‘Wh’ question words information sheet.

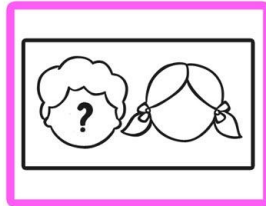
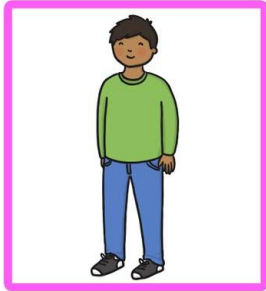
The understanding and use of question words is an important area of language. When children are learning to understand and use question words, they will typically follow a developmental sequence: what, who, where, when and how. ‘Wh’ questions allow children to take part in conversations, find out information and show their knowledge and understanding.

Some children, for example with a language disorder, autism etc., may have difficulty in using and understanding question words and need extra support to understand and use them.
