

Did You Know...? There have been many films made about Robin Hood, including a Disney film where all the characters are animals.





The Legend of Robin Hood

What Is a Legend? -

A legend is a story that is passed down through time by being told over and over again. Legends are sometimes partly true as they can have real people in them or be inspired by historical events. You would not find dragons or fantasy characters in them. This makes them different from **myths**.

What Is the Story of Robin Hood?

There are many different Robin Hood stories. The earliest are from around the year 1200. The first to be written down was called 'Robin and the Monk' in 1450. The best known legend describes Robin Hood as an outlaw who lived in Sherwood Forest in Nottingham with his band of merry men. Outlaws were people who had broken the law. Robin's enemy was the Sheriff of Nottingham. He was in charge of Nottingham while King Richard was away in another country fighting a war. The sheriff made people pay lots of **taxes** which meant that they were very poor and couldn't afford food. Robin and his friends thought that was very unfair so they robbed money from the rich to give to the poor people.
