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DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

March 11, 2026, marks the 12th day of a full-scale conflict between Iran and the combined forces of the United States and Israel. Following the assassination of Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei and members of his family, the Iranian state has executed a rapid and stable leadership transition, appointing his son, [Ayatollah Sayyid Mustafa \(Mujtaba\) Khamenei](#), as the new leader. This transition appears to have backfired on US strategic goals of regime change, as millions have reportedly taken to the streets in shows of solidarity, and the [regime's internal cohesion](#) has remained intact despite heavy bombardment of its political and military infrastructure.

Militarily, the conflict has entered a phase of severe attrition and regional expansion. Iran has launched "Operation True Promise 4," involving 39 waves of missile strikes characterized by increasingly heavy warheads, with the IRGC now deploying

[missiles with warheads exceeding two tons](#). In response, the US and Israel are facing critical [shortages of interceptor missiles](#) (Patriot and THAAD systems), necessitating the withdrawal of defense assets from the Pacific and South Korea. Simultaneously, the Lebanese Resistance (Hezbollah) has [re-entered the conflict](#) with massive salvos against northern Israel, prompting retaliatory carpet-bombing of the southern suburbs of Beirut.

The global economic consequences have reached catastrophic levels. The effective closure of the Strait of Hormuz to US and Israeli-linked vessels has forced [major energy producers](#) like Qatar, Kuwait, and Iraq to declare Force Majeure on exports. Oil prices are hovering near \$120 per barrel with predictions of [\\$200 per barrel](#) if hostilities persist. This energy shock is triggering a global recession, particularly impacting European and Asian markets, while the G7 has taken the unprecedented step of authorizing the release of [400 million barrels of oil](#) from reserves to stabilize the market.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

Iran's Generational Leadership Succession

- The 88-member Assembly of Experts, despite being a target of US/Israeli strikes, has successfully elected [Ayatollah Sayyid Mujtaba Khamenei](#) as Supreme Leader, ensuring institutional continuity.
- Public sentiment in Iran has shifted from potential unrest to [unified revolutionary fervor](#), with the assassination of the former leader serving as a catalyst for national mobilization rather than collapse.

Escalation of Operation True Promise 4

- The IRGC has escalated its missile campaign to its 39th wave, specifically [targeting US regional bases](#) in Bahrain, Kuwait, the UAE, and Saudi Arabia.
- Iran has shifted its targeting parameters to include [economic centers and banks](#) in retaliation for the bombing of Iranian financial institutions and civilian infrastructure.
- IRGC Navy commanders claim the US Navy has withdrawn its aircraft carriers [beyond 700 kilometers](#) from Iranian shores to avoid sinking operations.

Global Energy Disruption and Blockade

- The Strait of Hormuz is under effective Iranian naval control, with Iran vowing that "not a single liter" of oil will transit for the [benefit of the US and its allies](#).
- Qatar, Kuwait, and Iraq have [reduced output and declared force majeure](#) due to the inability to secure shipping insurance and safe passage.

US/Israeli Interceptor Crisis

- Reports indicate the US is [running dangerously low](#) on PAC-3 Patriot and SM-3 missiles, forcing a drawdown from the Pacific theater.
- Israeli air defenses are [rationing interceptor missiles](#), allowing heavier Iranian warheads to hit targets including the Ministry of War in Bat Yam and Netanyahu's private residence.

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Succession & Stability

- The appointment of Mujtaba Khamenei represents a [generational shift](#) in the Islamic Republic, potentially leading to a more aggressive defensive posture as the new leader seeks to avenge his family's assassination.
- Despite US claims of imminent collapse, Iranian state organs continue to [function through eight layers](#) of redundant command and control structures.

AI & Cybersecurity

- The "Handalla" hacking group has claimed a massive breach of [Striker Corporation](#), an entity allegedly linked to the US-Israeli defense lobby, wiping 200,000 systems.
- Accusations have surfaced that US targeteers are using [AI to select targets](#), leading to the "double tap" strike on a girls' school in southern Iran that killed 170 children.

Energy Security

- The IEA's record-breaking release of [400 million barrels](#) indicates the depth of the energy crisis and the failure of diplomatic efforts to keep shipping lanes open.
- The disruption of LNG from Qatar is creating a [liquidity and heating crisis](#) in Europe, doubling gasoline prices in the UK within one week.

Strategic Alignment & Bloc Politics

- The conflict has exposed a rift in US-GCC relations, as Gulf states find that hosting US bases [invites Iranian retaliation](#) without guaranteed US protection.

- Russia and China are positioned as [major beneficiaries](#), with Russia providing a stable energy alternative and China acting as a potential mediator to offer the US an "off-ramp."

