SUMMARY:			
The interest in and use of short-term rentals (such as AirBNB, VRBO, etc.) has increased in popularity over the past several years. Many local governments have sought options on how best to address this growing issue both legally and practically through local government regulation. Over time, many local governments have adopted ordinances restricting locations, quantity, and requiring registration for these short-term rental properties.			
In April 2022, the North Carolina Court of Appeals ruled in Schroeder v. City of Wilmington that state law prohibits a registration requirement for short-term rentals. The court also ruled that state law allows for general zoning and development standards for short-term rentals. The Town's Land Use Attorney, Tom Terrell, will provide information about the current status of laws related to short-term rentals.
