Aim To use painting software to create a picture, using a variety of colours.

Prior Learning: After completing Lesson 1, children should be familiar with using painting software. They should also be confident in selecting a brush to use and should be able to change the thickness of a brush.

Learning Sequence

 	Remember It: Using the Lesson Presentation , prompt children to demonstrate on their device how to select a brush to paint with and how to change the type and thickness of a brush.	
	Knowledge Organiser: Display the Knowledge Organiser to the class. As a class, highlight any words from the key vocabulary section that the children recognise. Can children discuss with their partner what those highlighted words mean?	
	Using Colour: Use the Lesson Presentation to discuss using colours when drawing pictures and why particular colours are chosen. Look at the digital paintings and discuss what colours the artist has used and why.	
 	Choosing a Colour: Use the Lesson Presentation to model to children how to change the colour of a brush. Give the children time on their devices to explore changing the colour of the brush. Challenge them to draw lines and shapes of different colours. Can children use two different colours when drawing their lines and shapes?	

	<p>Creating New Colours: Use the Lesson Presentation to model how to use the colours menu to create a new colour. Give the children time on their devices to explore creating their own colours.</p> <p>Can children draw lines and shapes using their customised colours?</p>	
	<p>Time to Explore: Using the Lesson Presentation, the differentiated Colours Everywhere Activity Prompt Cards and the skills explored in the lesson, the children should create their own painting within the painting software.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-between;"> <div data-bbox="215 414 582 716">  <p>Children could edit their picture from the previous lesson or they could begin a new one. Children should create a digital painting by changing the colour of the brush tool. The prompt card provides instructions alongside icons as prompts to complete this task.</p> </div> <div data-bbox="614 414 981 795">  <p>Children could edit their picture from the previous lesson or they could begin a new one. Children should create a digital painting using at least two different colours, including one colour they have created themselves. The prompt card provides brief instructions alongside some icons as prompts to complete this task.</p> </div> <div data-bbox="1013 414 1380 817">  <p>Children should begin a new picture. Children should create a digital painting using at least three colours including ones they have created themselves. The children need to also apply the skills of changing the brush type and thickness that they learnt from the previous lesson. The prompt card provides instructions to complete this task.</p> </div> </div>	
	<p>Time to Share: Using the Lesson Presentation, give the children time to have a look at their partner's painting. Ask children to identify where their partner has changed the colour and used a customised colour.</p>
