## DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

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March 12, 2026, marks the 13th day of an unprecedented regional war initiated by the joint US-Israeli "decapitation strikes" against the Islamic Republic of Iran. The primary strategic development is the successful consolidation of Iranian governance following the martyrdom of Ayatollah Sayid Ali Khamenei. The 88-member Assembly of Experts has [elected Ayatollah Sayid Mujtaba Khamenei](#) as the third Leader of the Islamic Revolution. This transition has debunked Western intelligence projections of a power vacuum or internal collapse. Instead, the new leadership has adopted an aggressive posture, signaling a shift from "strategic patience" to a doctrine of "regret-inducing defense" that targets US and Israeli assets across the entire Persian Gulf and Levant.

On the military front, the IRGC has launched the 42nd wave of "Operation True Promise 4," utilizing advanced drones and heavy ballistic missiles with warheads exceeding [one ton in](#)

[weight](#). Simultaneously, the maritime blockade of the Strait of Hormuz has effectively paralyzed 20% of the global oil supply, driving Brent crude prices toward \$120 per barrel. Major energy firms, including TotalEnergies, have [halted production in Qatar, Iraq, and the UAE](#) due to security risks. In Lebanon, the conflict has widened as Israel issued a mass evacuation order for residents south of the Zahrani River, effectively attempting to carve out a deeper buffer zone in response to sustained Hezbollah rocket fire and successful ground repulsions.

The day's narrative is defined by a sharp divide between Western media reports focusing on "regime engineering" and the ground reality of a hybrid war that is depleting US and Israeli munitions stockpiles. Reports indicate that the US is [rationing interceptor missiles](#) and withdrawing THAD and Patriot systems from strategic locations like South Korea to fill gaps in West Asian defenses. As International Quds Day approaches, the axis of resistance appears to be leveraging the conflict to catalyze a broader "global uprising" against the current regional security architecture.

## MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

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### 1. Formal Succession and First Message of Ayatollah Mujtaba Khamenei

- The Assembly of Experts formally elected Mujtaba Khamenei to succeed his father, emphasizing his military background and status as a "gatekeeper" to the previous leadership. [His military service](#) in the Iran-Iraq war is being highlighted to bolster his credentials among the IRGC.

- In his first public address, the new leader emphasized national unity and warned that Iran would [seize or destroy equivalent assets](#) if the US and Israel refuse to pay war reparations for infrastructure damage.
- The address specifically targeted regional states, "advising" them to shut down US bases to avoid further collateral damage, while maintaining that Iran seeks [friendly relations with its 15 neighbors](#).

## 2. Escalation of "Operation True Promise 4"

- The IRGC and Hezbollah have conducted coordinated strikes against US and Israeli targets, specifically focusing on "blinding" the [US and Zionist radar networks](#).
- Iranian intelligence claims to have successfully targeted US officers in [residential compounds in Bahrain and Kuwait](#).
- The use of heavy missiles such as the Emad, Khaibar Shekan, and Fattah has increased, with the IRGC vowing to no longer use warheads [weighing less than one ton](#).

## 3. Global Energy Crisis and Maritime Blockade

- The Strait of Hormuz remains "effectively closed," with the US Navy [admitting it cannot currently provide escorts](#) for commercial shipping despite President Trump's earlier promises.
- Major producers like Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, and the UAE have been forced to [reduce oil production](#) due to a lack of storage capacity and the inability to export through the blocked straits.

- The US Energy Secretary has warned that the Strategic Petroleum Reserve may [only last for weeks](#), not months, under current consumption and disruption levels.

## 4. Israeli Ground Incursions and Buffer Zone Expansion

- Israel has expanded its evacuation orders in Lebanon [to the Zahrani River](#), shifting the conflict focus beyond the Litani River.
- Hezbollah claims to have defeated Israeli "special brigades" attempting to penetrate southern Lebanon, maintaining a high volume of [rocket fire into 18 settlements](#).
- Reports from Beirut confirm Israeli strikes on civilian centers, including [Ramlet al-Baida](#), a beach area used by displaced persons.

## 5. US Munitions Scarcity and Logistics Shifts

- The US is facing a severe shortage of aerial defense interceptors, reportedly [withdrawing Patriot systems from South Korea](#) to support the Israeli front.
- Pentagon spending is projected to reach [up to \\$95 billion](#) for direct military costs if the war continues, with three fighter jets already lost in Kuwait.
- Aerial refueling tankers are being concentrated at Ben Gurion Airport, [transforming it into a hub](#) for long-range operations.

## KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

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### Succession & Stability

- The election of Mujtaba Khamenei was finalized within days of the assassination, utilizing [contingency procedures in the constitution](#) to prevent a power struggle. The role of the 88-member Assembly of Experts was central to this legitimization process.
- Domestic stability in Iran is being framed through the lens of the "children of Ramadan," with state media emphasizing that [people are returning to Iran](#) from the diaspora to defend the nation.

