Guidance for Animations


Every separate 'step' of the Lesson Presentation begins with an animation of the individual number.

While in slide show mode, click anywhere in the square to start (and pause) the animation.


Throughout the Lesson Presentation, blank handwriting guidelines will appear. While in slide show mode, click anywhere on the guidelines to start (and pause) the animation of a specific letter pattern or join.

Please note that the animations may not be compatible with early versions of PowerPoint.
