

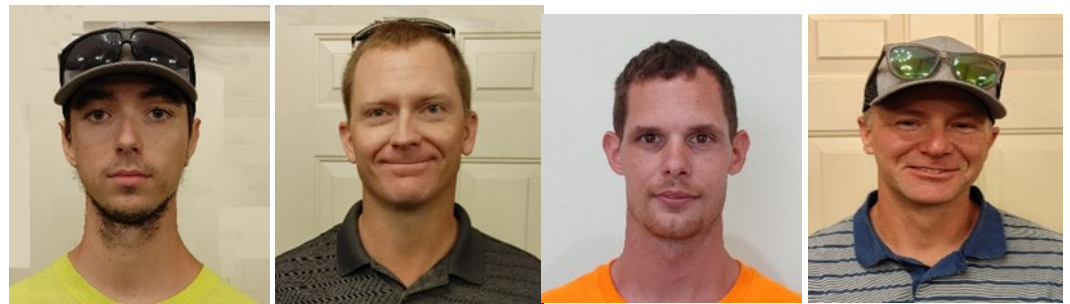


## New Faces!

### Jamestown Loose Leaf Collection

The Town's annual leaf collection program begins **October 25th** and will end **February 25th 2022**.



The program provides residents with the opportunity to have loose leaves collected at the roadside without the need of bagging. The program is operated on a routing system that is based on our staff completing one leaf collection route of the town in approximately 2 to 3 weeks. Once a route is completed, then staff returns to the beginning of the same planned route and begins again. To participate in the Leaf Collection Program simply:

- **Rake leaves to the edge of your yard behind the curb.**
- **Remove sticks, rocks, and other debris which can damage the Town's equipment.**
- **If staff encounters debris in the leaf pile, they will not continue collection at the property.**
- **Do not park vehicles on, in front of, or near your leaves.**

The leaf collection program helps keep leaves from blocking storm drains and prevents decaying leaves from polluting lakes and streams.

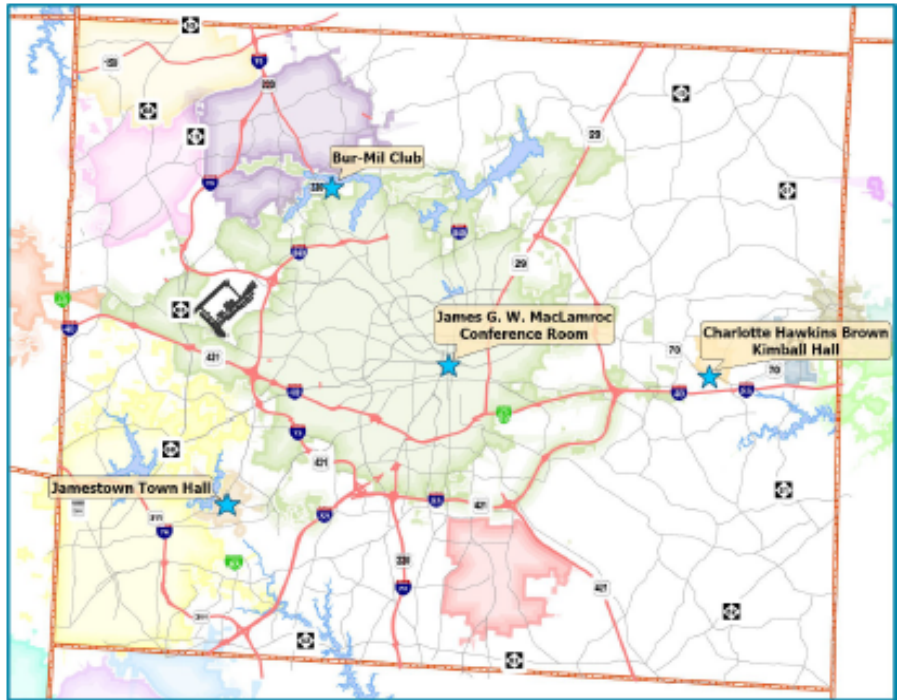

# PINECROFT SEDGEFIELD

## October is Fire Prevention Month

People tend to remove smoke alarm batteries or dismantle smoke alarms altogether when the alarm begins to chirp as a result of low batteries or when the alarm is no longer working properly. These behaviors present serious risks to safety that can have tragic consequences in the event of a fire. When a smoke alarm or carbon monoxide (CO) alarm sounds, respond immediately by exiting the home as quickly as possible and calling 911. If your alarm begins to chirp, it may mean that the batteries are running low and need to be replaced. If the alarm continues to chirp after the batteries are replaced, or the alarm is more than 10 years old, it is time to replace the alarm. Test all smoke and CO alarms monthly. Press the test button to make sure the alarm is working. If you need your Smoke/Carbon Monoxide Alarms checked or need smoke alarms installed, please call Pinecroft Sedgefield Fire District Inc. at (336) 299-4421.

## FIRE DEPARTMENT TO TEST HYDRANTS

The Pinecroft Sedgefield Fire District will begin their semi-annual fire hydrant testing on October 1<sup>st</sup> and will continue this operation throughout the month, finishing by October 31<sup>th</sup>. All hydrants in the Pinecroft Sedgefield Fire District will be tested to ensure that they are operating properly and are able to produce the required water pressure when needed. This testing also includes all hydrants in the Town of Jamestown.

Because this testing must be done during normal operating hours, it will be impossible to know in advance just when or where the testing will take place in any specific area. Opening hydrants can sometimes cause a temporary discoloration of water in nearby homes. The discoloration is not harmful in any way and can be cleared up by running the cold water for a few minutes.

This testing ensures the protection of citizens and is also an evaluation indicator used by the NC Response Rating System, which evaluates the fire district according to the protection they offer.



## Questions Asked and Answered

- Does Jamestown offer E-Bill options to save paper?**

The Town does offer E-bills. If the E-bill option is selected, no paper bill will be mailed. It will be the customers responsibility to contact the Town office if they are having problems with their internet provider or if their email account changes. The Town will not be responsible for bills not received.

To receive your Utility bill electronically , you create a login and choose the paperless option to receive your statement.
