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VENEZUELA POSITIONS AS GLOBAL ENERGY PIVOT AMID MIDDLE EAST CONFLICT AND DOMESTIC JUDICIAL CONSOLIDATION

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

On May 13, 2026, Venezuela is navigating a complex intersection of aggressive judicial restructuring, nationalist territorial defense, and opportunistic energy diplomacy. The National Assembly's decision to increase the number of Supreme Tribunal of Justice (TSJ) magistrates from 20 to 32 signifies a major **consolidation of state power** under the guise of "judicial reform." This move coincides with Acting President Delcy Rodríguez's return from the International Court of Justice (ICJ), where Venezuela continues to reject the court's jurisdiction over the Esequibo dispute, insisting instead on the 1966 Geneva Agreement. The administration is effectively using the "national unity" of the Esequibo claim to provide cover for deep structural changes to the judiciary.

Simultaneously, the global energy landscape is shifting in Venezuela's favor due to the escalating conflict between the United States and Iran, which has **blocked the Strait of**

Hormuz and pushed oil prices toward \$120 per barrel. US President Donald Trump's arrival in Beijing to discuss these disruptions, coupled with his controversial rhetoric regarding Venezuela as a "51st state," highlights a new era of "tutelage" or intense strategic alignment. The announcement that United Airlines will resume direct Houston-Caracas flights and the government's move to **restructure external debt** suggest a desperate but calculated attempt to reintegrate into the global financial system, leveraging its oil and gas reserves as the only viable alternative to Middle Eastern supply chains.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

- **Expansion of the Supreme Tribunal of Justice (TSJ):** The National Assembly sanctioned a reform increasing the bench from 20 to 32 magistrates to "stabilize" the justice system. [unanimously sanctioned the reform](#).
- **Esequibo Defense at the ICJ:** Acting President Delcy Rodríguez reaffirmed that Venezuela will not recognize any ICJ ruling on the 1899 Paris Award. [rights were clearly defended](#).
- **Energy Geopolitics & US Relations:** Resumption of direct US-Venezuela flights and Trump's "51st state" comments signal a profound shift in regional influence. [United Airlines resumes flights](#).
- **National Debt Restructuring:** The Executive announced a formal process to restructure the external debt of both the Republic and PDVSA. [restructuring of external debt](#).

- **Public Health & Biosurveillance:** Authorities are monitoring a Hantavirus outbreak on European cruises while launching a massive cattle vaccination drive. [Hantavirus prodromic phase](#).

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Judicial Lawfare & State Capacity: The expansion of the TSJ is framed as a move toward "judicial efficiency," yet critics and opposition members view it as a continuation of the "January 3rd" political shift. This expansion is intended to **accelerate sentencing** in the social, civil, and criminal chambers. [32 judicial officials](#) will now oversee the court's operations. This follows the high-profile death of Victor Quero under state custody, which has forced the National Assembly to issue statements **supporting investigations** to maintain the appearance of the Rule of Law. [Quero died under custody](#).

Energy Security & Geopolitical Power Dynamics: The Strait of Hormuz closure has made Venezuelan gas and oil a strategic priority for both Washington and Beijing. US companies like **Siemens and General Electric** have reportedly received licenses to operate within the Venezuelan power grid, signaling a move toward "re-institutionalization" led by US energy needs. [Siemens and GE licenses](#). This is mirrored by the **restoration of gas production** through projects like Cardón 4, involving Repsol and Eni, to stabilize the national grid. [arrived in Spain](#).

Economic Security & Investment Climate: Táchira Governor Freddy Bernal is aggressively lobbying for a **Special Economic Zone (SEZ)** on the border with Colombia to capture 39% of bilateral trade and mitigate "exchange rate distortions"

where the Peso dominates over the Bolívar. [SEZ for Táchira](#). However, the private sector remains hamstrung by **chronic electricity shortages**, with 59% of industries forced into partial self-generation. [59% self-generation](#).

