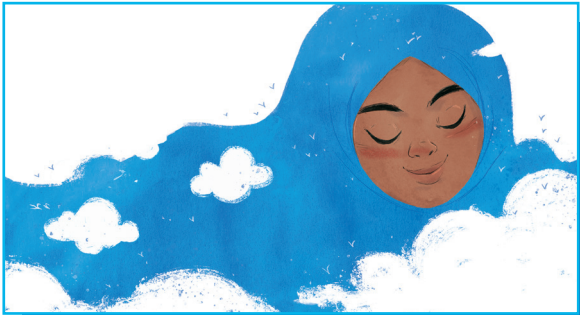


# The Proudest Blue

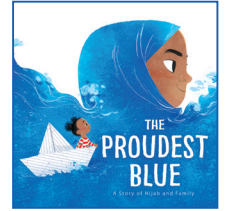
