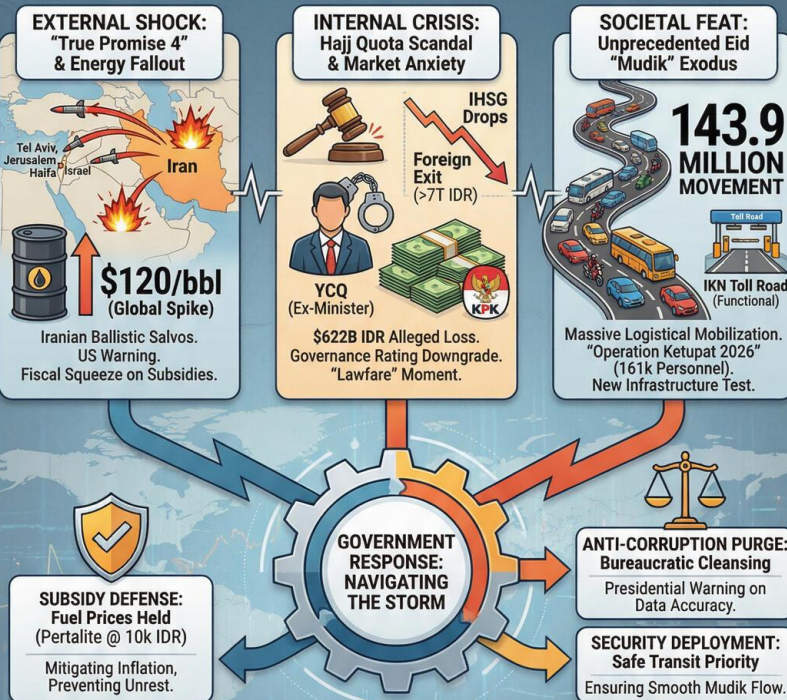

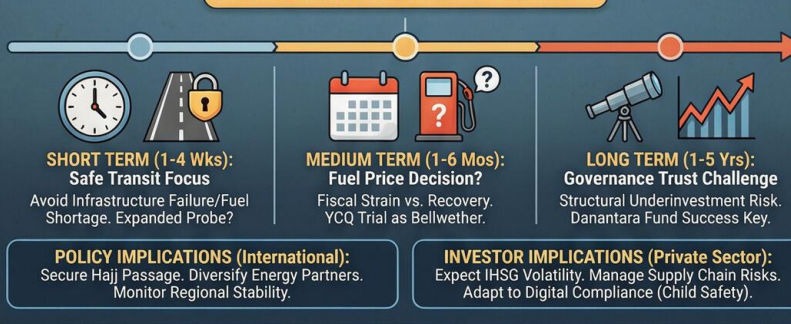

## DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

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March 12, 2026, was defined by a volatile convergence of international military escalation in the Middle East and a significant domestic anti-corruption purge in Indonesia. Globally, the conflict between Iran, Israel, and the United States entered a dangerous new phase with "Operation True Promise 4," involving massive Iranian ballistic missile salvos against Israeli urban centers and U.S. regional assets. While the Trump administration claimed to have neutralized Iranian capabilities, the subsequent spike in global oil prices to nearly \$120 per barrel has forced the Indonesian government into defensive fiscal posturing to maintain domestic fuel subsidies and prevent social unrest during the holy month of Ramadan.

Domestically, the arrest and detention of former Religious Affairs Minister Yakut Cholil Qoumas by the Corruption Eradication Commission (KPK) regarding the 2023 Hajj

quota scandal has sent shockwaves through the political establishment. This development coincides with a period of intense economic anxiety, as the Indonesia Stock Exchange (IHSG) faces pressure from a downgrade in governance ratings by MSCI and other global agencies. Meanwhile, the state is mobilizing for an unprecedented logistical feat: the management of 143.9 million citizens participating in the annual "Mudik" exodus, requiring a massive deployment of security personnel and the functional opening of new infrastructure, including the toll roads serving the new capital, IKN.

## MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

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### The "True Promise 4" Escalation and Global Energy Fallout

- Iran launched the 40th wave of its offensive, utilizing [ballistic missiles](#) including the Qodor and Fatah models against Tel Aviv, Jerusalem, and Haifa.
- U.S. President Donald Trump warned that the U.S. military could make Iran [impossible to rebuild](#) if escalation continues, despite Iranian claims of successful strikes on the Al-Azraq and Al-Harj bases.
- Global oil prices surged toward \$120 per barrel following attacks on [fuel depots](#) in Bahrain and Oman, though Indonesian officials noted a recent stabilization back toward \$100.

### The Fall of Yakut Cholil Qoumas (YCQ)

- The KPK officially detained former Minister Yakut Cholil Qoumas for [20 days](#) following the rejection of his pre-trial motion by the South Jakarta District Court.

- Investigation reveals a corruption scheme involving the [misallocation of Hajj quotas](#), where additional quotas meant for regular pilgrims were sold to special interest groups for fees reaching \$5,000 per person.
- The state claims a total loss of [622 billion IDR](#), with investigators seizing over 100 billion IDR in foreign and domestic currency.

## Financial Market Volatility and Governance Concerns

- The IHSG suffered drastical drops following warnings from [MSCI and Moody's](#) regarding Indonesian corporate and sovereign governance standards.
- Foreign investors have exited the market in significant numbers, with [outflows exceeding 7 trillion IDR](#) in early 2026 as the premium previously enjoyed by the market shifted to a "geopolitical discount."

## Logistical Mobilization for Mudik 2026

- The government expects [143.9 million movements](#) during the Eid al-Fitr period, leading to the launch of "Operation Ketupat 2026" involving 161,243 joint personnel.
- Key infrastructure projects, including the [IKN toll road section 1B](#), have been opened functionally to alleviate traffic congestion in East Kalimantan.

## KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

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### Corruption & Governance

- The detention of YCQ represents a high-stakes "lawfare" moment for the current administration, signaling an attempt to [cleanse the bureaucracy](#) of systemic corruption related to religious services.
- President Prabowo issued a stern warning to all officials against [manipulating reports](#) to please leadership, demanding factual accuracy in all state data.

### Economic Security & Resilience

- Bank Indonesia (BI) maintained the [interest rate at 4.75%](#) to support growth amidst global liquidity tightening and a rupiah that briefly touched 17,000 per USD.
- The national budget (APBN) recorded a [deficit of 0.53%](#) as of February 2026, though revenue from taxes grew by 30%, indicating a recovery in the real sector that has not yet been reflected in panicky financial markets.

### Energy Security

- The Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources (ESDM) guaranteed that [Pertalite prices](#) will remain at 10,000 IDR per liter until the end of Q1 2026 to mitigate inflation.
- National fuel stocks are reported to be [secure for 23 days](#), with continuous production aimed at preventing "panic buying" during the Eid travel peak.

## Digital Sovereignty & Child Safety

- The Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Communication and Digitalization have moved to enforce [PP Tunas](#) and Permen Komdigi No. 9/2026 to combat digital addiction among children, citing that 10% of children show signs of mental health issues due to excessive social media use.

## LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

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Governance activity focused on implementing the 2026 budget priorities and refining regulations for emerging social and infrastructure challenges. Policy shifts in energy subsidies and digital safety for minors were central to the day's legislative discussions.

### BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **PP Tunas & Permen Komdigi No. 9/2026:** New regulations aimed at creating safe [digital boundaries](#) for children and mitigating the cognitive impacts of screen addiction.
- **Hajj Law Revisions (Implied):** Following the YCQ scandal, discussions between the [Ministry of Religion and Commission VIII](#) emphasized adhering strictly to the 92% regular and 8% special quota split dictated by existing law.
- **APBN 2026 Deficit Management:** Adjustments to handle a projected [2.68% annual deficit](#) while maintaining fuel and electricity subsidies.

### HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS:

- **KPK Press Briefing on YCQ:** Asep Guntur Rahayu detailed the [flow of funds](#) and the "priority fee" system used to bypass the Hajj waiting list.

- **Presidential Address at Danantara Anniversary:** Prabowo highlighted a [300% increase](#) in the return on assets for the Danantara sovereign fund, while demanding transparency from his subordinates.
- **DPR Commission VIII Meeting:** Minister of Hajj and Umrah Muhammad Irfan Yusuf presented [three contingency scenarios](#) for the 2026 Hajj, including possible cancellation if the Middle East conflict renders Saudi airspace unreachable.

## DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

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### Strategic "Decoupling" of Real and Financial Sectors

A notable trend is the divergence between Indonesia's real economy and its financial markets. While tax revenues and retail sales, including [car sales](#), are showing positive growth, the stock market is suffering from a "crisis of guidance." Analysts argue that the lack of clear policy frameworks from the new Finance Minister and the central bank governor has left [investors fearful](#), even as fundamental data suggests a recovery is underway.

### Logistical Nationalism and IKN Legitimacy

The functional opening of [IKN toll roads](#) for the Mudik season serves a dual purpose: practical traffic management and symbolic legitimacy for the new capital. By integrating the new city into the nation's most sacred annual migration, the government is attempting to weave IKN into the social fabric of the country, despite ongoing concerns about construction delays and the high cost of the project.

## Consumption Paradox of Ramadan

Despite the religious philosophy of restraint, Ramadan 2026 is seeing a [surge in consumerism](#), with food waste becoming a critical issue. Experts from BRIN noted that while inflation rose to 4% in February, this is viewed as a sign of [strong purchasing power](#). However, the environmental impact—exemplified by the waste piles at [Bantar Gebang](#)—is creating a sustainability crisis that contradicts the "circular economy" goals the state nominally promotes.

## STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

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**Short Term (1-4 Weeks):** The focus will remain on the safe transit of 144 million people. Any major [infrastructure failure](#) or fuel shortage during this period could trigger significant social unrest. Expect the KPK to expand its probe into the Hajj scandal, potentially targeting travel agencies and lower-level ministry officials.

**Medium Term (1-6 Months):** The government must decide whether to adjust fuel prices after the Q1 [subsidy commitment](#) expires. If the Iran-Israel conflict sustains oil prices above \$110, the fiscal strain may force a price hike, potentially slowing the real sector recovery observed in early 2026. The trial of YCQ will serve as a bellwether for judicial independence.

**Long Term (1-5 Years):** The "governance discount" noted by MSCI could lead to structural underinvestment in Indonesian equities if the state does not implement [transparent policy guidance](#). The success of the Danantara fund in consolidating state assets will determine if Indonesia can fund its ambitious "Asta Cita" programs without further inflating national debt.

## RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

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### For International Policy:

- Diplomatic efforts should prioritize securing [safe passage](#) for the upcoming Hajj season, as the potential cancellation for 200,000+ citizens would be a major domestic stability risk.
- Deepen energy partnerships with non-Middle East suppliers to buffer against [Strait of Hormuz](#) closures.
- Monitor the potential for a regional refugee crisis or evacuation needs for [Indonesian citizens](#) in Iran and Lebanon.

### For Private Sector/Investors:

- Investors should prepare for [continued volatility](#) in the IHSG until a clear fiscal-monetary framework is articulated by the Prabowo administration.
- The consumer goods sector should expect a high-volume but high-risk period during Mudik, with supply chains vulnerable to [infrastructure bottlenecks](#) in North Sumatra and Central Java.
- Companies in the digital space must adapt to [stricter compliance](#) regarding child-targeted content and usage limits as the government prioritizes mental health over digital engagement metrics.
