



# Level 5 Common Exception Words



Regional pronunciations of words may affect whether they are considered to be common exception words or not, for example, past, last, and bath are not exceptions in accents where the 'a' is pronounced as in cat. Teachers should use their judgement about whether words might need to be substituted to meet the needs of your class.

Common Exception Words are those which are not completely decodable using known grapheme-phoneme correspondences. However, they will usually contain one or more GPC that is known by the time the word is introduced. Try to begin by looking at phonemes within the word that are represented with regular graphemes, then introduce the part of the word that does not follow known patterns.

This level includes common exception words for reading and common exception words for spelling. The common exception words for spelling are words that have previously been taught as tricky or common exception words for reading.
