He became an elective fellow of American College of Medical Informatics (FACMI), (2010), Australian College of Health Informatics (FACHI), (2010) and also the President of Asia Pacific Association for Medical Informatics (APAMI) from 2006 to 2009. Currently, he is the Editor-in-Chief of two internationally renowned journals - Computer Methods and Programs in Biomedicine and International Journal for Quality in Health Care. His main areas of expertise are: Medical Decision Support Systems, Patient Safety Information Systems, and Medical Big Data Analytics.
