Town Manager Search Begins

Most people know the Town is currently in an interim manager period. Many have asked what the process will be to select the next manager. This is the process to date as well as projection on the completion of hiring a manager. As we move through the process, we will keep the Town residents up to date.

During the Town Council meeting held on October 18, 2016, Council Member Straughn made a motion to approve a contract with Piedmont Triad Regional Council for an amount not to exceed \$8,000.00 to assist the Mayor and Town Councilmembers with the search for a new Town Manager. Council Member Ragsdale made a second to the motion and the Council passed the motion by unanimous vote.

The Interim Town Manager immediately signed a contract with the Piedmont Triad Regional Council and scheduled a special Town Council meeting to allow the Mayor and Councilmembers the opportunity to express their opinions concerning the skills, experience and education that would be important for a Town Manager to bring to the role. Following this meeting on November 15, 2016, the consultant, with the assistance of the Town staff, began to prepare an advertising packet to describe the town government and the Jamestown community. The Council will be asked to comment on the final advertisement that will be shared with media sites and a dedicated website that will be available for potential candidates to review and use for the application procedure. The advertisement process will move forward during December with the consulting agency reviewing the applications and meeting with the Mayor and Councilmembers to discuss and determine candidates and schedule interview dates during January.

Depending on proposed candidates and the Mayor and Councilmembers' ability to meet and move through the selection process, the consultant anticipates a successful candidate will be identified and in place in Town Hall by early April. The process will be an open and transparent method to select our Town's next Manager.

Holidays affect Town Hall Hours

During December and January there are several holidays which affect Town Hall hours. Town Hall will be closed December 23 and 26 for Christmas. This means **NO GARBAGE** pickup on Friday, December 23. Realizing there will be more garbage than usual on Tuesday December 27, we will run two trucks. Have your garbage out by 7am as the trucks may come earlier than the regular time. Town Hall will be closed on January 2 for New Year's Day. This will not affect garbage pick up. However, please make sure your utility bill has been paid. Don't start the new year with a disconnection of service! Finally, January 16 Town Hall will be closed for Martin Luther King Day. Again, there will be no affect on garbage services.