Biosurveillance & Food Security: The government has launched a national vaccination campaign against **Foot and Mouth Disease (Fiebre Aftosa)** to achieve international certification as a "free" territory, which is essential for meat exports to the Middle East and Southeast Asia. [certification as free of aftosa](#). Simultaneously, the emergence of a Hantavirus strain in Europe has triggered a "fake news" alert regarding a Pfizer vaccine, though officials admit the **Andes strain** remains a threat in South America. [Hantavirus mortality at 60%](#).

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

The National Assembly is currently focused on structural legal changes to facilitate foreign investment in energy and the total overhaul of the judicial branch. The legislative agenda is increasingly dictated by the "post-January 3rd" reality of increased US mediation in Venezuelan internal affairs.

BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **TSJ Organic Law Reform:** Sanctioned to increase magistrates from 20 to 32. [approved by unanimity](#).

- **Acting President's ICJ Update:** Delcy Rodríguez briefed the nation on the "unassailable" historical titles Venezuela holds over the Esequibo. [3000 folders of evidence](#).
- **Consecomercio Strategic Plan:** Business leaders called for tax exemptions on the import of electrical generators to combat the energy crisis. [exempt from taxes](#).
- **Expoferia National 2026:** Promotion of the buffalo sector, which now produces 6 million liters of milk daily and represents a \$1 billion potential. [6 million daily liters](#).

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The "January 3rd" Paradigm Shift: A recurring theme across multiple broadcasts is the "post-January 3rd" era. The governor's push for "Exchange Houses" (Casas de Cambio) is a desperate attempt to **re-strengthen the Bolívar** in a region that has functionally seceded from the national monetary policy. Technological Leapfrogging vs. Basic Infrastructure: There is a jarring contrast between the promotion of "Red IA" (Artificial Intelligence platforms) and "tokenization of assets" by Silicon Valley-linked investors and the reality of **171 hours of power outages** in regions like Zulia. The government is promoting a high-tech future to attract foreign capital while the industrial base suffers from 480 potential hours of labor reduced by 127 hours due to grid failure. [127 hours without power](#).

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks): Expect a flurry of new TSJ appointments as the "preliminary committee" moves to fill the 12 new seats. These will likely be filled by figures acceptable to the current "acting" leadership to ensure continuity. On the health front, the **Foot and Mouth vaccination drive** will serve as a test for state capacity in rural areas, where lack of fuel for refrigerated trucks remains a risk. [vacunacion until June 15](#).

Medium Term (1-6 Months): The resumption of United Airlines flights in August

will be a significant psychological and economic marker. If the flights proceed without incident, it will signal a **de facto normalization** of relations with the US. Debt restructuring negotiations will intensify, likely using **future gas production** as collateral. However, if the Hantavirus cases spread beyond cruises into the general population in neighboring Argentina or Chile, expect regional border closures. [Hantavirus death in France](#).

Long Term (1-5 Years): The "51st state" rhetoric, while dismissed by nationalists and regional leaders like Petro, indicates a long-term US strategy of deep **economic and political integration** of Venezuela into the North American energy orbit. Structurally, the expansion of the buffalo and livestock sectors suggests a shift toward becoming a **regional food power**, potentially rivaling traditional exports if the "aftosa-free" status is achieved. [replaces oil income](#).

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- The ICJ jurisdiction dispute is likely to result in a **default ruling** against Venezuela; diplomatic channels should prepare for a potential "hot" border or increased naval presence in the Esequibo.
- US-Venezuela "re-institutionalization" is moving faster than public rhetoric suggests; monitoring the **licenses for Siemens/GE** is critical for understanding the true level of US involvement. [Siemens/GE licenses](#).

- The humanitarian repatriation flights from Panama represent a **shift in migrant management** from containment to organized return, likely funded by the US to stabilize the region. [Panama repatriation flights](#).

For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Energy Sector:** Major opportunities in gas infrastructure and electrical grid rehabilitation as the government prioritizes export-grade energy. [exporting gas natural](#).
- **Agricultural Risk:** The Foot and Mouth Disease (Fiebre Aftosa) status is the single most important metric for the livestock sector; a failure in this vaccination cycle will kill export potential for years. [90% of rebaño](#).
- **Logistics/Currency:** Táchira is the testing ground for the new SEZ; investors should watch for the **re-introduction of official exchange houses** as a sign of regulatory stabilization. [operators and exchange houses](#).