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

Discussion focused on the legality of war powers and international sanctions. The UN Security Council and European Union have moved to penalize Iran, while internal US dissent focuses on the circumvention of Congressional war powers by the Trump administration.

- **BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED: UN Security Council Resolution (GCC-sponsored):** Demands an immediate end to Iranian attacks on Persian Gulf nations; [approved with 13 votes](#), but its legitimacy is challenged by Iran as it ignores the use of GCC soil by US forces.
- **BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED: EU Sanctions Package:** Imposes new [sanctions on 19 Iranian officials](#) and firms over human rights allegations; dismissed by Tehran as "illegal and immoral" complicity in US aggression.
- **HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS: US Congressional Briefing:** Senator Chris Murphy and Congressman Jason Crow noted that the [justification for the war](#) shifts hourly between regime change and "imminent threats," with Crow warning the military lacks the munitions to sustain the current pace.
- **HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS: Axios Interview with Donald Trump:** The President claimed the war is "far ahead of schedule" and there is [nothing left to target](#) in Iran, a statement contradicted by continued IRGC missile launches.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The Failure of the "Decapitation" Strategy

The primary strategic narrative of the day is the failure of the US "decapitation" strike. Analysts point out that the assassination of the Supreme Leader was intended to create a power vacuum and spark a popular uprising. Instead, the [Iranian constitutional system](#) demonstrated resilience, and the public has rallied around the martyrdom of the Khamenei family. The "Shock and Awe" approach used in previous conflicts has failed to account for Iran's [redundant leadership layers](#) and deep-rooted ideological commitment to the Islamic Republic's survival.

Asymmetric Dominance and Air Defense Attrition

A critical theme is the shifting math of regional defense. Iran's use of relatively inexpensive drones and older missiles to [deplete high-cost US and Israeli interceptors](#) has rendered the "Golden Dome" and Patriot batteries permeable. This has allowed newer, heavy warheads to hit sensitive targets. The US is now [stripping its Pacific stockpiles](#), potentially creating a strategic window for other adversaries like China in the First Island Chain.

The Collapse of the US "Security Umbrella" in the Gulf

A significant trend is the increasing desperation of GCC monarchies. While these nations have traditionally relied on the US for security, the current war has shown that the presence of US bases makes them [legitimate targets for Iran](#). Iran's strategy of warning regional neighbors to "stay 1 kilometer away"

from US/Israeli assets has effectively [forced a reconsideration](#) of the US military presence in the Middle East, with several nations mulling temporary evacuations of US personnel.

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks)

- Expected shift in [Iranian nuclear doctrine](#): With the death of the leader who issued the fatwa against nuclear weapons, the new council may authorize the final assembly of warheads using Iran's 450kg stockpile of 60% enriched uranium.
- Likely [total collapse](#) of the Lebanese economy as Israel targets national infrastructure in an attempt to force the Lebanese Army to disarm Hezbollah.

Medium Term (1-6 Months)

- A global [energy-led depression](#) is probable if the Strait of Hormuz remains contested, potentially leading to the use of the 25th Amendment in the US if the war's domestic economic impact becomes untenable.
- Russia may move to [take Odessa](#) and render Ukraine landlocked while the US is militarily overextended in West Asia.

Long Term (1-5 Years)

- The permanent [removal of US military hegemony](#) in the Persian Gulf as regional states pivot toward a security architecture guaranteed by Iran, China, and Russia.
- Potential [disintegration of Israel's "edge"](#) as its inability to defeat a peer competitor leads to mass exodus of its settler population and internal political fracturing.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy

- **Diplomatic Neutrality:** Nations dependent on Persian Gulf energy should immediately [pursue independent energy corridors](#) through Russia or Central Asia, as the US security umbrella is currently a liability.
- **Humanitarian Compliance:** International bodies must urgently address the reported [use of unconstrained AI](#) in urban targeting to prevent further mass casualty events in civilian areas.
- **Nuclear Non-Proliferation:** Urgent engagement with the new Iranian leadership is required to prevent a [strategic shift toward weaponization](#) in the wake of the previous leader's death.

For Private Sector/Investors

- **Asset Relocation:** Investors in Dubai, Doha, and Manama must account for the [permanent change in regional dynamics](#), as these cities are no longer insulated from Iranian-US hostilities.
- **Sovereign Debt Risk:** The move by Japan to [divest from US Treasury bonds](#) signals a potential crisis in the US dollar's status as a safe-haven currency during high-intensity conflict.
- **Supply Chain Diversification:** Manufacturing sectors must pivot away from reliance on LNG and oil transiting the Strait of Hormuz, treating it as a [long-term blocked zone](#) regardless of short-term ceasefire rumors.
