
# This week, we have been learning to read and spell words containing 'aw' and 'au' saying /or/.



### **Top Tip**

The graphemes 'au' and 'aw' both make the same sound as the grapheme 'or'. 'au' is most commonly found when the /or/ sound is in the middle of a word, e.g. launch. If the /or/ sound is at the end of a word, 'aw' is more commonly found, e.g. saw.


