THE CORONATION OF MOJTABA
KHAMENEI AMID REGIONAL WAR
AND GLOBAL ENERGY COLLAPSE

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

March 9, 2026, marks a historic pivot in the Middle East as the Islamic Republic of Iran officially transitioned to its third Supreme Leader, Mojtaba Khamenei, the second son of the recently killed Ali Khamenei. This succession, occurring under the shadow of a ten-day-old war with Israel and the United States, signals a consolidation of power by the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) and the "security-military" faction of the elite. The appointment was fast-tracked by the Assembly of Experts to prevent a leadership vacuum, despite the fact that Mojtaba Khamenei lacks a public record of executive service or a verified religious standing as a high-ranking cleric. The move effectively ends the "republican" veneer of the state, shifting it toward a hereditary system supported by the military apparatus.

Simultaneously, the geopolitical and economic consequences of the conflict reached a boiling point. The Functional closure of the Strait of Hormuz has sent global oil prices soaring

above \$100-\$120 per barrel, triggering emergency G7 meetings and market volatility not seen in years. On the ground, kinetic operations expanded as Iran launched "Operation True Promise 4" against regional targets, hitting oil refineries in Bahrain and US bases in Qatar, while US and Israeli strikes devastated Iranian energy infrastructure and historical sites in Isfahan. The day is characterized by a "darkness" imposed on the Iranian citizenry through total internet shutdowns and toxic smog from burning fuel depots, even as the first cracks in the new leadership's legitimacy appeared via rooftop protests in Tehran.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

Hereditary Succession and the IRGC Coup

- The Assembly of Experts officially named [Mojtaba Khamenei](#) as the third Supreme Leader of the Islamic Republic.
- State media has launched an intensive campaign to build a "revolutionary resume" for Mojtaba, describing him as a [war veteran at age 17](#) and a "Ramadan martyr/veteran" due to injuries sustained in recent strikes.
- Analysis suggests the [IRGC's "security-military" wing](#) forced this appointment to maintain internal cohesion and protect their vast financial-intelligence empire.
- The transition is widely viewed as [hereditary](#), a major ideological contradiction for a regime that justified its 1979 revolution as an end to monarchical rule.

Kinetic Escalation: "Operation True Promise 4"

- The IRGC announced the 31st wave of attacks, targeting Israel and regional neighbors, [dedicated to the new leader](#).
- A drone strike on a [Bahraini refinery](#) injured 32 people, including a two-month-old infant.
- The US Central Command (CENTCOM) confirmed [seven US soldiers](#) have been killed since the war began, while satellite imagery reveals significant damage to [five US bases](#) in the region.
- US Tomahawk missiles were identified by investigators as the weapons used in a [deadly strike on a girls' school](#) in Minab, which killed 168 people.

Global Energy and Economic Crisis

- Brent crude oil prices spiked by [25% in a single day](#), reaching \$119 per barrel before settling near \$100 following G7 intervention rumors.
- The [G7 and IEA](#) held emergency sessions to discuss releasing 400 million barrels of strategic reserves to stabilize markets.
- Major Asian stock markets, including the [Nikkei and KOSPI](#), plummeted between 5% and 8% as the Strait of Hormuz remains functionally impassable.
- Global shipping insurance costs have skyrocketed, with [Lloyd's of London](#) withdrawing coverage from the Persian Gulf.

Targeting of Iranian Cultural Heritage and Infrastructure

- Strikes on the Isfahan Governor's office caused collateral damage to [Safavid-era historical sites](#), including the Chehel Sotoun Palace and Ali Qapu.
- Strategic fuel depots in [Shahran, Fardis, and Aghdasieh](#) are burning, causing toxic "black rain" and severe respiratory risks for the population of Tehran.
- Rationing has been implemented, reducing the [petrol quota](#) from 30 to 20 liters per vehicle.

Succession & Stability

- The selection of Mojtaba Khamenei was finalized behind closed doors in Qom, with [85-90% of members](#) present voting in favor, though some members were reportedly not notified of the session.
- Elite politics are fractured; former President [Hassan Rouhani](#) issued a veiled critique, suggesting the leadership choice should have been delayed to avoid distracting from the war effort.
- The "Hereditary" nature of the appointment is being countered by state media through [religious terminology](#), calling Mojtaba the "General Deputy" (Naeb-e Am) of the Hidden Imam.

Digital Sovereignty & Cybersecurity

- Iran has implemented a total internet blackout to suppress dissent, relying on [Chinese-developed censorship technology](#) to manage access and disrupt Starlink connections.

- The "White List" system allows [government-approved SIM cards](#) to maintain connectivity while the general public is left in an information vacuum.

International Relations & Lawfare

- President Trump has warned that any leader not [approved by the United States](#) will not survive long, signaling a policy of targeted assassination or regime decapitation.
- Vladimir Putin was the [first foreign leader](#) to congratulate Mojtaba, promising that Russia will remain a "reliable partner" to the new leadership.
- The Iranian Judiciary has threatened to [seize the assets](#) of Iranians abroad who support the US/Israeli offensive.

