REPORT: DAY-AT-A-GLANCE



DECAPITATED LEADERSHIP: Mojtaba Khamenei named successor amidst father's death. IRGC consolidates power as a "corporate regency".



INTENSE WAR: "Operation Epic Rage" by US/Israel destroys infrastructure, fuel, & military base. 90% missile reduction claimed.



INTERNAL TERROR: Near-total internet blackout, >1,300 fatalities reported. Judiciary threatens execution for documenting damage. "Garrison atmosphere" in cities.

CRISIS OF SUCCESSION & "GHOST LEADER"



Mojtaba Khamenei: Unseen successor, fueling rumors. US dismisses, Russia welcomes to preserve structure. A "palace coup" by IRGC.

DOMESTIC STABILITY & LAWFARE



JUDICIAL REPRESSION: Death penalty for "hostile collaboration" (e.g., sharing damage videos). Armed units enforce "psychological terror". Fuel & food shortages.

HIGH-PROFILE DEFECTIONS



SYMBOLIC COLLAPSE: Women's national football team members seek asylum in Australia. Regime legitimacy evaporating.

TREND: SYRIANIZATION

Fear of a "Syria-style" collapse with infrastructure destruction & urban poverty. Regime "betting on its own death".



STRATEGIC FORESIGHT & TIMELINE



SHORT TERM (1-4 Weeks)

Catastrophic failure of electrical/fuel systems. "Liberated zones" may emerge in border regions. High-risk of Strait escalation.



MEDIUM TERM (1-6 Months)

Possible "Heroic Flexibility" maneuver or IRGC civil war over resources. Oil market decoupling. Regional reconstruction costs rise.



LONG TERM (1-5 Years)

Current Islamic Republic unlikely to survive. Future: "Fortress Iran" junta or fragmented regions. Redefinition of regional balance favors Israel/US-Arab alliance.

ESCALATION OF "OPERATION EPIC RAGE"



HEAVIEST BOMBARDMENT: US strikes shift to "industrial-military infrastructure" (electrical grids, fuel) to prevent rearmament. Strikes in Tehran & Karaj.

BATTLE FOR THE STRAIT OF HORMUZ



ENERGY SECURITY THREAT: Iran lays mines; US destroys minelaying boats. IRGC vows no oil leaves. Global prices fluctuate, G7 intervenes.

SECURITY ARCHITECTURE & REGIONAL PROJECTION



REGIONAL CONFLAGRATION: Iran launches missiles at neighbors to pressure US withdrawal. Qatar warns Tehran. Conflict rapidly "regionalizing".

Regime's "digital darkness" to control narrative. US/Israel target "narrative centers". Population forced onto Starlink.

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

March 10, 2026, marks a pivotal and potentially terminal phase for the Islamic Republic of Iran. On the [twelfth day of a high-intensity war](#) with the United States and Israel, the Iranian state is attempting to stabilize a decapitated leadership through the appointment of [Mojtaba Khamenei as the third Supreme Leader](#). This hereditary succession, while welcomed by Russia, has been met with immediate [dismissal by the Trump administration](#), which continues to demand unconditional surrender. The domestic landscape is one of extreme duress, characterized by a near-total [internet blackout](#), reports of [over 1,300 fatalities](#), and an atmosphere of "psychological terror" as the judiciary threatens citizens with [execution for documenting military damage](#).

The military conflict has expanded into a regional conflagration. While the Pentagon

claims a [90% reduction in Iran's missile launch capabilities](#), the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) continues to project power through drone swarms and ballistic strikes against [Israel, Bahrain, the UAE, and US assets in Iraq](#). The threat to global energy security reached a critical threshold as the [US identified Iranian mining](#) operations in the Strait of Hormuz, prompting President Trump to threaten strikes that would make it "impossible to rebuild Iran." Simultaneously, the defection of [multiple members of the women's national football team](#) in Australia serves as a high-profile symbol of the regime's evaporating domestic legitimacy and the collapse of its internal discipline.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

- **Crisis of Succession and Leadership Legitimacy**
 - Mojtaba Khamenei has been officially named successor to his father, Ali Khamenei, who was killed in the opening days of the war. Despite the announcement, [Mojtaba has failed to appear](#) or speak publicly, fueling rumors that he was [injured in the initial strikes](#) on the leadership compound.
 - The US administration has expressed "dissatisfaction" with the choice, with Trump suggesting a [preference for an internal leader](#) capable of a peaceful transition, rather than a continuation of the Khamenei dynasty.
 - Russia's Vladimir Putin was the [first foreign leader to congratulate](#) Mojtaba, signaling Moscow's intent to preserve the current regime structure as a strategic counterweight to the US.

• Escalation of "Operation Epic Rage"

- US Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth announced that March 10 would see the [heaviest bombardment to date](#), deploying the "most bombers and intelligence assets" to dismantle Iran's remaining military-industrial base.
- Targeting has shifted from tactical missile batteries to "industrial-military infrastructure" to [prevent future rearmament](#).
- Strikes in Tehran and Karaj have hit [electrical grids and fuel depots](#), leaving large swaths of the capital in darkness and causing [severe fuel shortages](#).

• The Battle for the Strait of Hormuz

- The US reports that Iran has [laid dozens of sea mines](#) in the Strait of Hormuz to create a "defense belt," threatening the transit of 20% of global oil.
- Trump claimed the US [destroyed ten Iranian minelaying boats](#) and warned of a "20-fold increase" in retaliation if the waterway is blocked.
- The IRGC countered, stating it will [not allow "one liter of oil"](#) to leave the region until the war ends.

• High-Profile Defections in Australia

- At least [five to eleven members](#) of the Iranian women's national football team and staff have applied for asylum in Australia following the Asian Cup.
- Iranian officials have accused Australia of ["hostage-taking,"](#) while the Australian Home Affairs Minister confirmed the [granting of humanitarian visas](#) due to threats made by Iranian state media.

