TOWN OF JAMESTOWN SELECTS NEW ASSISTANT TOWN MANAGER

Jamestown, NC – (March 15, 2022) – The Town of Jamestown has selected Katie Weiner to serve as the Town's Assistant Town Manager.

After careful consideration, the Town of Jamestown is pleased to announce the appointment of Katie M. Weiner as Jamestown Town's Assistant Town Manager, effective immediately. As Assistant Manager, Katie will assist in overseeing the day-to-day operations of the Town and will assist in directing the Town's staff in the implementation of the Town Council's Strategic Plan, which was recently adopted and will be updated on a biannual basis. Additionally, she will be working directly with the Town Council and Town Manager to develop and implement strategies that will propel Jamestown into the future.

Katie was hired by the Town of Jamestown in 2017 and has a bachelor's degree in Political Science and a Master's degree in Public Administration from Appalachian State University. Katie has been serving as the Town Clerk and will continue to serve in that capacity as well.

PINECROFT SEDGEFIELD

Last month was Daylight savings time! As we change our clocks forward, this is a good time to check to see if you have working smoke alarms. "Why check my smoke alarm?" The answer is simple. Working Smoke Alarms save lives!

Here are some simple steps on how to test your smoke alarm.

- 1. Press the Test button and listen for beeping sounds.
- 2. Check the date on the back. (If older than 04/01/2012 it needs replaced)

Clean the Smoke Alarm of any dust and cobwebs.

If you find that your smoke alarm is out of date, is not working, or you just need help testing them, please call the Pinecroft Sedgefield Fire District Inc. at (336) 229-4421 and ask for assistance. And as always, we provide free Smoke Alarms to help make our community safer.

FIRE DEPARTMENT TO TEST HYDRANTS

The Pinecroft Sedgefield Fire District will begin their semi-annual fire hydrant testing on April 1st and will continue this operation throughout the month, finishing by April 29th. All hydrants in the Pinecroft Sedgefield Fire District will be tested to ensure that they are operating properly and are able to produce the required water pressure when needed. This testing also includes all hydrants in the Town of Jamestown.

Because this testing must be done during normal operating hours, it will be impossible to know in advance just when or where the testing will take place in any specific area. Opening hydrants can sometimes cause a temporary discoloration of water in nearby homes. The discoloration is not harmful in any way and can be cleared up by running the cold water for a few minutes.

This testing ensures the protection of citizens and is also an evaluation indicator used by the NC Response Rating System, which evaluates the fire district according to the protection they offer.

Questions Asked and Answered

• Now that loose leaf collection is over, how do I get my yard waste picked up?

Place your leaves or shrub trimmings in clear plastic bags not to exceed 50 lbs. for pick up on Wednesday or Thursday weekly.

• Will the town pick up old tires ?

No, we are unable to take them to our landfill. Please take your tires to the White Goods Facility located at 2138 Bishop Rd in Greensboro.
