

-es and -s Flag

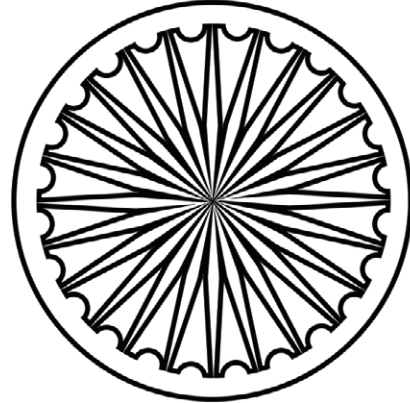
