This week, we have been learning to read and spell words containing 'ue' saying /yoo/ and 'ue' saying /oo/.

The grapheme 'ue' can make the same sound as /y/ and /oo/ together (yoo), as in 'd<u>ue</u>'. 'ue' can also make an /oo/ sound, as in 'gl<u>ue</u>'. There is no specific pattern so you can try both when decoding a new word.
