
This week, we have been learning to read and spell words containing 'y' saying /ee/.

When the grapheme 'y' is at the end of a word it makes the /ee/ sound, e.g. hairy. Sometimes the letter before the 'y' is doubled too, e.g. the word 'fun' becomes 'funny'.
