DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

The security and humanitarian situation across the Palestinian territories on May 10, 2026, is characterized by a systemic failure of basic infrastructure in Gaza and a rapid, strategic territorial reorganization in the West Bank. In the Gaza Strip, the reported "ceasefire" is described as existing only on paper, as Israeli forces expand the [Netzarim corridor](#) and seize approximately 50% of the territory's geographic area. The humanitarian crisis has shifted from acute trauma to chronic collapse, evidenced by a 53% shortage of [essential medicines](#) and a complete breakdown in environmental health, leading to rodent infestations and sewage flooding in displacement camps.

In the West Bank, a dual-track policy of infrastructure development and settler-led intimidation is underway. The Israeli government has allocated over [one billion](#)

[shekels](#) for bypass roads designed to connect settlements while bypassing Palestinian population centers, a move interpreted as a "race against time" to establish irreversible facts on the ground before the next Knesset elections. This territorial pressure is punctuated by high-intensity symbolic violence, most notably the forced [exhumation of a Palestinian body](#) by settlers and military forces in Jenin, an act condemned by UN officials as a sign of total dehumanization.

Regionally, the conflict is increasingly integrated into a broader US-Iran-Lebanon escalation. Lebanese casualties are mounting from Israeli strikes, while Iran has issued direct [threats against US naval assets](#) in the region. Amidst this, internal Palestinian politics are shifting as Fatah prepares for its 8th General Conference, positioned as a vehicle for national reform and "internal fortification" against Israeli strategic maneuvers.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

- **Expansion of the Netzarim Corridor and Gaza Partition**
 - Israeli forces have reportedly moved "yellow blocks" to extend their control zone in central Gaza, effectively [cutting off North Gaza](#) from the south via the Netzarim axis.
 - Military operations continue to target civil infrastructure, including [police points and civilian vehicles](#), despite ongoing discussions regarding a ceasefire.
 - The Israeli military now occupies or controls over [50% of the Gaza Strip's](#) total area.

- **Systemic Health and Environmental Collapse in Gaza**

- Health officials report a "zero list" (total exhaustion) for [67% of medical disposables](#) and 53% of basic medicines.
- Environmental degradation has led to the accumulation of [450,000 tons of waste](#) in the Khan Younis area alone, fostering rodent and insect infestations in hospitals and tents.
- Thalassemia patients face a lethal crisis, with [50 deaths recorded](#) among the patient population since the start of the conflict due to blood and medication shortages.

- **Accelerated West Bank Annexation and Settlement Infrastructure**

- The Israeli government has allocated an additional [billion shekels](#) for settlement-serving bypass roads through 2028.
- Settlers are reportedly "racing against time" to establish [20 new settlements](#) before the October Knesset elections, fearing a potential shift in the Israeli right-wing's dominance.
- The Israeli Civil Administration is discussing the legalization of dozens of [outposts established](#) since October 7th.

- **Symbolic Violence and Desecration in Jenin**

- Settlers and Israeli troops forced a family in the village of Al-Asa'sa to [exhume a relative's body](#) hours after burial, under threat of further desecration.
- The UN Human Rights Office described the incident as a "horrifying" example of the [dehumanization of Palestinians](#).

- **Regional Escalation and Diplomatic Brinkmanship**

- Lebanese casualties rose significantly, with [25 deaths and over 100 injuries](#) reported in a single day of Israeli strikes in southern Lebanon.
- Iran has declared its missiles and drones are [locked onto US bases](#) and ships, pending orders to fire.
- Pakistan is reportedly acting as a [neutral mediator](#) between Iran and the US to prevent total regional war.

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Security Architecture and Civil Order The Palestinian Authority (PA) is warning of a "calculated strategy" by the Israeli right wing to [undermine the security apparatus](#) in the West Bank. This includes incitement against Palestinian police forces to create pretexts for Israeli military intervention in PA-controlled "Area A" zones. Concurrently, the Israeli military has implemented a [policy of legal discrimination](#), where law enforcement in the West Bank is applied differently to Palestinians versus settlers, as admitted by Israeli military officials in leaked reports.

Food, Water, and Health Security The governance of basic survival in Gaza has shifted to a triage state. The Ministry of Health reports that [oncology and hematology protocols](#) are essentially non-functional because the absence of even one drug out of a four-drug protocol renders the entire treatment useless. In the West Bank, [settlers have begun targeting livestock](#), stealing 80 head of sheep in Ramallah, a move intended to disrupt rural economic resilience and food security.

Diplomatic Engagement and Lawfare Israel has moved to [deport international](#)

[activists](#) from the "Freedom Flotilla," asserting its right to maintain a naval blockade. Meanwhile, a coalition of 300 US Christian leaders is [lobbying the US Congress](#) to restore UNRWA funding and halt weapons shipments used against civilians, indicating a growing rift in the traditional pro-Israel evangelical base in the United States.

