## Town Awarded Funding

Flood Mitigation Funding Award

The State of North Carolina appropriated the Golden LEAF Foundation \$25 million for a Flood Mitigation Program. The Flood Mitigation Program will award funding up to \$2 million per project. Funds may only be awarded to units of local government. The Golden LEAF Board awarded \$7,704,537 in funding to support 10 projects through the Flood Mitigation Program in Avery, Columbus, Craven, Cumberland, Duplin, Guilford, Harnett, and Wilson counties.

The Town of Jamestown was awarded \$769,000 in funding from the Golden LEAF Foundation under the Flood Mitigation Program for construction expenses. The project will replace the current infrastructure at O'Neil Drive, Royal Road, and Wiltshire Drive with larger pipes. It will address the frequent flooding experienced as a result of undersized culverts and infrastructure which does not allow for sufficient flow during rain events. Households and users of the road will benefit from this project. This project would not be possible without the funding from the Golden LEAF Foundation and the Town is appreciative of this funding opportunity.

## Yard Sales

Thinking of having a yard sale? Follow these rules to ensure you have the best yard sale possible! Avoid losing your signs to code enforcement by only posting when and where it's allowed. Yard sale signs may be put up after 12pm on Fridays and must be removed by 12pm on Monday. They may not be attached to any telephone poles or street signage. 
