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VENEZUELA NAVIGATES A FRAGILE DOMESTIC "TRANS-DECISION" UNDER ACTING PRESIDENT DELSI RODRÍGUEZ WHILE THE US-IRAN WAR SHATTERS GLOBAL ENERGY MARKETS.

### DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

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March 17, 2026, marks a pivotal moment in Venezuelan history, characterized by a complex "trans-decision" or managed political transition. Following the detention of Nicolás Maduro and Cilia Flores—referred to by state media as a "kidnapping"—Acting President Delsi Rodríguez has consolidated power through a strategy of "pragmatic coexistence" and dialogue with the Trump administration. This domestic pivot is underpinned by a massive amnesty program that has [benefited over 7,500 individuals](#), signaling an attempt to de-escalate years of internal conflict while maintaining the socialist "communal" state architecture. The regime is leveraging a "New Political Moment" to attract foreign investment, specifically targeting the [recovery of oil production](#) toward 1.2 million barrels per day, positioning Venezuela as a stable energy alternative to the chaotic Middle East.

Globally, the situation is grave as "Operation Epic Fury," a joint US-Israeli campaign against Iran, has escalated into a regional conflagration. The reported [elimination of Ali Lariyani](#) and other high-ranking Iranian officials follows the earlier death of Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, leaving the Islamic Republic in a state of fractured leadership. Iran's blockade of the Strait of Hormuz has sent oil prices to \$120 per barrel, with analysts warning of a surge to [\\$300 if the blockade persists](#). Donald Trump has simultaneously signaled a predatory foreign policy toward the Caribbean, [threatening to "take" Cuba](#) while praising his "incredible" relationship with the Rodríguez administration in Caracas.

On the domestic front, the "managed peace" is tested by severe infrastructure failures and labor unrest. A significant [transport strike in Caracas](#) paralyzed the city as drivers demanded a fare increase to 120 bolivars to combat inflation. While the government celebrates nationalistic fervor surrounding Venezuela's historic [World Baseball Classic final](#) appearance against the United States, the reality for citizens remains one of water scarcity, frequent blackouts, and a hollowed-out healthcare system. The administration is attempting to bridge this gap by [distributing new police vehicles](#) to communal "Peace Quadrants," essentially militarizing local security under the guise of citizen protection.

### MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

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#### The Transition of the "Acting Presidency"

- Delsi Rodríguez has emerged as the face of a new diplomatic pragmatism, receiving [explicit recognition from Donald Trump](#) as the head of state.

- The administration is actively promoting a [Ley de Amnistía \(Amnesty Law\)](#), with 7,580 people already benefiting, though critics note that those involved in military actions against the state remain excluded under Article 9.
- Elite reshuffling is evident in the [selection process for a new Ombudsman](#) (Defensor del Pueblo) and Attorney General, with candidates like Enrique Ochoa Antich calling for an end to the "Palace of Silence."

### Global Energy Crisis and the Hormuz Blockade

- The ongoing war in the Middle East has led to the [closure of the Strait of Hormuz](#) by Iran, disrupting 20% of global oil transit.
- The US has begun [releasing 400 million barrels](#) from strategic reserves to stabilize prices, though the International Energy Agency warns this is a temporary buffer.
- Venezuela is positioning itself for a [20% growth in oil production](#), seeking to capitalize on the vacuum left by Iranian and Russian oil through new joint ventures.

### Regional Geopolitical Shifting

- Trump has publicly stated he expects the ["honor of taking Cuba"](#) during his mandate, citing the island's extreme vulnerability.
- In Brazil, former President Jair Bolsonaro has been [moved to intermediate care](#) while serving a 27-year sentence for a coup attempt, highlighting the collapse of his movement.
- Chile's President Kast (referred to as "José") has [initiated a "Border Shield"](#) in Arica to militarize the fight against illegal migration.

### Domestic Social and Labor Volatility

- A Caracas-wide [transportation strike](#) on March 16 pressured the Ministry of Transport to anchor fares to the US dollar.
- Severe water shortages in Nueva Esparta have forced the [distribution of free bottled water](#) by local municipalities, as the Turimiquira system remains unstable.
- Public health remains in crisis, with surgeons in Monagas reporting they [cannot perform operations](#) due to a lack of basic surgical supplies.

## KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

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### Elite Politics & Leadership Dynamics

- The detention of Maduro has created a power vacuum being filled by the Rodríguez siblings and Diosdado Cabello, who is focusing on [strengthening the communal "Peace Quadrants"](#).
- The presence of former Spanish PM Rodríguez Zapatero as a ["Champion of Peace"](#) provides international cover for the Rodríguez administration's transition.

