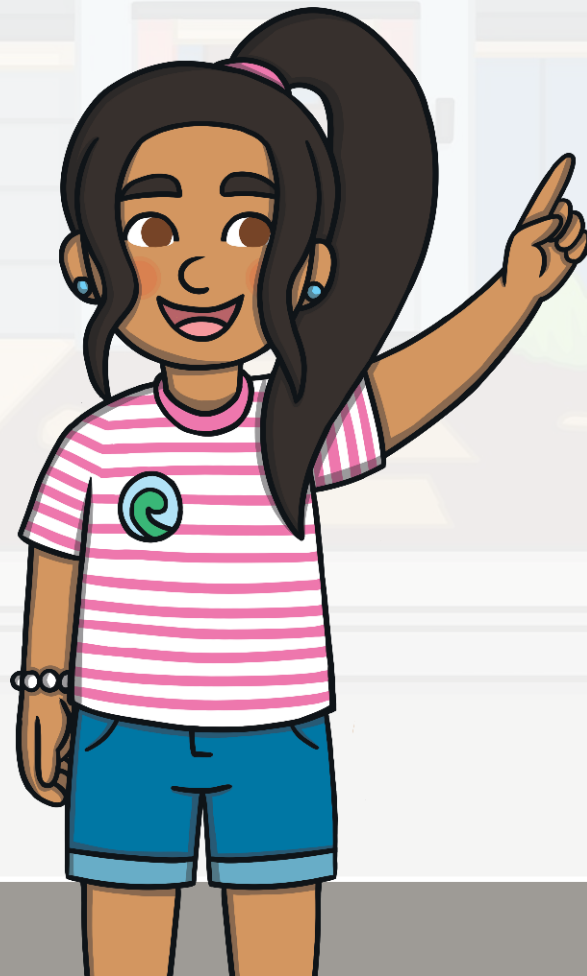
# Travelling

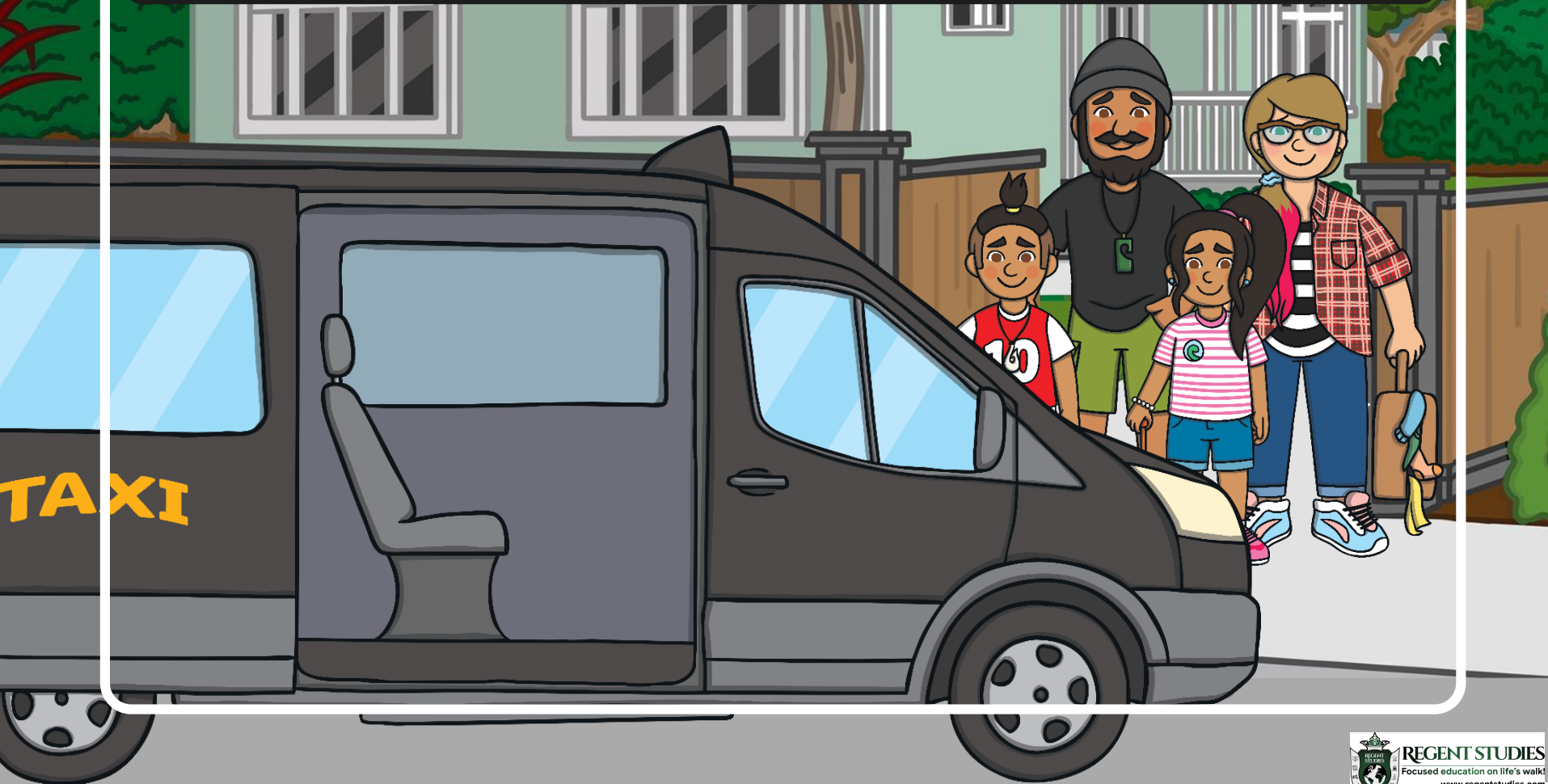




Ben and Sam's family were finally called to board the plane. "I'm going to sit next to the window," shouted Sam, waiting in the line.

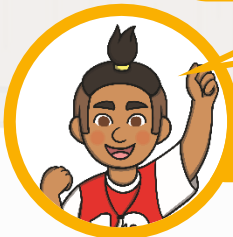


