“Not any more you’re not,” said the grumpy shampoo bottle.

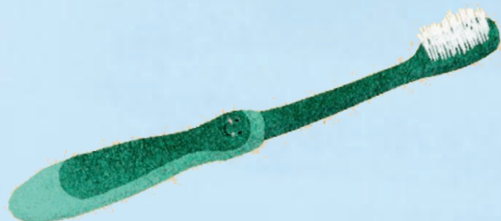
“You’re rubbish now.”

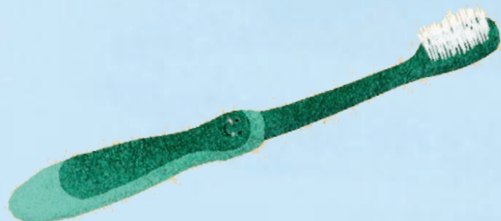
