FIRE DEPARTMENT CELEBRATES NEW EQUIPMENT

The new truck that we have placed in service in Jamestown is a 2021 Pierce Pumper. This is a custom built truck that came from Pierce Manufacturing in Appleton, Wisconsin. This truck is state of the art with all the latest technology and safety features. This is the first new pumper in the Town of Jamestown in the last 30 years.

The antique refurbished truck is a 1928 American LaFrance. This fire truck is the first fire truck that the Town of Jamestown had. Three main volunteers on this project (Bruce Dillon, Art Wise & Stephan Thomas) have spent the last few years bringing this truck back to life to what it looked like when it was first built. This truck was originally purchased new by High Point Fire Department, and then purchased by Jamestown Fire Department in the early 1950's.
