Twelve North Carolina communities were named finalists for the 2022 N.C. Department of Transportation Mobi Awards, which recognizes the state’s best projects that combine several modes of

Summertime is here and the heat has arrived too! With summer weather here it is important to be aware of the signs and symptoms of heat exhaustion and dehydration. Prevention and knowing when to get help are key.

Signs and symptoms of heat exhaustion: (If someone has a throbbing headache, vomiting, a rapid strong pulse, not sweating, or are unconscious,

CALL 911 RIGHT AWAY and help cool the person until help arrives.



- Hot red skin
- Unusual heartbeat
- Vomiting
- Weakness
- Tremor

What you can do to stay safe:

- Wear lightweight, light-colored, loose-fitting clothing as well as a hat and sunglasses when outdoors.
- Drink plenty of water (2-4 glasses of water every hour if you are physically active or out in direct heat).
- Always apply sunscreen multiple times a day and find shade when possible.
- Limit exposure during mid-day and pace yourself in the heat.
- Monitor those at risk for heat related illnesses, especially those on medications for heart disease, high blood pressure, etc. as they may be more affected by the heat.

Jamestown Utility Charges Increase

Effective July 1st the charges for water, sewer and sanitation services will increase.

Water Rate	Per Unit
In Town	\$3.25
Out of Town	\$6.50
Sewer Rate Per Unit	
In Town	\$4.25
Out of Town	\$8.50



All Residents that receive Sanitation services will see an increase from \$10.00 per month to \$12.50 monthly.

The tax rate for Jamestown residents will not increase this year and remain at \$.485 per \$100 valuation.

The Grill is open for service Wednesday—Sunday from 10 am—4pm.

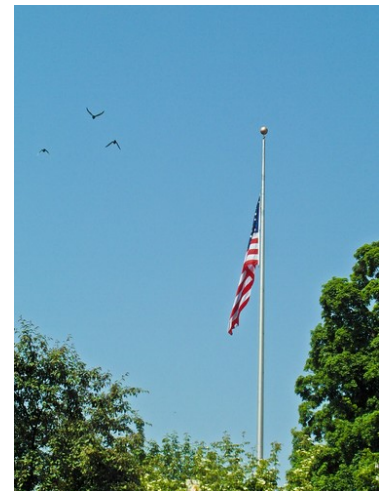
Rentals for events at the Club House Mendenhall room are available for daytime and evening events.