### Energy Security

- The "oil weapon" is being deployed with total effect; Iran has stated that ["not a single liter of oil"](#) will pass the Strait of Hormuz if Iranian ports are targeted.
- TotalEnergies' halt in production in Iraq and Qatar suggests a [withdrawal of Western capital](#) from the region's energy infrastructure as security guarantees evaporate.

### National Security & Security Architecture

- Iran is reportedly opening "new fronts" where the enemy has [little experience and high vulnerability](#). This includes the deployment of underwater drones/swarms to target tankers.
- The IRGC claims to have destroyed the [Green Pine radar system](#) and Elta systems in Israel, significantly degrading the "Iron Dome" effectiveness.

## Statecraft & Financial Resilience

- Iran is pivoting toward "war reparations" as a diplomatic tool, threatening to [seize US assets](#) globally to pay for local damage. This represents a new form of legal warfare (lawfare).
- Despite sanctions, Iran reportedly transferred [11 million barrels of oil to China](#) recently, indicating an bypass of the blockade via alternative routes or prior agreements.

## Diplomatic Engagement & Bloc Politics

- The "G2" concept is being rejected by China; officials in Beijing state that [all countries should be equal](#), signaling a refusal to help the US mitigate its prestige loss in West Asia.
- The UN Security Council's condemnation of Iran is being dismissed by Tehran as ["garbage of history"](#) due to its silence on the Gaza genocide.

## LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

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Governance activity has shifted entirely to emergency executive orders and military councils. The Iranian Parliament has effectively ceded immediate tactical control to the [Supreme National Defense Council](#), while the Assembly of Experts concluded its most significant constitutional task in decades. In the US, the administration is facing internal criticism over the [legality of the unprovoked strikes](#) and the potential for a "false flag" incident to justify boots on the ground.

## **DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES**

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**The End of "Plausible Deniability"** The conflict has moved past the era of proxy wars. The direct [US-Israeli targeting of Iranian schools](#) (Minab) and leadership has forced Iran to abandon its previous caution. This is visible in the IRGC's transition to "True Promise" operations, which are no longer symbolic but intended for ["utter destruction"](#) of command centers.

**The Fragility of the "Petrodollar" Security Umbrella** The GCC states are experiencing a

realization that the US cannot protect their [energy infrastructure from indigenous threats](#). The withdrawal of THAD and Patriot systems to focus on Israel has left regional allies feeling [vulnerable and exposed](#). This is driving a nascent "re-alignment" toward Iran's advice of shutting down foreign bases to secure regional peace.

**Cognitive Warfare and Information Sovereignty** Tehran is winning the "cognitive war" among the global south by contrasting Western "human rights" rhetoric with the reality of [170 children killed in Minab](#). Meanwhile, social media is eroding Western narrative control; footage of [Iranian missiles hitting Tel Aviv](#) is circumventing Israeli censorship, leading to a "morale breakdown" among settler populations.

## **STRATEGIC FORESIGHT**

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### **Short Term (1-4 Weeks)**

- International Quds Day (March 13) will likely see [massive unrest in London, Nigeria, and the Arab world](#), potentially leading to the opening of the "new fronts" mentioned by the Iranian leadership.
- Expect a ["false flag" incident](#) on US soil, as predicted by Iranian officials, to counteract the massive disapproval of the war (currently at 55% in some US polls).

### **Medium Term (1-6 Months)**

- The US midterms will be a "breaking point" for current policy. The projected [Republican defeat in the House and Senate](#) could lead to an abrupt US withdrawal or an off-ramp, as the economic cost of \$95B becomes unsustainable.

- Israel will face a critical munitions exhaustion; without the US [plugging holes in their inventory](#), the Iron Dome will become a legacy system rather than an active defense.

### Long Term (1-5 Years)

- A permanent shift in the regional security architecture. The "Greater Israel" project is [facing an existential hurdle](#) in the form of a more militarized and unified Iran-Lebanon-Iraq axis.
- China and Russia will likely emerge as the primary [mediators and infrastructure partners](#) in a post-US West Asia, especially as US prestige "crumbles" under military failure.

- Shift humanitarian focus to Lebanon, where a ["Vichy-style" government](#) is failing to protect its citizens from mass displacement.

### For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Supply Chain Risk:** Diversify all energy-dependent operations away from the Persian Gulf. The [halt in TotalEnergies' production](#) is a leading indicator of regional abandonment.
- **Inflation Hedging:** Prepare for long-term oil price volatility. If the Strait remains closed for months, [global inflation could spike by 40%](#).
- **Regulatory/Sanctions Compliance:** Monitor the "war reparations" doctrine. Iran may [seize corporate assets](#) of US-aligned firms to settle "debts" incurred from the bombing campaign.
