## **Streets**

Oakdale Road is currently being resurfaced. The segment in the vicinity of Bull Run Village is not being resurfaced at this time, as that area will be impacted by the NCDOT U-2412A Jamestown Bypass project, which should be awarded this summer. The bypass project will impact several roads affecting Jamestown, such as: Vickrey Chapel Road; Harvey Road; Oakdale Road; Bull Run Village - Chimney Court and Oak Village Drive; Dillon Road; Scientific Street; and Greensboro Road (W. Main Street). At this time the project is in the bid process, so we do not have a construction schedule. Staff will provide updates on the Town webpage as the project develops.

The street sign order for the 2017-2018 budget will be delivered soon. Staff will be installing new regulatory signs on Town-maintained streets. Several individual signs in town have been damaged this year, so those signs will be repaired or replaced.

## Water and Sewer

We have two significant water and sewer projects in the proposed budget for next year. Water line improvements along West Main Street from Dillon Road to Oakdale Road are in the review process after coordinating some issues with NCDOT to minimize resurfacing costs. Staff is evaluating certain sewer segments that Page 3 Volume 11 Issue 3

will be near the NCDOT U-2412A bypass crossings to make repairs while access to these areas is in good repair. Due to the population of Jamestown, we were able to request that our utilities impacted by the bypass work be funded completely as part of the NCDOT roadway project.

Additionally, several small sewer repairs have been made in recent months; the sewer problems were found as we performed inspections of underground utilities.

# 2018-2019 Budget

Town Staff has been diligently working since February on the budget for the 2018-2019 fiscal year. A budget workshop was held in February at the Jamestown Park Golf Course with the Town Council. Staff presented a beginning budget then asked Council for input. From that a Proposed Budget was crafted. At the May meeting, staff presented the Recommended Budget and a Public Hearing was held. The Council will vote on the Budget at the June 19 meeting.
