



DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

On March 8, 2026, the Venezuelan state media landscape focused on the first "Consulta Popular Nacional" of the year, a massive grassroots voting initiative designed to decentralize project funding to communal councils. This domestic mobilization, coinciding with International Women's Day, appears to be a strategic effort to maintain internal stability and institutional legitimacy under Acting President Delcy Rodríguez. The administration is framing this as a transition to a "direct democracy" model while the country navigates the aftermath of what state media terms the "kidnapping" of Nicolás Maduro on January 3, 2026. This narrative of [institutional resilience](#) is being used to solidify the "chavista" movement as a unified cultural and political force in the face of external pressure.

Regionally and globally, the security environment is undergoing a tectonic shift. The United States, under President Donald Trump, has launched "Operation Epic Fury" (Furia Épica), a joint military offensive with Israel that has reportedly decapitated the Iranian regime and triggered a global energy and security crisis. Simultaneously, the U.S. has announced a new "Coalition of the Americas" involving 17 nations to militarily target narcotics cartels across the hemisphere, specifically identifying Mexico as the [epicenter of violence](#). In neighboring Colombia, high-stakes legislative elections are underway amidst border closures and threats of violence, serving as a critical bellwether for the country's post-Petro future.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

- **Consulta Popular Nacional 2026:** A nationwide voting process was held to select thousands of community-led projects for direct government funding.
 - The CNE extended voting hours until 7:00 PM due to high [citizen participation](#) across all federal entities.
 - Projects are prioritized by communal assemblies, focusing on [public services](#), water access, and local infrastructure.
 - Youth as young as 15 years old were permitted to [exercise their vote](#) in this consultation.

- **Geopolitical Disruption: Operation Epic Fury:** A massive military escalation in the Middle East has disrupted the international order.
 - The operation has resulted in a [power vacuum](#) in Iran following the destruction of its leadership structure.
 - Iran has retaliated with drone and missile strikes against U.S. infrastructure in [Bahrain and Qatar](#).
 - Analysts suggest the conflict marks the definitive end of [post-war international institutions](#) and law.
- **Colombian Legislative Elections:** Colombia held elections for the Senate and House of Representatives for the 2026-2030 period.
 - The border with Venezuela was closed to [ensure security](#) during the voting process.
 - The elections are seen as a test for the "Pacto Histórico" and a precursor to the [presidential elections](#) in May.
 - A record 1,234 women ran for office, though concerns remain regarding [political violence](#) against female candidates.
- **Venezuelan Leadership Transition:** Delcy Rodríguez continues to act as "Presidenta Encargada" (Acting President) following the January 3rd crisis.
 - Chavista leadership is emphasizing "unity" and "coexistence" through a [national amnesty](#) narrative.
 - The state is positioning Rodríguez as a figure of [sovereignty and peace](#) during Maduro's absence.

- **U.S. Security Policy Shift:** President Donald Trump has announced a new militarized approach to the region.
 - The "Coalition of the Americas against Cartels" includes [17 participating countries](#).
 - Trump has threatened the use of [missile strikes](#) to eliminate criminal networks in the Western Hemisphere.

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

- **Diplomatic Engagement:**
 - Venezuela and Italy have agreed to [restore full diplomatic ties](#), elevating their missions to the ambassadorial level.
 - Spain's ambassador to Venezuela, Álvaro Albacete Perea, participated in the [Expo Fedecámaras Portuguesa](#) to explore market complementarities.
- **Economic Security & Critical Minerals:**
 - State analysts highlight the strategic importance of Venezuelan [rare earth minerals](#) for the global race in artificial intelligence and disruptive technologies.
 - The "Consulta Popular" is used as a mechanism for [efficient resource administration](#) at the local level during sanctions.
- **Domestic Stability & Social Order:**
 - The Venezuelan government is promoting the "Ley de Amnistía" (Amnesty Law) as a tool for [national reconciliation](#).
 - NGOs like "Buena Voluntad" are highlighting the [labor inclusion](#) of persons with disabilities as a social stability factor.

- **Security Architecture:**

- The Venezuelan military (FANB) is being integrated into [democratic coexistence](#) programs, while maintaining high-alert status due to regional conflicts.
- The 1,380 military personnel of "Operación República" in Nueva Esparta were deployed to [guard polling stations](#).

