & Healthcare

- The Iranian Red Crescent reports that [11 medical centers](#) have been damaged, and hospitals like the Gandhi Hospital have been forced to evacuate patients under fire.
- Iran claims its [arrival time for emergency rescues](#) remains under four minutes despite the ongoing bombardment.

Economic Security & Financial Resilience

- US national debt interest has reached [1.2 trillion dollars](#), with analysts warning that the "Petrodollar arrangement" is being torched by the current war.
- A global "scramble phase" for [strategic commodities](#) is underway, potentially leading to a permanent reshuffling of world orders.

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

The executive branch has largely sidelined legislative debate in favor of emergency war powers. Secretary of War Pete Hegseth and Secretary of State Marco Rubio have been the primary public faces for the administration's strategy of "maximum pressure" transitioned into kinetic war.

BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **Emergency Lethal Aid Package:** 12,000 new half-ton bombs to Israel, citing an "emergency" need for regional security.
- **War Funding Reauthorization:** voting in Congress for continued operations, with reports of a narrow margin of support.

HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS:

- **White House Briefing on Iran Strategy:** consideration for complete destruction due to "bad behavior."
- **Pentagon Missile Defense Summit:** "Big Five" defense firms to demand an immediate increase in missile production, citing depleted stockpiles.
- **Counter-Cartel Summit:** Western Christian civilization to the war effort and domestic border security.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The Myth of the "House of Cards" There is a profound disconnect between the US administration's "bubble" and the reality of Iranian state capacity. While the White House expected the Iranian government to collapse like a [house of cards](#) following the assassination of the Supreme Leader, the transition to a collective leadership council and the continued functionality of Tehran suggest a [civilization-state](#) that is more resilient than the US "decapitation" model accounts for. The assumption that the Iranian public would "throw flowers" at invaders has been met with the reality of [nightly protests](#) against American aggression.

Asymmetric Retaliation and the "Petrodollar Hangover" Iran's strategy of asymmetric warfare is successfully targeting the core of the US global power: the economy. By controlling the Strait of Hormuz and inflicting damage on GCC oil infrastructure, Iran is exposing the [betrayal of the monarchies](#) by the US, which has failed to protect its regional partners' energy assets. This "hangover" is leading to a recalculation where the GCC may eventually prioritize

[neighborly stability](#) over US security guarantees that are no longer being met.

The High-Tech Propaganda Vacuum The administration is attempting to fight a modern war using an [outdated psychological playbook](#). Recruitment videos relying on movie tropes and AI-generated content are failing to generate the "rally 'round the flag" effect seen in previous conflicts. Public opinion polls now show [59% of Americans oppose](#) the war, a level of skepticism unprecedented at the start of a major conflict. This domestic dissent creates a critical vulnerability for the Trump administration if the conflict transitions into a long-term "forever war."

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks): Expect a [critical shortage of precision munitions](#) as current stockpiles are depleted faster than the defense industrial base can replenish them. Domestic gas prices in the US are likely to hit record highs, potentially leading to [civil unrest and long lines](#) at fueling stations. In the Levant, Israel will likely increase its brigade strength in south Lebanon, leading to a full-scale [regional conflagration](#).

Medium Term (1-6 Months): The failure of "airpower only" regime change will likely force the US to decide between a [humiliating withdrawal](#) or the reintroduction of a military draft to support a ground invasion. Ethnic proxy mobilization (Kurds, Azeris) could lead to [uncontrollable sectarian violence](#) that spills over into Iraq and Turkey, destabilizing the entire Middle Eastern border architecture.

Long Term (1-5 Years): The global economy may undergo a [forced transition](#) away from the Petrodollar as the primary reserve currency. If the US is "pushed out" of the

Middle East, it will mark the end of the post-WWII [unipolar world order](#), with Russia and China emerging as the primary security brokers in the Global South. Structural changes to alliances will see the [re-integration of Iran](#) into a new regional security framework that excludes the US.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- Allies must prepare for a [prolonged shutdown](#) of the Strait of Hormuz and coordinate alternative energy supply chains immediately.
- Diplomatic channels should prioritize a [regional de-escalation framework](#) involving the GCC and Iran to prevent a total collapse of the maritime trade routes.
- The international community must verify reports of [civilian targeting](#) (schools, hospitals) to maintain the integrity of the law of armed conflict.

For Private Sector/Investors:

- The "scramble phase" for [critical minerals and energy](#) necessitates an immediate shift into domestic or near-shored commodity supplies.
- Financial institutions should hedge against extreme [volatility in the derivatives market](#) caused by the energy shock and US debt servicing concerns.
- Technology firms should brace for increased [cyber and space-based warfare](#) as major powers utilize asymmetric digital tools to compensate for kinetic stalemates.