Humanitarian and Health Security

- Health experts warn of a [toxic environment](#) in major cities; residents are urged to wear N95 masks and stay indoors to avoid permanent lung damage from chemical smog.
- The war has led to significant civilian displacement, with [500,000 Lebanese](#) reportedly displaced by Israeli incursions in the north.

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

Legislative and policy actions today focused on emergency war measures and international crisis management. The G7 and the International Energy Agency (IEA) are moving toward a coordinated release of global oil reserves to counter the Iranian blockade of the Persian Gulf. In Iran, the Assembly of Experts bypassed traditional public debate to solidify the leadership transition under emergency war powers.

- **G7 Oil Reserve Release Proposal:** A proposed coordinated action to inject [400 million barrels](#) of oil into the market to combat the price spike caused by the Hormuz closure.

- **Putin-Trump Call:** A 90-minute call between the [Russian and US presidents](#) regarding the "resolution" of the Iran and Ukraine conflicts.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The End of the "Republic" and the Rise of the Military State The elevation of Mojtaba Khamenei is more than a family succession; it is the culmination of a decade-long shift from a clerical oligarchy to an IRGC-dominated praetorian state. Analysts note that Mojtaba has been the ["man behind the curtain"](#) for 20

years, managing the intelligence and financial committees that bypassed formal government ministries. By placing him at the helm, the IRGC ensures that its "Habib Battalion" networks remain in control of the state's remaining assets. However, this transition carries a massive risk: the [loss of religious legitimacy](#). Traditionally, the Supreme Leader must be a Marja (source of emulation), a status Mojtaba has not achieved, forcing the regime to rely entirely on "force and shadow" rather than the ideological charisma of his predecessors.

The "Strait of Hormuz" Economic Weapon
Iran's strategic logic in expanding the war to its neighbors (Bahrain, UAE, Kuwait) is clearly economic. By making the Persian Gulf [uninsurable and impassable](#), Tehran hopes to trigger a global economic collapse that forces the G7 to restrain Trump and Netanyahu. The strategy is working in the short term, as seen in the [market panic](#). However, the US is countering this by looking toward [lifting Russian sanctions](#) and leveraging Venezuelan oil to decouple the global economy from the Persian Gulf, a shift that could permanently marginalize Middle Eastern energy influence.

The "Human Shield" Strategy and Collateral Damage
A disturbing theme is the emergence of urban areas as primary battlefields. CENTCOM has accused Iran of using [residential zones](#) in Tehran and Shiraz as launch sites for missiles, essentially using the civilian population as a shield. The tragic bombing of the [Minab girls' school](#) highlights the failure of "surgical strike" narratives. Simultaneously, the regime is using the environmental disaster—the [burning oil depots](#)—to keep people indoors, effectively using a public health crisis as a tool for riot control.

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks)

- Expect an intensified "kinetic search" for Mojtaba Khamenei. Israeli officials have hinted he is a [legitimate target](#), and his current location is a state secret. If he is killed shortly after appointment, the regime may collapse into a direct IRGC military junta with no figurehead.
- Protests are likely to migrate from rooftops to streets if fuel and food shortages worsen following the [depot strikes](#).

Medium Term (1-6 Months)

- The US may attempt to execute a "Venezuela Model" in Iran, looking for a [disgruntled insider](#) to lead a transitional government while continuing the "decapitation" of the current leadership.
- Global energy supply chains will undergo a structural shift as [South Korea and Japan](#) (who rely on the Gulf for 80% of their oil) move toward long-term contracts with non-Gulf producers.

Long Term (1-5 Years)

- The "Shiite Crescent" influence may permanently wane. The loss of charisma in leadership (Mojtaba vs. Ali Khamenei/Nasrallah) means regional proxies will likely move toward [local nationalism](#) or religious guidance from Grand Ayatollah Sistani in Iraq, rather than Tehran.
- Iran's nuclear program will either be completely destroyed or the new leadership will [openly pivot to a nuclear weapon](#) as their only survival guarantee.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- **Security Architecture:** Western allies must accelerate the deployment of [THAAD and AEGIS](#) systems to Gulf allies, as Iran's "Vadeh Sadegh 4" wave shows an increased willingness to target non-combatant neighbors to exert economic pressure.
- **Diplomatic Engagement:** Recognition of the Mojtaba leadership should be withheld to maintain leverage. The US "Venezuela Model" hint suggests that [secondary leadership](#) layers should be targeted for defection.
- **Humanitarian Monitoring:** Urgent pressure is needed regarding the [environmental disaster](#) in Tehran; the burning depots represent a massive war crime risk regarding civilian health.

For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Energy Diversification:** The [Strait of Hormuz is no longer a reliable transit point](#). Investments should pivot toward trans-continental pipelines and renewables to mitigate the 30% volatility risks seen this week.
- **Supply Chain Resilience:** Manufacturing reliant on Gulf-produced petrochemicals (e.g., nitrogen fertilizers) should expect [long-term price inflation](#) and potential shortages.
- **Insurance and Risk:** The withdrawal of [maritime insurance](#) from the Gulf necessitates a complete re-evaluation of shipping routes, potentially increasing costs for all consumer goods moving through the Suez-Indian Ocean corridor.
