Intro:
Hebrews 2:1-10

Missio Dei: The Story of Redemption

- v 1 The Gospel: “Don’t drift”
- v 2 The law of Moses punishes rejection.
- v 3 The Gospel’s rejection is punished even more.
- v 4 Because of its heavenly witnesses.
- v 5-11 These verses explain “how great a salvation.”
 - v 5 “The world to come” ?
 - v 6 - 8 Man was created to rule as king of the creation but fell. Thus man needs a “Great Salvation”

v 9 Except for one man

Who did not sin as mankind
but was obedient to the death.

He did what Adam did not.

Jesus had to live out divine perfection as a man

To die for others

And impute to others

v 10 And it was “becoming” God

... who is to be glorified in all things ...

... in bringing many sons to glory”

to “perfect” Jesus through suffering.

He had to obey like we do even when it came to the cross.

Such was becoming God.

Conclusion: This is the “Missio Dei”
