Leaf Collection

The Town of Jamestown's leaf
collection program began October
25 and will end on February 23rd,
2024. To participate in the
program simply:

- Rake leaves to the edge of your yard behind the curb.
- Remove sticks, rocks, and other debris which can damage the Town's equipment. If staff encounters debris in the leaf pile, they will not continue collection at the property.
- Do not park vehicles on, in front of, or near your leaves.

Yard Sale Signs

Also, be sure you don't attach them to any telephone poles or street signage to ensure you can have the best yard sale possible. We are coming up on winter months and as it gets colder we all use different methods to keep our homes warm. Below are a few tips to follow when using any type of heater to keep your home warm.

1. Be sure to plug your heaters directly into a wall outlet, never use an extension cord.
2. If using a flammable gas or liquid (propane, kerosene, diesel, etc.) be sure that heater is not left unattended.
3. If using a wood stove or fireplace, be sure to have your chimney cleaned and inspected to ensure all components are working right. Never leave a fire unattended.
4. Always have a Carbon Monoxide Alarm if you are using anything other than electric heaters.
