

This week, we have been learning to read and spell words containing 'ea' saying /e/.

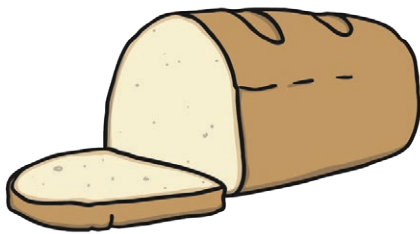

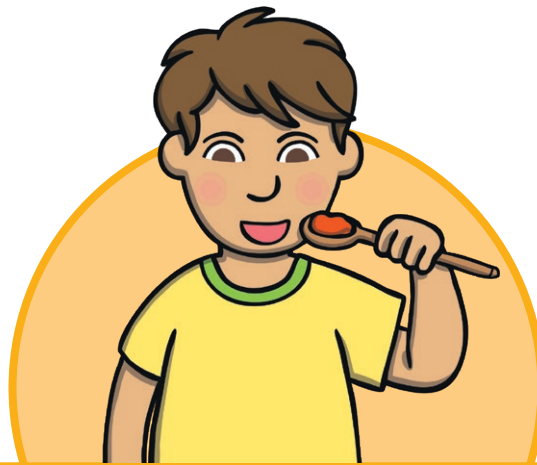
