













# Computer Skills: Applications and Windows

<b>Aim:</b> Use technology safely and respectfully. Children will learn to turn on and shut down computing equipment safely.  I can launch an application and manipulate windows.	<b>Success Criteria:</b> I can use more than one way to open an application.  I can move, change the shape and position of a window.	<b>Resources:</b> Lesson Pack  Desktop computers/laptops
	<b>Key/New Words:</b> Launch, application, window, minimise, restore, size, move, screen, close, exit.	<b>Preparation:</b> None needed

**Prior Learning:** Children will have learnt to use a mouse or trackpad and how to switch a computer on and off in lessons 1 and 2.

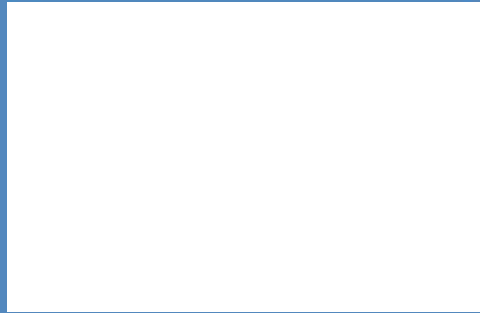
## Learning Sequence

	<b>Get Started:</b> Children switch on the computer and log on. <i>Can the children launch an application?</i>	
	<b>Launching Applications:</b> Show the children how to open an application (program), using the 3 different methods shown on the Lesson Presentation. Applications are usually closed by kissing goodbye with the X. (Applications are generally software programs designed for users rather than programmers. Apps are a term that were initially used for mobile devices, but it is increasingly used for desktop computers or laptops as well).	
	<b>Get Launching:</b> Children practise opening an application in 3 different ways.	
	<b>Do you know?</b> Review how the children found launching applications, ask what they know about windows and what the buttons in the right hand corner of a window are for. <b>Minimising and Restoring Windows:</b> Demonstrate how to minimise and restore a window, change the size of the window (in 2 ways) and move it around the screen. Finally demonstrate closing windows by clicking X. (Kiss it goodbye!) <b>Moving and Resizing:</b> Demonstrate how to resize a window.	
	<b>Have a Go:</b> Children manipulate windows: minimise, restore, move, resize.	
	<b>For Next Time...</b> <i>Where do you store your work in the classroom?</i>

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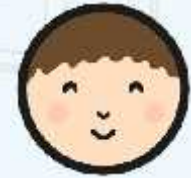

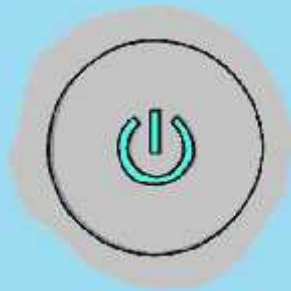

# Launching Applications

There are 3 main ways of opening an application:

1. Click on a desktop icon.



Double click on a desktop icon.

2. From the start menu.



Click start and find the application. It could be in 'All Programs'.

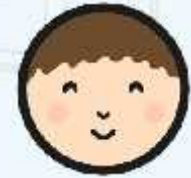
3. Using the search bar in the start menu.



Click start and write the first 2 or 3 letters of the application and it should appear in the list.

To close, kiss it goodbye with the X

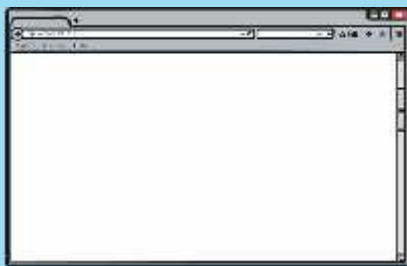

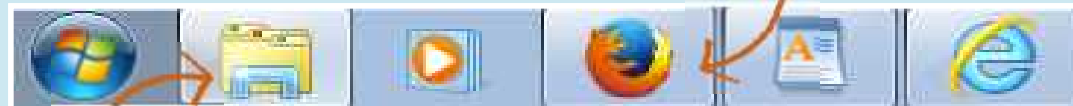
# Minimising and Restoring Windows

You can minimize a window to the taskbar and restore the window back to the desktop.

Click the little button with a single line to minimise.



You can also change from application to application or window by clicking on these icons.



Click the icon on the taskbar to restore. Sometimes you have to choose between several windows.

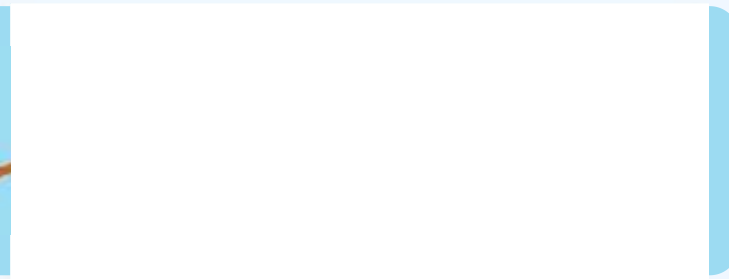
# Moving and Resizing

You can resize a window with the button or dragging the corner.



Click the little button with the two squares to change the window from full size to smaller.

You can move a window about by dragging the top of the window.



Find the double arrow in the corner of the window and drag to resize.
