It seems that things are slowly returning to normal after over a year of the Coronavirus pandemic. I hope that everyone has stayed safe and is paying close attention to the guidance that has been distributed by the CDC. I know that everyone is looking forward to enjoying the summer with their families and friends!

The Citizen Advisory Boards are starting to have their meetings in person again. These committees are extremely important because they focus on different aspects of business conducted by the residents of the Town of Jamestown. The Planning Board and Parks and Recreation Committee are permanent boards that meet on a semi-regular basis. There are also volunteer opportunities for citizens to participate in various steering committees which have a more narrow focus (such as updating the Comprehensive Plan or creating the Parks and Recreation Master Plan).

The Town is very appreciative of the volunteers that are willing to spend their time and energy working for the community that we all love so much. There are currently two vacancies on the Planning Board for Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ) Members. The residents that would qualify for these two positions would be those that reside in areas that are adjacent to the Town's corporate limits. Although ETJ residents do not live within the Town's limits, our zoning and land use regulations still apply to the property owners in those areas (For Example: Cedarwood & Wellington). The Planning Board Members serve five-year terms and may serve two terms before taking a break from the Board. The Town is always accepting applications for Regular Planning Board Members as well.

There are three vacancies that have just opened up on the Parks and Recreation Committee. These Members must live within the Town's corporate limits. The Parks and Rec Members serve two-year terms and can serve three terms before a required break.

Applications for the Citizen Advisory Boards can be found on the Town of Jamestown's website under the "Downloads" tab. The Town could not function without the volunteers that serve on these committees. It is a great opportunity for anyone that is seeking to get involved in their local government and build connections within the community. Fire Department Purchases New Fire Station Alerting System

Pinecroft Sedgefield Fire District is in the process of converting over the fire station alerting system to a new state of the art internet based alerting system. By June, PSFD firefighters will begin being notified for a call by a system called the **Phoenix G2 Fire Station Alerting System**. When someone calls 911, this system will alert firefighters at the fire station immediately after a dispatcher enters information about a call into the computer-aided dispatch system. An alert will be sounded at the fire station within milliseconds, and the call type, address of the call and the nearest cross street will appear on monitors as a visual indicator for firefighters. This will result in decreased response times.

The system has additional health and safety benefits to the firefighters as well, such as a nighttime alert that starts at a lower volume and increases while LED speakers gradually begin glowing. This technology has proven to reduce cardiac stress, which is one of the biggest health risks to firefighters. This fire station alerting system has recently become available in Guilford County and is a capital investment by PSFD.
