





There are lots of other aeroplanes taking off and landing at the airport.


Watch as each plane comes together, then read the **-s** or **-es** word that it makes.




#### -s or -es


The family finally arrive at Kanpur Airport. There are signs in lots of different languages! Read the words on the signs and decide if the word has the correct -s or -es ending.

















