


Top Tip

When the grapheme 'g' is before an 'e', 'i' or 'y', it makes a soft /j/ sound, e.g. magic, cage.

When the grapheme 'c' is before an 'e', 'i' or 'y', it makes a soft /s/ sound, e.g. <u>c</u>ity, fa<u>c</u>e.
