DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

On March 16, 2026, the seventeenth day of what Iranian state media has dubbed the "Ramadan War," the Islamic Republic projected a narrative of strategic victory, domestic resilience, and ideological continuity. Following the recent death of the "martyred leader" Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, the state has aggressively promoted the smooth succession of his son, [Ayatollah Seyyed Mojtaba Khamenei](#), as the third leader of the Revolution. This transition is being framed as a failure of U.S. intelligence, which reportedly anticipated a regime collapse. Instead, Iran is using massive public rallies and Quds Day demonstrations to demonstrate a unified front, even as U.S. and Israeli airstrikes target civilian and military infrastructure across the country.

Strategically, Iran has escalated its asymmetric campaign, moving into waves 55 through 57 of "Operation True Promise 4."

These operations utilize a mix of high-speed hypersonic missiles and low-cost "Arash" and "Hadid" drones to [exhaust U.S. and Israeli air defense](#) interceptors. Key targets include Israeli defense contractors (Rafael) and critical U.S. logistics hubs in the UAE, Bahrain, and Saudi Arabia. The most significant strategic lever remains the "smart" closure of the Strait of Hormuz. By demanding oil payments in Chinese Yuan and restricting transit, Iran has successfully triggered a global energy crisis, with [oil prices surging toward \\$150](#) per barrel, effectively isolating the Trump administration from its traditional allies in Europe and Asia who are now seeking direct negotiations with Tehran.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

Operation True Promise 4: Waves 55-57

- The IRGC and Army have launched successive waves of missile and drone strikes targeting the [Rafael and IAI defense complexes](#) in Israel and the Ben Gurion airport area.
- Strikes targeted the [Al-Dhafra base in the UAE](#), Sheikh Isa in Bahrain, and the Kharij base in Saudi Arabia, specifically focusing on U.S. fuel depots and "tanker" aircraft.
- The IRGC utilized the "Sejjil" solid-fuel missile for the first time in this conflict, a weapon [described as a "nightmare"](#) for Israeli planners due to its speed and multi-warhead capability.

Global Economic Warfare and the Strait of Hormuz

- Iran has implemented a policy allowing only tankers paying in [Chinese Yuan to transit](#) the Strait of Hormuz, a move analysts call more "deadly than a military defeat" for the U.S. dollar.

- Global supply chains are fracturing as [urea and fertilizer prices](#) jump by 23-30%, threatening the spring planting season in the U.S. and Canada.
- Nations including France, Italy, and China are reportedly [bypassing Washington to negotiate](#) directly with Tehran for safe passage of their vessels.

The "Minab School" Narrative and Lawfare

- Iran is centering its international legal and media campaign on a reported strike on a [girls' school in Minab](#) that allegedly killed 170-175 students.
- The Judiciary and Ministry of Foreign Affairs are coordinating with UNESCO and international NGOs to document the incident as a [primary symbol of U.S.-Israeli war crimes](#).

Domestic Wartime Governance

- The Supreme Council of Labor announced a [60% increase in the minimum wage](#) for the year 1405 (2026) to mitigate the impact of wartime inflation on the working class.
- The government has tripled the distribution of [basic goods for Ramadan](#) compared to the previous year to ensure domestic stability.

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Succession and Stability The rapid elevation of [Ayatollah Seyyed Mojtaba Khamenei](#) is the central political event. State media emphasizes his "40 years of preparation" and his immediate command of military and intelligence apparatuses, countering Western narratives of a power vacuum.

Energy Security The control of the Strait of Hormuz is being used as a strategic "kill switch" for the global economy. Iran claims the [U.S. has exhausted its strategic reserves](#) and is unable to force the waterway open.

Coalition Cohesion Iran is highlighting the [refusal of NATO allies](#) (Australia, Japan, France, Canada) to join Trump's naval coalition in the Persian Gulf. This is framed as the end of U.S. regional hegemony.

Economic Security The government is maintaining a "business as usual" front. The Central Bank has [increased ATM withdrawal limits](#) to 5 million Rials and suspended penalties for bounced checks to prevent a liquidity crisis.

Critical Infrastructure The Civil Defense Organization (Passive Defense) reports that despite [150 serious incidents](#) involving power grids and infrastructure, "recovery teams" are restoring services in under two hours.

Labor and Industry A massive wage hike (60%) and the "Mother's Hope Card" (2 million Rials for newborns) were launched during the war to [bolster the "home front"](#) and prevent civil unrest.

