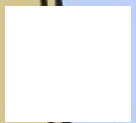

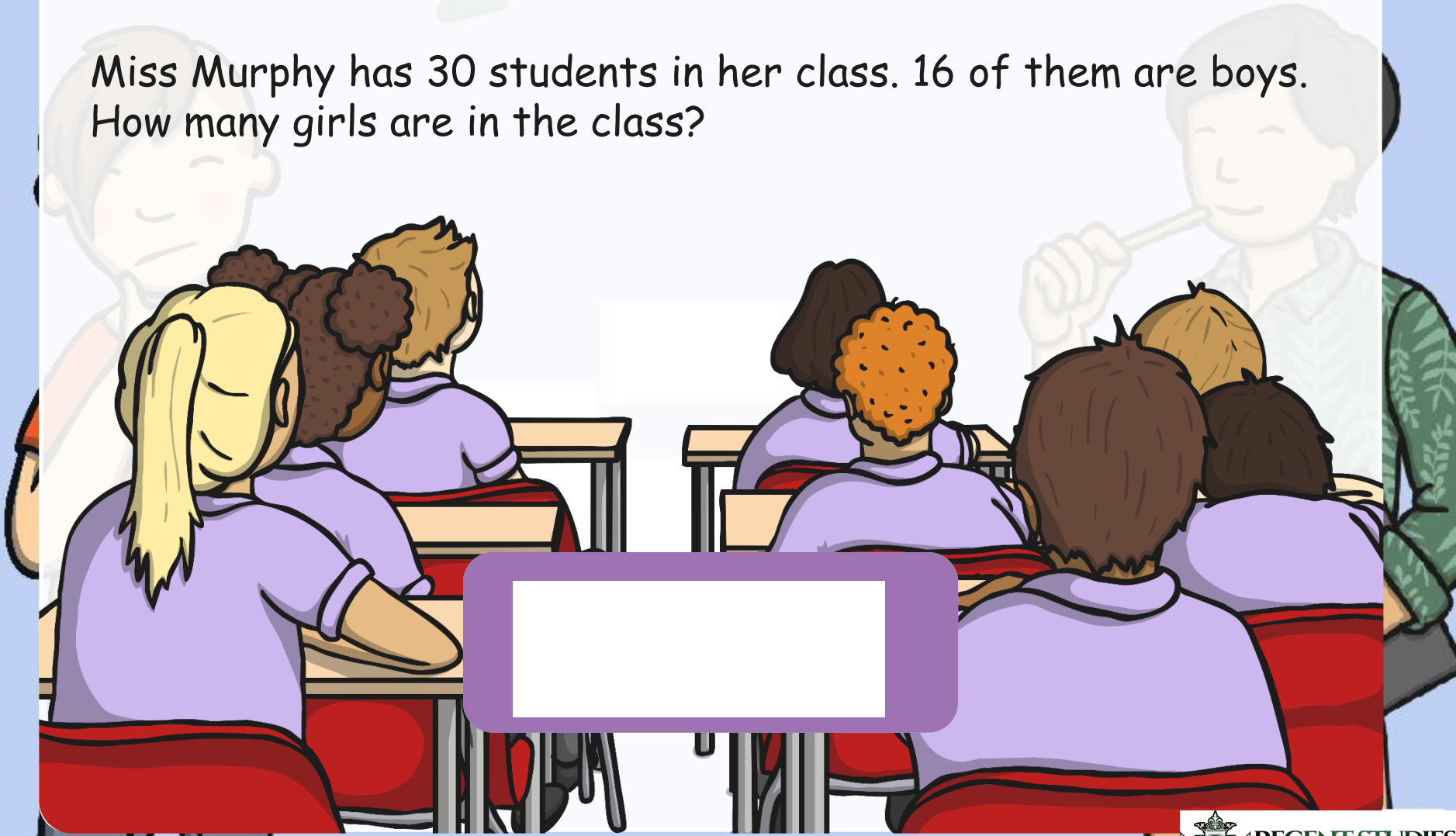

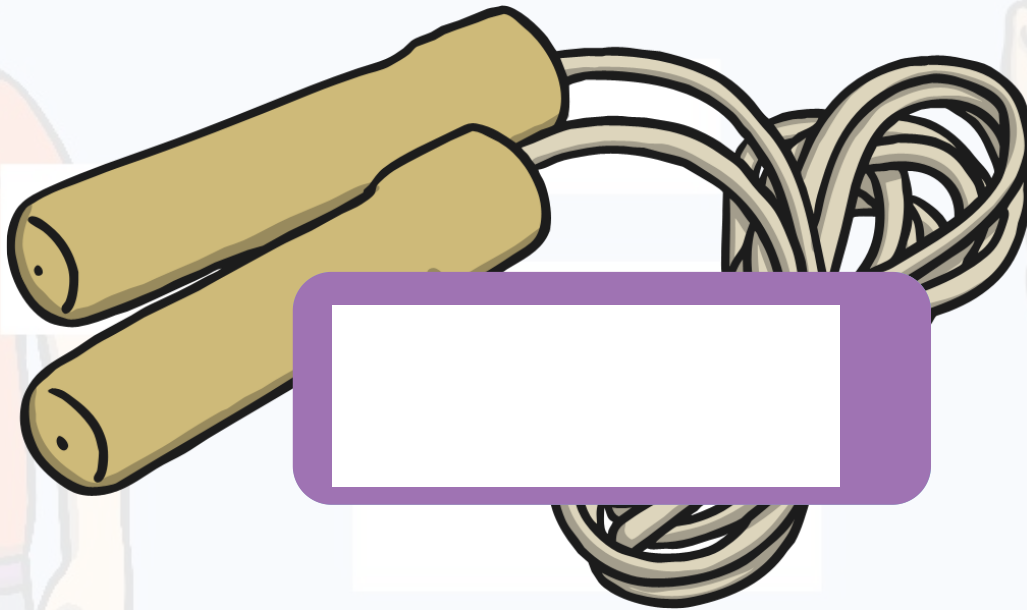
# Monday

Miss Murphy has 30 students in her class. 16 of them are boys. How many girls are in the class?



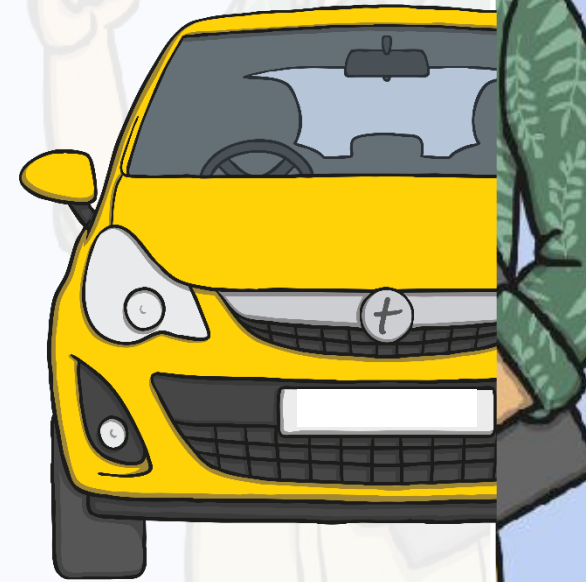