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

• Succession & Stability

- The appointment of Mojtaba Khamenei represents a [consolidation of power by the IRGC](#) and the security apparatus (the "Habib Battalion"). Analysis suggests this move is a ["palace coup"](#) designed to prevent internal reformists or moderate factions from seeking a separate peace with the West.
- The regime is utilizing [manufactured "pledges of allegiance"](#) across state media to project a facade of unity despite the chaos.

• Energy Security & Global Markets

- Oil prices [peaked at \\$120 per barrel](#) before retreating to the \$90 range following G7 and IEA discussions regarding the [release of 400 million barrels](#) of strategic reserves.
- Internal Iranian governance is failing to provide basic energy needs, with [hours-long lines for fuel and bread](#) becoming the norm in Tehran.

• Domestic Stability & Lawfare

- The Iranian Judiciary has [operationalized a new phase](#) of legal repression, authorizing the [seizure of property and the death penalty](#) for anyone perceived to be collaborating with "hostile governments"—a definition that now includes sharing videos of bomb damage on social media.
- Armed [motorcycle units are patrolling streets](#), maintaining a "garrison atmosphere" to suppress any potential uprising following the death of Ali Khamenei.

- **Security Architecture & Regional Projection**

- The conflict is rapidly "regionalizing." Iran has launched [missiles at eleven neighboring countries](#) or territories to pressure them into withdrawing support for US operations.
- Qatar has [issued a rare public warning](#) to Tehran, stating that continued attacks on regional infrastructure will force [deeper military integration with the US](#).

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

The Iranian state has shifted from civil governance to [martial law by decree](#). The Judiciary has fast-tracked legislation [intensifying punishments for espionage](#), specifically targeting the use of satellite internet and the dissemination of "unauthorized" imagery.

- **BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED**

- **Intensification of Espionage Penalties:** A decree by the Judiciary Spokesman [authorizing the death penalty](#) for collaboration with the US/Israel, including the act of filming infrastructure damage.
- **Property Confiscation Act:** Mandates the [seizure of assets belonging to Iranians abroad](#) who support the "national movement" or the "enemy front."

- **US Defense Briefing:** Secretary Hegseth and the Joint Chiefs [outlined three goals](#): destruction of missile/drone stocks, elimination of the Iranian Navy, and permanent denial of nuclear weapons.
- **G7 Emergency Meeting:** Finance ministers met to discuss [market interventions](#) to stabilize the global economy against the Strait of Hormuz blockade.
- **IRGC Press Statement:** General Salami's office stated that [negotiations are not on the agenda](#) and that the war will continue until the "attackers repent."

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

- **The Syrianization of Iran**

There is a growing fear among historians and sociologists that Iran is [tracking toward a "Syria-style" collapse](#). - **The "Ghost Leader" and the IRGC Coup**

Mojtaba Khamenei's absence is the defining political vacuum of the day. By naming a leader who [cannot or will not speak](#), the IRGC leadership has effectively created a [corporate regency](#). This "shroud of leadership" allows the military to make all decisions without the oversight of a traditional jurist leader. The [marginalization of moderate figures](#) like Hassan Rouhani, who has issued "complaining" statements, indicates that the regime has fully transitioned into a [military-intelligence junta](#).

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks): Expect a catastrophic failure of the Iranian electrical and fuel distribution systems as the [US shifts to "Phase 2" industrial targets](#). Domestic unrest is likely to remain suppressed by extreme force in Tehran, but [border regions \(Kurdistan, Baluchistan\)](#) may see the emergence of ["liberated zones"](#) as central authority stretches thin. The Strait of Hormuz will remain a high-risk zone for ["accidental" escalation](#) as the US begins potential escort operations.

Medium Term (1-6 Months): The regime may attempt a ["Heroic Flexibility"](#) maneuver through Mojtaba Khamenei to prevent total collapse, but only if the US offers a ["Venezuela-style" exit path](#). If Mojtaba is confirmed dead or incapacitated, a [civil war within the IRGC](#) over the remaining resources is a high-probability scenario. Oil markets will likely decouple from the Iranian supply, but regional [reconstruction costs](#) will begin to weigh on the global economy.

Long Term (1-5 Years): The Islamic Republic, in its current 1979-model form, is unlikely to survive. Whether it is replaced by a [junta-led "fortress Iran"](#) or a fragmented collection of autonomous regions depends on whether the US [deploys ground forces](#) or opts for a ["regime change from within"](#) by supporting internal defectors. The [redefinition of the regional balance](#) will likely favor Israel and a new [US-Arab military alliance](#).

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

- **For International Policy:**

- Formalize a [multilateral naval escort task force](#) for the Strait of Hormuz to prevent a permanent spike in energy costs.
- Establish a ["humanitarian corridor" for high-profile defectors](#) (athletes, diplomats, military officers) to accelerate the regime's internal erosion.
- Coordinate with Russia to define the [limits of Mojtaba Khamenei's recognition](#) to ensure Moscow does not provide a military lifeline to the IRGC.

- **For Private Sector/Investors:**

- **Supply Chain Risk:** Diversify away from any industrial inputs involving the [Persian Gulf petroleum-chemical sector](#) (e.g., nitrogen fertilizers), as regional facilities like [Ruwais in the UAE](#) are now active targets.
- **Compliance Warning:** Be alert to [Iranian state asset seizures](#); firms with significant Iranian expatriate clients may face complex legal requests from Tehran's judiciary.
- **Opportunity:** Anticipate a surge in [decentralized communication technologies](#) and satellite hardware as the Iranian market seeks alternatives to the state-controlled internet.