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

Governance activities focused on Israeli administrative orders for land seizure and Palestinian preparations for institutional restructuring.

BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED

- **Settlement Bypass Road Funding (Israel):** A multi-year plan (through 2028) allocating [over 1 billion NIS](#) for West Bank infrastructure, following a previous 7 billion NIS allocation.
- **Land Seizure Orders (Jenin):** Israeli military orders for the [confiscation of 7 dunums](#) in the Jabriyat area for military/strategic purposes.
- **Outpost Legalization (Israel):** Discussion by the Israeli Higher Planning Council to [legalize hundreds of settlement units](#) and establish 18 new settlements in the Jordan Valley.

HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS

- **Fatah 8th General Conference Briefing:** Leadership officials discussed the conference as a "beginning of the road" for [reforming the national situation](#) and fortifying the internal front.

- **UN Human Rights Briefing:** Statements from James Heenan (OHCHR) and the UN spokesperson regarding [40,000 Palestinians displaced](#) in the West Bank since early 2025.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The Weaponization of Geography and Infrastructure The use of infrastructure as a tool of displacement has reached a new peak. In Gaza, the military is not merely fighting a war but [physically re-engineering the landscape](#) through the Netzarim corridor to ensure long-term separation of population centers. In the West Bank, the [billion-shekel road network](#) creates a "dual-reality" where settler mobility is maximized while Palestinian mobility is funneled through checkpoints or entirely obstructed. This is a transition from temporary military occupation to permanent structural annexation.

The Psychological Phase of the Conflict Analysis of the Israeli public suggests a transition from a "revenge phase" toward a [period of reassessment](#), potentially leading to political instability within Israel. However, the current government is compensating for this internal friction by allowing settler "Talmudo-colonialist" factions to [drive policy on the ground](#). The grave desecration in Al-Asa'sa is not an isolated incident but a manifestation of a doctrine that denies Palestinian presence even in death, aimed at inducing psychological defeat and voluntary migration (transfer).

Institutional Collapse vs. Political Reorganization While the PA's medical and civil systems are collapsing under the weight of the war, there is a distinct effort to [revitalize Fatah](#) through its upcoming

conference. This suggests a recognition that the current status quo is unsustainable and that a "post-war" leadership structure must be established to prevent total chaos or a Hamas-led alternative in the West Bank. The focus on "internal fortification" suggests the PA is preparing for a period of extreme isolation and reduced international support.

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks): Gaza will likely face an outbreak of waterborne diseases as [unseasonable rainfall](#) interacts with 450,000 tons of unmanaged waste and overflowing sewage. Expect a spike in mortality among chronic patients (diabetes, Thalassemia) due to the [exhaustion of insulin and blood supplies](#). In the West Bank, settler raids are likely to intensify in the Jordan Valley as the legalization of 18 outposts enters the final administrative stages.

Medium Term (1-6 Months): The Fatah 8th Conference will likely lead to a leadership shuffle, potentially introducing more hardline or reformist elements to counter the Israeli government's annexationist policies. In Israel, the "race against time" for settlement construction will likely cause a [diplomatic crisis with the EU](#), as hundreds of European officials call for an end to the "illegal annexation" of Area E1. Regional tensions will remain at a "controlled boil" as Pakistan mediates between Washington and Tehran.

Long Term (1-5 Years): The West Bank will likely be fragmented into "islands" of Palestinian population surrounded by a [contiguous settler road and utility network](#), making a two-state solution geographically impossible. Gaza may remain permanently bifurcated by the Netzarim axis, with the northern portion serving as a restricted

military zone or a perpetual "grey zone" of minimal governance. The survival of the Palestinian Authority will depend on its ability to transition from a service provider to a "national liberation" framework if its administrative capacity continues to be eroded by Israeli fiscal and military pressure.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- The international community must address the [oncology/hematology supply chain](#) as a distinct humanitarian priority, as partial shipments are medically ineffective.
- Diplomatic pressure should focus on the "dual-use" nature of Israeli infrastructure projects, which [violate international law](#) regarding the modification of occupied territory.
- UN agencies should increase monitoring of [settler-led land grabs](#) framed as "natural reserves," a growing tactic for land seizure.

For Private Sector/Investors:

- Supply chains for pharmaceuticals and medical supplies into the Levant face extreme disruption risks due to [regional escalation in Lebanon](#).
- Investments in Israeli infrastructure may face future [sanctions or legal challenges](#) if they are linked to the billion-shekel West Bank bypass road project.
- There is a critical opportunity for investment in [off-grid environmental health solutions](#) (waste treatment, water purification) for humanitarian NGOs operating in high-conflict zones.