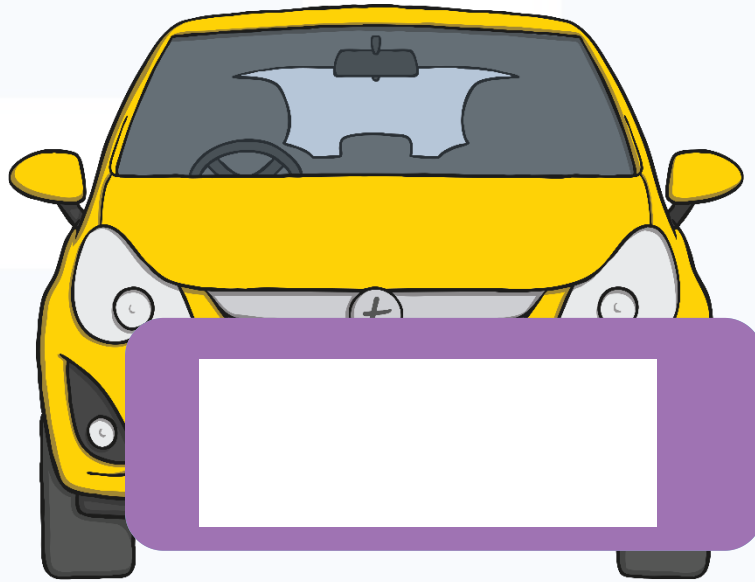
# Tuesday

# Wednesday

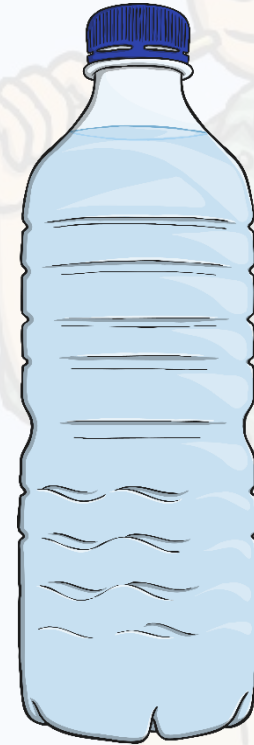
Larry sold a  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the cars in his shop. He had 30 cars left. How many cars did he have before he sold any?