- **Biosurveillance & Public Health:**

- Health authorities are urging [yellow fever vaccination](#) for travelers to Barinas, Aragua, Lara, and Portuguesa states following reported cases.
- The "Fénix Senior" program was launched to provide [affordable medical screenings](#) for the elderly population.

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

Legislative activity in Venezuela currently centers on the implementation of the Amnesty Law and the formalization of the Communal Consultation process as a recurring state function. In Colombia, the legislative elections will determine the viability of future presidential mandates and the future of the 2016 Peace Agreement benefits for former guerrilla members.

BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **Ley de Amnistía (Amnesty Law):** Described as a step toward [national coexistence](#) and a response to demands for political peace.
- **Consulta Popular Framework:** Policies allowing [youth from age 15](#) to participate in community budget decisions.
- **Colombian Gender Quota Law:** Regulations requiring at least [30% female representation](#) in electoral lists, tested in the current legislative cycle.

HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS:

- **Consulta Popular Press Updates:** Various governors, including Ernesto Luna (Monagas) and Luis Marcano (Anzoátegui), held press events to [verify polling station](#) status.
- **International Women's Day "Radiotón":** A 12-hour continuous broadcast by Radio Nacional de Venezuela featuring [Isbemar Jiménez](#) and female leaders to promote government social policy.
- **Furia Épica Analysis:** International analysts held televised deep-dives into the [implications of the fall](#) of the Iranian regime for Venezuelan security.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The Communalization of the State: The Rodríguez administration is leaning heavily into "Communal Power" as a primary governance pillar. By allowing local communities to vote on projects, the government is effectively [bypassing traditional bureaucracy](#) and ensuring that limited resources are spent in ways that maintain a base of support at the neighborhood level. This serves as a pressure valve for social discontent over failing public services like water and electricity.

Lawfare and the "Presidenta Encargada": There is a concerted narrative effort to justify Delcy Rodríguez's role as "Presidenta Encargada." State media frequently references the "kidnapping" of Nicolás Maduro as an act of international lawlessness, which in turn justifies a [homogeneous and "religious"](#) internal unity of the chavista movement. This framing is designed to

prevent internal fractures within the elite leadership while Maduro is absent.

The New Unipolar Threat: Strategic analysis presented in the transcripts suggests that the U.S. has moved from a policy of "consensus" to one of [pure domination](#). Operation Epic Fury is portrayed not just as an attack on Iran, but as a warning to the "Global South." The re-emergence of the Monroe Doctrine, coupled with Trump's threats of missile strikes against cartels, is interpreted by Venezuelan analysts as a [direct threat](#) to Latin American state sovereignty.

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks): The results of the Colombian legislative elections will likely trigger a period of political realignment in Bogotá, potentially impacting the [border security protocols](#) with Venezuela. Domestically, the Venezuelan government will begin the rapid allocation of resources to the "winning" community projects to demonstrate immediate efficacy following the consultation.

Medium Term (1-6 Months): Expect a deepening energy crisis and potential global supply chain shocks as the full impact of the [conflict in the Persian Gulf](#) hits international markets. Venezuela may attempt to leverage its own oil reserves to fill gaps in the market, despite ongoing sanctions, while navigating the "Coalition of the Americas" military presence in the region.

Long Term (1-5 Years): If the Iranian leadership remains dismantled, the global geopolitical map will shift toward a new "Coalition" model led by the U.S. that prioritizes [resource security](#) (oil and critical minerals) over traditional diplomatic norms. Venezuela's "Direct Democracy" model may become a permanent fixture, essentially

replacing regional and local governorships with a more direct line of control from the central acting presidency to communal councils.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- The restoration of ties with [Italy](#) suggests a fracture in the European consensus regarding the Venezuelan acting presidency; other nations may follow suit to secure energy interests.
- The "Coalition of the Americas" represents a new militarized interventionist framework; regional bodies must define [clear boundaries](#) for these operations to prevent unintended state conflicts.
- International legal bodies will need to address the [suspension of international norms](#) following Operation Epic Fury to prevent a total collapse of global governance.

For Private Sector/Investors:

- Investment in [Portuguese agricultural and genetic](#) centers shows resilience in the Venezuelan agro-industrial sector; local partnerships in non-sanctioned areas remain viable.
- The shift toward [community-led infrastructure](#) projects creates opportunities for firms specializing in modular water and power solutions at the micro-scale.
- High risk remains for logistics in the [Andean border regions](#) due to electoral instability and the new U.S. anti-cartel military posture.
