# **Town Staff Changes**

The past few months have been very busy in the personnel department! The Town Council hired Dave Treme to be the Interim Town Manager. Dave comes to the Town with forty plus years of experience and a wealth of knowledge. He has served in Salisbury and Mooresville as Manager and more recently at the Town of Spencer as Interim Manager. Dave has hit the ground running at Jamestown, filling key positions recently vacated and moving forward on several projects in Town.



The Town had three key positions vacated at the Golf Course which have now been filled. Former Golf Maintenance Assistant Superintendent John Hart left in January and former Golf Maintenance Superintendent John Crowe left in February. During the interim time, the Town was fortunate to call back Jay Gardner who formally worked as Superintendent for many years.



After advertising with the Carolinas Golf Superintendent Association, the Town has filled both positions. Jamey Claybrook is the new Superintendent. He began on March 8. Jamey and his family have moved to the area from Eden, NC where he was Superintendent at Oak Hills Golf Course. Prior to that he was at Greensboro National Golf Course.

The Town has hired Justin May as Assistant Golf Superintendent. Justin was Assistant at Jamestown Park from 2003-2013. He left to go to Tanglewood Golf Course. He is excited to return to Jamestown but will not officially start until April 5.





The Golf Course also lost its Turf Equipment Mechanic in January. That position will be filled by Justin King. Justin has been the mechanic at Oak

Hollow in High Point. He is looking forward to the challenge of being the sole mechanic for Jamestown.

The Town Council approved a new position of Town Planner when the 2020-2021 budget was passed last year. That position has been filled

as of March 22. Anna Hawryluk comes to the Town from the Piedmont Triad Regional Council. Anna served as an interim Planner for the Town in 2015. Anna has already been familiarizing herself with the Town. If you have planning and zoning questions, please give her a call at 336.454.7388.



The Town Council will begin the process of hiring a Town Manager soon. The Piedmont Triad Regional Council will be assisting the Council with advertising and reviewing initial applications.

## PINECROFT SEDGEFIELD

The Pinecroft Sedgefield Fire District will begin their semi-annual fire hydrant testing on April 1st and will continue this operation throughout the month, finishing by April 30th.



All hydrants in the Pinecroft Sedgefield Fire District will be tested to ensure that they are operating properly and are able to produce the required water pressure when needed. This testing also includes all hydrants in the Town of Jamestown.

Because this testing must be done during normal operating hours, it will be impossible to know in advance just when or where the testing will take place in any specific area. Opening hydrants can sometimes cause a temporary discoloration of water in nearby homes. The discoloration is not harmful in any way and can be cleared up by running the water for a few minutes.

This testing ensures the protection of citizens and is also an

evaluation indicator used by the NC Response Rating System, which evaluates the fire district according to the protection they offer.
