

GLOBAL VOLATILITY PEAKS AS IRAN  
WAR ENTERS NEW PHASE OF  
SUCCESSION AND DOMESTIC  
SECURITY RISKS CONVERGE

## DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

---

March 10, 2026, marks a critical pivot point in the 11-day-old conflict between the United States, Israel, and Iran. Following the death of Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei, religious leaders in Tehran have appointed his son, [Mustaba Khamenei](#), as successor. This move signals a likely hardline continuation of the war, even as the Trump administration offers contradictory messaging regarding the conflict's duration. While the U.S. Secretary of War describes the conflict as "just beginning," President Trump has suggested a conclusion could be reached ["soon,"](#) despite the most intense day of air strikes recorded to date. The conflict has triggered severe global market volatility, with crude oil prices fluctuating between \$90 and \$120 per barrel, and has caused an environmental catastrophe in the form of ["toxic oily rain"](#) over Tehran due to the destruction of fuel depots.

Domestically, Canada is grappling with an escalation of national security threats and

economic fragility. A [shooting at the U.S. Consulate](#) in Toronto has been deemed a national security incident, coinciding with the exposure of white supremacist infiltration within the [Canadian military](#). Simultaneously, the "agentic AI" revolution is placing unprecedented strain on Canada's critical infrastructure, particularly water and energy resources required for [hyperscale data centers](#). These geopolitical and technological shifts are occurring against a backdrop of acute domestic crisis, where one in four Canadian households faces food insecurity and the housing market remains largely inaccessible to the middle class, forcing a national conversation on radical solutions like basic income.

## MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

---

### 1. The Iran War: Succession and Escalation

- Mustaba Khamenei has been named the new Supreme Leader of Iran, a move seen as a [bid for continuity](#) by the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC).
- The U.S. has deployed 20-pound penetrator bombs to target [deeply buried missile sites](#), though Iran continues to launch retaliatory strikes against Gulf states, hitting oil refineries in [Abu Dhabi](#) and Bahrain.
- Humanitarian crises are deepening in Lebanon, where over [700,000 people](#) have been displaced due to Israeli strikes on Hezbollah infrastructure.
- The use of [cluster munitions](#) by all parties is increasing, leading to significant civilian risk in residential areas and playgrounds.

## 2. AI Technology: The Rise of Agents and Infrastructure Costs

- The industry is shifting from reactive chatbots to ["agentic AI,"](#) which can autonomously execute tasks like booking travel and managing finances, raising new concerns about [fraudulent transactions](#) and "AI psychosis."
- The environmental cost of AI is surging; Microsoft and Amazon are building [massive data centers](#) in Canada, with some facilities projected to use up to a billion liters of water annually for cooling.
- AI is becoming integrated into Canadian healthcare, with apps like [Plum AI](#) and [medical transcription tools](#) reducing doctor workloads but raising data privacy concerns.

## 3. Canadian National Security and Social Order

- Toronto police and the RCMP are investigating a [shooting at the U.S. Consulate](#) involving suspects in a white Honda CRV; security at Jewish and Israeli sites has been heightened following earlier synagogue shootings.
- Leaked data from a white supremacist dating site, [White Date](#), has identified over 500 Canadians, including active members of the [Canadian military](#) and Air Force working on sensitive projects.
- The federal government reached a deal to allow [TikTok to remain](#) in Canada, following the "European model" of enhanced data protection and third-party monitoring.

## 4. Economic and Food Security Crises

- Food banks report a [40% increase in poverty](#) over the last two years, with many employed Canadians now relying on aid.

- An investigation into ["property controls"](#) reveals that major grocers like Sobeys and Loblaws use lease agreements to block competitors from opening in the same plazas, stifling competition.
- The surge in ["Buy Now, Pay Later"](#) (BNPL) schemes is being used by consumers to pay for essentials like groceries, potentially creating a new debt trap for younger Canadians.

## 5. Historical Justice and Legal Warfare

- The death of Miramichi serial killer [Allan Legier](#) at age 78 brings a sense of closure to New Brunswick, while highlighting long-term fears of his potential release or escape.
- A lawsuit has been filed against Open AI by the family of a [Tumblr Ridge shooting victim](#), alleging the company failed to notify police despite the shooter using Chat GPT to plan a mass casualty event.

## KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

### AI, Technology Policy & Digital Sovereignty

- Governments are struggling to regulate [agentic AI](#) before it gains the capacity to perform fraudulent economic actions without human oversight.
- Quebec's government is piloting [AI medical transcription](#) to address doctor shortages, but the legal responsibility for AI-generated medical errors remains undefined.
- The federal government is balancing national security with digital access in its [TikTok compromise](#), opting for corporate monitoring over a total ban.

## Energy and Economic Security

- The [Strait of Hormuz](#) shutdown has created a supply shock, driving Canadian gas prices up by [20 cents per liter](#) in a single week.
- Fertilizer prices are [surging](#) due to blocked exports of nitrogen and phosphorus from the Middle East, threatening the 2026 Canadian crop yield.
- The "Uncertainty Economy" strategy led by [Mark Carney](#) emphasizes diversifying trade away from the U.S. and toward global markets to build resilience against Trump-era tariffs.

## Domestic Stability & Social Order

- High housing costs are driving [insolvency rates](#), with Saskatchewan leading the country in missed mortgage payments.
- The [basic income](#) debate is intensifying; proponents argue it is the only solution to automation-driven unemployment and the collapse of the social safety net.
- The [childcare crisis](#) in BC has created a "two-tier" system where only 10% of families access \$10/day care, while others pay five times more.

## Critical Infrastructure

- Aging water infrastructure in Canadian cities is not equipped for the ["thirst"](#) of AI data centers, which could consume municipal drinking water at the expense of residential growth.
- Hydro Quebec is using [LiDAR and AI](#) to map and prune trees with surgical precision to prevent mass power outages during storms.

## LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

---

Legislative activity focused on expanding citizenship rights, managing the healthcare crisis through physician payment reform, and addressing the fallout of the Middle East war on Canadian soil through national security protocols.

### BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **Bill C-3 (Lost Canadians Act):** Legislation that allows Americans with [Canadian ancestors](#) to apply for citizenship, regardless of how many generations removed. It has triggered a [surge in applications](#) at national archives.

## DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

### The Weaponization of Uncertainty

Geopolitical instability in Iran is being leveraged by the Trump administration to reorder global energy flows and push for [concessions](#) from allies like Canada. The phenomenon of ["oily rain"](#) in Iran represents a new era of environmental warfare where attacks on energy infrastructure produce long-term ecological and health damage. This is mirrored in the domestic [resource conflict](#) in Canada, where the "blood" of the AI industry—water—is increasingly at odds with the needs of a population struggling with climate-driven scarcity.

## STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

---

### Short Term (1-4 Weeks):

- Expect [gas prices](#) to fluctuate wildly as G7 countries debate releasing emergency oil reserves.
- Heightened civil unrest is likely in Iran as the new leader, Mustaba Khamenei, attempts to consolidate power through [repressive measures](#).
- Security crackdowns within the Canadian Armed Forces will likely follow the exposure of [white supremacist](#) dating profiles.

### Medium Term (1-6 Months):

- Canadian farmers will face a [profitability crisis](#) if fertilizer and fuel prices do not stabilize before the peak seeding season.
- The [agentic AI](#) market will see its first major regulatory "stress test" as the first high-value fraudulent transactions conducted by autonomous agents are reported.
- Quebec's healthcare system may face [closures](#) if a new deal with family doctors is not reached following the suspension of Bill 2.

### Long Term (1-5 Years):

- Canada may be forced to implement a [Basic Income](#) to handle structural unemployment caused by AI automation and the collapse of the low-wage labor market.
- Energy infrastructure will shift toward [solar and indigenous-led](#) projects as remote communities seek to decouple from volatile global diesel markets.

- Structural changes to Canadian citizenship through [Bill C-3](#) could result in a significant "reverse migration" of Americans seeking social stability in Canada.

## RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

---

### For International Policy:

- Security: Urgent need to modernize [Consulate and Embassy](#) protocols to include detection of drone-based and decentralized kinetic threats.
- Diplomatic: Canada must align with G7 partners to ensure the [Strait of Hormuz](#) remains open, using military escorts for tankers if necessary.
- Humanitarian: Increase support for [displaced persons](#) in Lebanon to prevent a wider regional refugee crisis.

### For Private Sector/Investors:

- Supply Chain: Agribusiness must diversify [fertilizer sourcing](#) away from the Persian Gulf to prevent total crop failure.
- Regulatory: AI developers should expect [liability shifts](#) where companies are held legally responsible for "hallucinations" or failure to report imminent threats.
- Investment: High-growth opportunities exist in [non-profit housing](#) and co-op models, as traditional private development fails to meet demand.
