	Introductory Activity: A Useful Little Word Read the questions and answers to the children and ask them to discuss what word could be used to join the answers. Introduce and on the next slide and ask children to work together to think of their own answer to the question using and . (They could write these on whiteboards). Read the information about joining sentences and give children time to have a go at joining the sentences on the Lesson Presentation . Feedback and discuss. Address any misconceptions.
	Independent Focused Activity: Party Time Children complete the differentiated Party Time Activity Sheet. Check children can use and to join the words and parts of sentences correctly and maintain the sense of the sentence.
	Review Activity: Joining using and Introduce the idea of joining two separate sentences into one using and . Ask the children to hold up and call out and in the correct place to join together the two sentences on the Lesson Presentation slides. (Use the And Cards or ask children to write and on their whiteboards to do this.)

Consolidation Activity: Theo's Party

Children complete the differentiated Theo's Party Activity Sheet. Look for children who can confidently link the two separate sentences to write one complete sentence with two clauses.



Assessment Activity: Party Fun

Children work in pairs using the Party Fun Activity Sheet. They cut out the cards and stick them onto large sheets of paper writing in **and** where appropriate to join the words and clauses. The children complete the Application Activity as required. Can children use **and** to write their own longer sentences joining their ideas sensibly?