“Oh no, you are not!” said Ben, angrily.

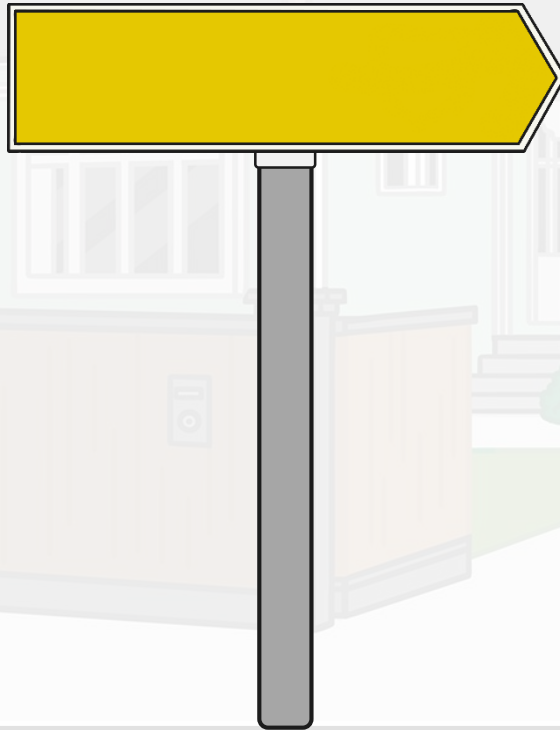

The family finally arrive at Kanpur Airport. There are signs in lots of different languages! Read the words on the signs and decide if the word has the correct **-s** or **-es** ending.

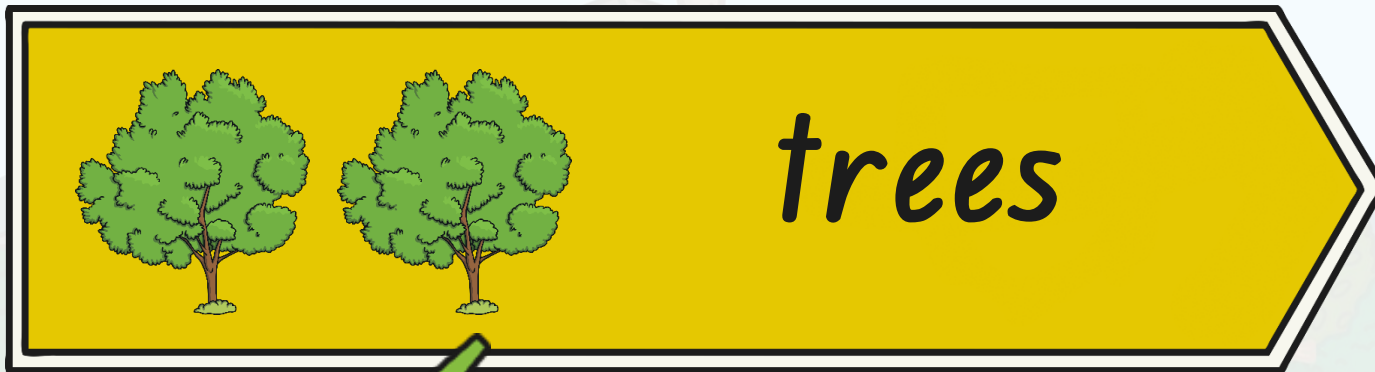