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

Governance during the "Ramadan War" has focused on rapid executive decrees to manage a command economy and social welfare, while the Judiciary prepares for post-war "lawfare" against domestic and foreign enemies.

BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **1405 Minimum Wage Decree:** A 60% increase in the monthly minimum wage to [roughly 22 million Rials](#) for single workers and 24 million for those with children.

- **Mother's Hope Card:** A new social welfare policy providing [2 million Rials per child](#) born in the new year to support "population youth" goals despite the conflict.
- **Customs Duty Waivers:** A 72-hour [grace period for port fines](#) was established to speed up the offloading of 6 million tons of basic goods currently in anchorage.

HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS:

- **Foreign Ministry Press Briefing:** Spokesman Baghaei emphasized that any country allowing its territory to be used for [U.S. or Israeli attacks](#) will be considered a legitimate target.
- **Judiciary Council Meeting:** Chief Justice Ejei ordered the [seizure of assets](#) belonging to "elements cooperating with the enemy" and emphasized that courts will remain open despite wartime damage.
- **Civil Defense Briefing:** General Jalali discussed the transition to ["non-visible" passive defense](#) and the use of AI for infrastructure recovery.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The Economics of Asymmetric Attrition
State media is leaning heavily into "battlefield economics." Analysts argue that Iran's use of [low-cost drones](#) is bankrupting the U.S. and Israel, who must spend millions of dollars on interceptors to stop a few thousand dollars' worth of technology. This is described as a [deliberate strategy of exhaustion](#).

The "Vietnamization" of the Iran Conflict
There is a concerted effort to link the current war to the Vietnam War in the American psyche. Reports cite [U.S. congressmen and](#)

[veterans](#) warning that "Iran is a completely different ball game" and that Trump is leading the U.S. into an [unwinnable quagmire](#) without public support.

Narrative Control: AI and Censorship
A meta-conflict is emerging over the veracity of news. Trump is accused of [claiming Iranian rallies are "AI-generated,"](#) while Iranian state media claims Israel is under [severe military censorship](#) to hide the true extent of damage to its airbases and ports.

Succession as a Weapon of Stability
The framing of [Ayatollah Mojtaba Khamenei's leadership](#) is not just domestic; it is a signal to the West that the "Deep State" of the Islamic Republic is intact. The new leader is portrayed as [imperturbable and deeply connected](#) to the military, moving from "Ali to Mojtaba" without a single day of institutional hesitation.

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks): Expect an intensification of "Operation True Promise 4" as Iran attempts to break the resolve of the remaining U.S. allies in the region. Domestic focus will be on the [threat of "insurgent" activities](#) during the upcoming Chaharshanbe Suri (Fire Festival), which the IRGC warns will be used as a cover for [U.S.-backed "false flag" operations](#).

Medium Term (1-6 Months): If the Strait of Hormuz remains restricted to Yuan-denominated trade, the [petrodollar system faces its greatest challenge](#) since 1974. European and Asian manufacturers may formally decouple from U.S. sanctions to restore energy flows. Domestically, Iran will transition from active defense to "reconstruction lawfare," using the [Minab school incident](#) to seek billions in reparations.

Long Term (1-5 Years): The "Ramadan War" likely accelerates the [emergence of a multi-polar regional order](#) where Iran, backed by China and Russia, manages Persian Gulf security. The succession of Mojtaba Khamenei suggests a long-term hardening of Iranian policy, focusing on [indigenous technology and "Eastward" alliances](#) to the detriment of Western influence.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- U.S. and Israeli strategists must recognize that the "regime change" narrative is currently failing to gain traction internally, as [succession has solidified](#) around a hardline consensus.
- The humanitarian "Minab" narrative is gaining [significant traction in the Global South](#), potentially leading to a diplomatic blockade of the U.S. and Israel in international forums.
- The reliance of the IRGC on [underground "missile cities"](#) suggests that air campaigns alone cannot disable Iran's offensive capacity.

For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Energy Volatility:** Hedge against a long-term closure of the Strait of Hormuz; Iran appears committed to a [permanent shift toward Yuan-based](#) energy trade.
- **Supply Chain Risk:** Agriculture and shipping industries must anticipate [prolonged fertilizer shortages](#) and high maritime insurance premiums in the Middle East.

- **Tech Resilience:** Iran's demonstrated ability to maintain its [national intranet \(SHAD and Baras\)](#) despite cyber and physical attacks indicates a robust, isolated digital infrastructure that will likely become the regional model for "digital sovereignty."
