





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THE IRANIAN CONFLICT ENTERS A CRITICAL PHASE AS MOJTABA KHAMENEI ASCENDS TO THE LEADERSHIP UNDER HEAVY FIRE WHILE US-ISRAELI STRIKES DECIMATE MILITARY INFRASTRUCTURE.

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

On the fourteenth day of a full-scale military conflict between a US-Israeli coalition and the Islamic Republic of Iran, the geopolitical landscape has shifted toward a volatile state of urban warfare and decapitation strikes. Following the death of Ali Khamenei fourteen days ago, his second son, Mojtaba Khamenei, has been named the third Supreme Leader. However, his ascension is marred by reports of severe injuries sustained during coalition strikes; US Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth reported that Mojtaba may have [lost a limb](#) and is currently managing state affairs from a medical facility. The internal stability of the regime is under extreme duress, with the IRGC threatening a crackdown more brutal than the "January 8th" massacre to suppress any potential [urban uprisings](#) sparked by the coalition's campaign.

Strategically, the US and Israel have shifted their focus toward degrading the Iranian security apparatus and nuclear potential. The Pentagon claims to have struck over 15,000 targets, including [6,000 military sites](#) and 90% of Iran's naval and aerial capabilities. Despite these losses, Iran continues to leverage its regional proxies and its control over the Strait of Hormuz to exert economic pressure on the West. The closure of the Strait has pushed oil prices toward \$100 per barrel, prompting President Trump to release strategic reserves and temporarily ease sanctions on [Russian oil sales](#) to stabilize global markets. Meanwhile, regional tensions are peaking as Turkey intercepted its third Iranian ballistic missile and a US tanker aircraft crashed in Iraq, killing all six [crew members](#).

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

Succession and Leadership Crisis

- Mojtaba Khamenei was officially named the third Supreme Leader, marking a transition to hereditary rule that has been criticized as "Moroosi" (dynastic) even [within the regime](#).
- Mojtaba has reportedly survived [two assassination attempts](#): one in the bunker where his father was killed and a second "special operation" strike on the hospital where he was being treated.
- Mark Fitzpatrick of the IISS suggests Mojtaba's appointment is a strategic "worst-case" for the US, as his radical reputation prevents the Trump administration from claiming a quick [diplomatic victory](#).

Military Escalation and Strategic Strikes

- Israeli forces have expanded their target list to include [urban security infrastructure](#), specifically targeting IRGC checkpoints in Tehran to facilitate a civilian uprising.
- Major strikes have been confirmed on ballistic missile production facilities in Shiraz and IRGC ground force [headquarters in Ahvaz](#).
- Symbolic damage was reported at Tehran's Azadi Tower, where the [cafe-gallery](#) was destroyed by the shockwave of a nearby explosion.
- US forces are deploying an amphibious task force, including 2,500 Marines and [F-35 components](#), from Japan to the Persian Gulf to prepare for potential special operations.

Regional Proxy Warfare and Spillover

- Hezbollah and the IRGC have integrated their command structures to launch [coordinated attacks](#) on Israel using Khurramshahr and Emad ballistic missiles.
- A French soldier was killed in a [drone attack](#) on a joint base in Iraqi Kurdistan, marking the first European combat fatality of the war.
- Turkey's relationship with Iran has soured significantly following the interception of a [third ballistic missile](#) over Turkish airspace, which Ankara termed a "dangerous provocation."

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Elite Politics and Leadership Dynamics

The ascension of Mojtaba Khamenei represents the total consolidation of power by the "Habib Brigade"—a secretive circle of security and intelligence figures including Hossein Taeb and [Ali Asghar Hejazi](#). This

group now operates as a "underground government," managing the war from bunkers while Mojtaba remains invisible to the public, raising questions about whether he is [truly in control](#) or merely a figurehead for a military junta.

Digital Sovereignty and Cybersecurity

Iran has implemented a total "digital darkness" policy, with global internet access cut for over [300 consecutive hours](#). Reports indicate that this infrastructure was built with significant [Chinese technical assistance](#), mirroring Beijing's centralized "Cyberspace Administration." The blackout is being used to prevent citizens from seeing Israeli evacuation warnings and to stifle the coordination of domestic protests.

Energy Security

The global economy is reeling from the [Hormuz blockade](#). While oil prices have fluctuated, the sustained closure of a channel that carries 20% of global fossil fuels has forced the US to seek an emergency deal to release [strategic reserves](#). Analysts warn that if Iran targets the oil fields of Saudi Arabia or the UAE, prices will enter an [unprecedented spike](#).

