Answer: The children are building a sandcastle.

Answer: The woman and man are eating food.

Answer: The woman and man are sitting on the picnic blanket.

Answer: The child in a blue top is holding the bucket.

Answer: The children are near the sea/on the sand. (Pointing to the children is also acceptable).

Answer: The seagull is next to/in front of the picnic blanket. (Pointing to the seagull is also acceptable).

Answer: The woman is below the parasol/on the picnic blanket/to the right of the man. (Pointing to the woman is also acceptable).

Answer: The man is below the parasol/on the picnic blanket/to the left of the woman. (Pointing to the man is also acceptable).

Answer: The seagull is watching the food.

Answer: The children are building a sandcastle.

Answer: The woman is holding a red apple.

Answer: The girl is holding a blue spade.

Answer: They are in the sand because they are playing/ building a sandcastle.

Answer: The seagull is near the picnic because it wants to eat their food.

Answer: The child in the blue top is holding a bucket of sand because (s)he is building a sandcastle.

Answer: The family is at the beach because they are on holiday.
