wild plants	A <b>wild plant seed</b> grows where it falls. It doesn't need to be planted or cared for as it grows.
garden plants	<b>Garden plants</b> are plants that people choose to grow in their gardens.
weed	Weeds are wild plants that grow in places where people don't want them.
deciduous	A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year.
evergreen	An <mark>evergreen</mark> tree keeps its green <b>leaves</b> all year round, even in the winter.



Key Vocabulary	
roots	<b>Roots</b> take in water and nutrients from the soil and keep the plant in the ground.
stem	The stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flowers.
leaves	<b>Leaves</b> catch sunlight to help the plant to make its own food.
flowers	Flowers attract insects and birds.
petals	<b>Petals</b> are the colourful part of the <b>flower</b> .
fruit	Fruit contains the plant's seeds. Sometimes humans try to grow fruit without seeds because it's easier to eat.
seed	Seeds grow into new plants.
bulb	Bulbs grow into new plants.
