- Your family constellation (parents, brothers, sisters, etc.).
- Your church history.
- Your walk with Christ: how it began, where you have been, where you are today.
- Your experience as a student in organized (church related) student activities.
- Your relationships with the opposite sex: girlfriends/boyfriends or your wife/husband.
- Your view of dating: boundaries in dating (set by you, set by his/her parents), your relationship with his/her parents, reasons for dating, reasons for not dating.
- Significant mentors who have influenced your life, positively or negatively.
- Your significant friendships.
- Your view of authority: church and government.
- Do your everyday interactions with others identify you as salt and light, as a Christian to the world?
- Your biggest sin struggle.
- How you have dealt with sin in the past.
- How you deal with sin now.
- How quick are you to admit sin, repent, and make amends when possible?
- Addictions, past and present.
- Your experience with pornography, if any.
- Accountability you have sought out, if you are involved with pornography.
- Steps you have taken to overcome your involvement with pornography (if applicable).
- How pornography has affected your significant relationships (if applicable).
- Any struggle with same-sex attraction you may have experienced.
- What can you offer to students you may be teaching that you did not receive as an adolescent (encouragement, personal testimony, etc.)?
- What is your testimony?
- Do you believe you know what God's will is for your life? If so, what?
- Who do you have in your life to pray for you and your ministry on a consistent basis?
- Who would you go to if an issue came up with a student and you didn't know how to handle it?
- As you seek to teach and minister to others, who do you have in your life to teach and minister to you?
- Why do you want to work with children?
- Do you have a preference concerning the age group or sex of children or students with whom you would like to work?

- Have you had any other volunteer or vocational experience working with children or students?
- What is your policy concerning re-direction or discipline of children?