### Energy Security & Investment Climate

- Legislative reforms to the [Organic Mining Law](#) are being debated to "change the rules of the game" and turn minerals into a primary wealth source.
- The government is pleading for the [unfreezing of gold reserves](#) in London and funds in Portugal to inject liquidity into the stagnant economy.

## AI & Technology Policy

- The integration of [AI in corporate accounting](#) (specifically Excel) is being aggressively marketed to Venezuelan firms to manage hyper-complex financial data.
- Ethical concerns are rising over [Meta's "immortal" profiles](#), which use AI to allow deceased users to continue interacting indefinitely.

## Domestic Stability & Civil Unrest

- The government is deploying [thousands of new motorcycles and patrol cars](#) to local communes to suppress potential unrest related to the economic crisis.
- Authorities are increasingly relying on [state-wide surveillance camera systems](#) linked to a central 911 hub to monitor "preventative" security.

## LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

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The National Assembly is currently focused on a suite of "Opening Laws" designed to liberalize the economy while maintaining socialist political structures. These include the Amnesty Law for political reconciliation, the new Mining Law for resource extraction, and adjustments to the Labor and Tax Codes to accommodate foreign capital.

## DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

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### The "New Political Moment" as a Tactical Retreat

The transition from Maduro to Delsi Rodríguez is less an ideological shift and more a tactical retreat to ensure survival. By framing Maduro's absence as a "kidnapping," the regime maintains its base's revolutionary fervor while the [Rodríguez siblings negotiate a "road map"](#) for a 24-month transition with Washington. This includes the [planned resignation of CNE rectors](#) and TSJ magistrates to "reinstitutionalize" the state in a way that satisfies Trump's demand for a "win" without surrendering communal control. The amnesty program serves as the lubricant for this process, buying off moderate opposition elements.

## Venezuela as the "Anti-Iran" Energy Hub

The regime is masterfully exploiting the Middle East conflict. With [oil prices threatening \\$300](#), the administration is marketing Venezuela as "safe, abundant, and cheap." This narrative is designed to force the US to drop all remaining sanctions. The push for a [new Mining Law](#) further aligns with this, positioning the country as a critical mineral supplier for the global tech and defense industries, effectively making Venezuela indispensable to the Trump administration's "America First" strategy.

## Militarized Communalism

Despite the talk of dialogue, the internal security trend is toward "Quadrants of Peace" ([Cuadrantes de Paz](#)). The delivery of military-grade transport and surveillance equipment to communal councils indicates that the regime is [outsourcing social control](#) to its most loyal grassroots supporters. This "militarized communalism" ensures that even if high-level political concessions are made in Caracas, the regime retains an unbreakable grip on the neighborhoods and rural territories.

## STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

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**Short Term (1-4 Weeks):** The conclusion of the World Baseball Classic will mark the end of a "national unity" distraction, likely followed by [renewed transport strikes](#) and social pressure if the fare increases are not gazetted. Expect a [formal announcement regarding US investment](#) in the Orinoco Belt as Hormuz remains blocked.

**Medium Term (1-6 Months):** The National Assembly will finalize the [restructuring of the CNE and TSJ](#), paving the way for a 2027 or 2028 election cycle. Economic "bubbles" will expand in Caracas and the Oil Belt, while the

[health and water crises](#) in the interior provinces deepen, potentially leading to localized riots.

**Long Term (1-5 Years):** If the "trans-decision" holds, Venezuela will evolve into a hybrid state—a [mixed economy model](#) with heavy Chinese and US energy investment coexisting with a socialist communal political structure. The "Cuba problem" will escalate, with [Trump potentially moving from sanctions to direct intervention](#) as the island's economy collapses entirely.

## RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

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### For International Policy:

- Western diplomats should focus on verifying the [autonomy of the new Power Citizen](#) appointees (Ombudsman/Attorney General) as a litmus test for the "trans-decision."
- The blockade of Hormuz requires a secondary energy corridor; [investing in Venezuelan infrastructure](#) is now a matter of global security, not just regional policy.
- Prepare for a massive refugee crisis from Cuba as Trump increases [pressure for a regime collapse](#) or surrender.

### For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Energy Sector:** Unprecedented opportunities exist in [rehabilitating existing oil wells](#) and secondary recovery, as the state is desperate for quick production spikes.
- **Tech/AI Services:** There is a massive untapped market for [AI-driven financial and logistics tools](#) for Venezuelan firms trying to normalize operations after years of sanctions.

- **Risk Warning:** Infrastructure remains the primary bottleneck; investments in oil or mining must include [private power and water solutions](#) to be viable, given the collapse of the national grid.