Domestic Stability and Social Order

Tehran has become a "city of the dead" with businesses closed and banks failing to [provide cash](#). Despite this, the regime forced a public showing for Quds Day, where officials like Masoud Pezeshkian and Ali Larijani marched even as [explosions rocked](#) nearby neighborhoods. Security forces are deploying black armored vehicles and Dushkas (heavy machine guns) in major squares to [intimidate the populace](#).

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

The day was dominated by high-level military briefings and executive statements from

Washington and Tel Aviv regarding the conduct of the war and the legal justifications for targeting Iranian state infrastructure. Discussion in the US Congress has turned toward the "Venezualization" of the Iranian conflict—an attempt to swap the regime's oil for [humanitarian stability](#).

HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS

- Pentagon Press Briefing: Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth announced the [appointment of an independent officer](#) (outside of CENTCOM) to investigate the strike on the Minab girls' school, which resulted in 167 deaths.
- President Trump's Fox News Interview: The President claimed that "very hard hits" are scheduled for the coming week and predicted the [eventual fall](#) of the regime, while dismissing questions about ground troops as "stupid."
- Israeli Defense Forces (IDF) Statement: The IDF confirmed the deliberate targeting of [Basij checkpoints](#) as part of a strategy to "deepen the blow" against the regime's repressive apparatus.
- Turkish Ministry of Defense: Issued a formal demand for an [explanation from Tehran](#) regarding ballistic missiles violating its airspace, threatening "decisive measures."

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

THIS IS CREATING A "CIVILIAN TRAP" WHERE NON-COMBATANTS ARE KEPT IN TARGET ZONES TO SERVE AS HUMAN SHIELDS OR TO MAXIMIZE INTERNATIONAL OUTCRY AGAINST THE COALITION.

THE END OF IRANIAN REPUBLICANISM THE SWIFT APPOINTMENT OF MOJTABA KHAMENEI, BYPASSING THE ASSEMBLY OF EXPERTS AND ANY DEMOCRATIC VENEER, HAS FUNDAMENTALLY TRANSFORMED THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC INTO A

HEREDITARY [SECURITY STATE](#). THIS HAS ALIENATED TRADITIONAL REGIME "INSIDERS" LIKE HASSAN ROUHANI AND THE KHOMEINI FAMILY, WHO HAVE ISSUED [VEILED GRIEVANCES](#) ABOUT THE STATE'S DIRECTION.

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks) Expect a massive surge in coalition strikes as the Trump administration attempts to meet a [one-week deadline](#) given to Israel to conclude major operations. Urban conditions in Tehran will likely deteriorate into a humanitarian crisis as [3 million](#) internally displaced persons struggle with food and fuel shortages. The IRGC may initiate "counter-protest" massacres to maintain street control.

Medium Term (1-6 Months) The conflict is likely to settle into a "war of attrition" centered on the Strait of Hormuz. Unless US Marines successfully [occupy Iranian coastlines](#) or the Kharg Island terminal, global oil markets will remain volatile. The legitimacy of Mojtaba Khamenei will face its sternest test as he must eventually [appear in public](#) to prove he is fit to lead.

Long Term (1-5 Years) Regardless of the war's outcome, the "Digital Silk Road" partnership with China will likely become Iran's [primary governance model](#), focusing on total technological surveillance and a closed national intranet. If the regime survives, it will be as a heavily militarized, nuclear-capable state with almost zero [public legitimacy](#).

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- The international community must pressure Tehran to restore internet access to facilitate the [evacuation of civilians](#) from military target zones.
- Diplomatic channels through Turkey and Oman should be used to prevent a [nuclear "breakout"](#) by the regime in its final stages of desperation.
- Coalition partners must coordinate on the [Russian oil exemption](#) to prevent a total collapse of European and Asian industrial economies.

For Private Sector/Investors:

- Supply chains dependent on the Persian Gulf (nitrogen fertilizers, [aluminum, and helium](#)) should seek alternative sources immediately as the Hormuz blockade shows no signs of lifting.
- Defense and satellite infrastructure companies should prepare for increased demand for "anti-space" and [anti-satellite technologies](#) as China simulates attacks on the Starlink network in support of Iranian goals.
- Financial institutions should hedge against a prolonged period of [market volatility](#) in East Asia, particularly in Tokyo and Seoul, which are most vulnerable to energy shocks.
